### Albania, Yugoslavia Dispute May Rock Communist World

New York, N. Y. 20 (AP)—A dispute between the leaders of neighboring Communist countries of Yugoslavia and Albania could result in political warfare which would rock the Communist world.

The feud between Tito and Hoxha led to a renewal of the conflict between the Kremlin and President Tito last night as he before Stalin died.

"The Albanian Hoxha," a few days ago Yugoslavia's President named the Kremlin's man in Albania, Gen. Ruzic Hoxha, as his candidate for public enemy No. 1 of eastern Europe. He denounced Hoxha as a political parasite who has been preventing democratization of Albania, as a savior of Yugoslavia and Poland, a man who respects to maintain himself on the backs of his people" with the help of reactionary Stalinist elements in the Soviet Union.

Tito made it clear he wants Hoxha and his clique out. Tito's condemnation of Hoxha is supported by publication Nov. 18 in Pravda of an article by Hoxha in which he attacked Tito. Hoxha, who was very nearly the bitterest of Communists in assailing Tito, Hoxha and his right hand man, Gen. Mehmet Shahu, a Moscow-trained Communist, liquidated Ruzic Hoxha, who had favored going along with Tito in his break with Moscow.
