Costs, Pay Set Fourth 1956 Mark

Washington, Nov. 26 (AP)—The government reported today that living costs rose one-half of one percent in October to a new record.

The increase means pay raises for about 1.5 million workers in auto, farm equipment, aircraft and metalworking industries whose wage rates are geared in part to the government index.

For most of these workers, the amount of the pay raise will be two cents an hour.

Nearly all consumer spending categories except housing rose in October. Food remained unchanged from September.

The index kept by the Labor Department's Bureau of Statistics rose to 117.7 per cent in 1946, an 4.9 per cent increase over the index in September and 2.4 per cent above October last year.

The bureau issued also a new report on industrial production. The agency said that total production of goods and services rose 1.1 per cent in September and 2.4 per cent above October last year.
