### Nehru, Ike Contrast Sharply in Methods

By JAMES MARLOW (AP News Analyst) Washington, Dec. 17 (AP)—Two men who talk today at Gettysburg—President Eisenhower and India's Prime Minister Nehru—come out of worlds so different they might have been in different centuries. Both have natural leaders. Both have temper. Both go to the point. Both are earnestly earnest. Both are in a hurry to get on with it.

The Helms on Staff Eisenhower, a West Point graduate, used force to preserve freedom, relies heavily on state work to run the government. Nehru, an intellectual who helped lead India to freedom through passive resistance, is less than an administrator. He seems to trust himself most.

A good example is the number of jobs he holds. Nehru is minister, foreign minister, defense minister, head of the planning commission and supervisor of the atomic energy program. Eisenhower came from a family where all the sons had to earn their own way. All his adult life he lived under military discipline.

Nehru, only son of a minister, never had to work. But he created his own personal discipline of passive resistance which he adhered to rigidly, even when called and when British troops beat him with sticks. Eisenhower, an outdoors lover, likes to have close friends around. He is a simple, uncomplaining man who can talk over his problems and his thoughts with his aide.

The introverted Nehru likes people in the mass. He is a biographer, Frank Moore. This is so complicated that he reveals himself completely even to the most trusted friends. Eisenhower is head of the strongest nation on earth, and the most modern in its industrial development.

Nehru is head of one of the largest nations on earth—its 400 million people more than double the number of Americans—and one of the oldest. But among the big powers, it is militarily the weakest. Waves of civilization and culture swept over India for thousands of years before America was discovered.

India Exploited Nation But under British rule from the 18th century until India won its independence in 1947, the Indians for the most part were an exploited, poverty-stricken, disease-ridden, uneducated people. Eisenhower is trying to keep the United States in the lead in every way in the 20th century. Nehru is trying desperately to get India into the 20th century.

Eisenhower believes in free enterprise. Nehru is a Socialist. This country has sought to achieve the dignity and freedom of man by a modified form of socialism, which has some capitalism in it.

### Syrian Refutes Red Influence, Hits Colonialism

New York, Dec. 17 (AP)—The Syrian Ambassador to the United States says reports of Soviet penetration into his country are "unfounded" but that "colonial Western policy is pushing the Arab people into the arms of the Communists." Dr. Faez Zeinedine, on a radio and TV program (NBC Most of the Press) yesterday, said Syria is strictly neutral in the Middle East situation.

Syria bought arms from Czechoslovakia, he said, "because we were unable to buy them elsewhere." He said sabotage of the Iraq-Mediterranean oil pipeline "was the result of the French-British-French invasion of the Mideast," adding: "We would like to see the Mideast return to normal in every way. But to have oil flow in that direction while there is danger blood may flow in the Mideast is something else."

Zeinedine charged that Israel is a "breachhead for colonial expansion in the Mideast." Asked if he "looked forward" to the time Israel could be destroyed by force or some other manner, "according to a custom of several years standing," he said: "It is not a question of wiping Israel out, it is a matter of disintegration." Without the dismemberment of Israel, Zeinedine said, it is "very difficult" to see a lasting settlement in the Mideast.
