So Ishibashi, after he becomes premier, is expected to do two things—slow down Japan's own rearmament and press the United States to set a final date for the withdrawal of her troops from Japan. We have hitherto held that we could withdraw from Japan only after Japan's own military strength had been rebuilt to the point where Japan could be certain of defending itself.

Thus, in a measure, we have some satellite trouble of our own, not in our case, the result of any oppression, but merely the inevitable reassertion of Japan's feebly but diversitarily as a nation.

The longer we stay, the more the pressure for us to go will become.
