The Nixon Trip

"Is this trip really necessary?" one asks of Vice President Nixon's journey to Austria, Hungary, Czechoslovakia and Poland.

The suggestion of the one who says that Nixon might thought up the trip primarily to enliven his own life is a little rougher than we care to get. Our guess would be that Nixon did suggest it, he had a purpose other than his personal ambition.

In other words, the Vice President in our opinion is not out to dramatize himself, or to sell the Hungarians the idea we are their friends, but to make Americans realize that, so far, other nations have taken more Hungarian than we and taken them a great deal faster.

If we are not sure the best argument for the trip establishes as necessary, that means that such doubts as we also entertain have not been overpowered by good certainties. And these doubts are considerable. We are sending this high ranking American official in to the neutral country of Austria, which has already drawn heavily on its moral courage in its rejection of Hungarian refugees.

"Treason" In South Africa

Two years ago, after Meade Alcorn had scored his upset victory with the election of Sheffield Conroy as Speaker of the House, Republican leadership of the legislature seemed to have been assured.

As the thing stands, Alcorn has suffered at least some degree of setback for his own presumed ambition, which is presumed to be to run for Governor, and Brennan, as the man who has controlled the Republican House which is always the nucleus of any Republican state convention, on this one test, stands in a position of potential strength and fighting alliance with such ambition as Clare Booth Luce may develop before 1960.

Cypriots Reject British Self-Rule Propositions

(Continued from Page One)

There was speculation that the new British proposals and the talks with Makarios might be opening a way for his release. British leaders have said he will be freed by denouncing the use of force as a political instrument.

The British proposals met the sharpest rejection from Greek Cypriot leaders and from the Greek government because they did not set a date for granting self-determination for Cyprus. It is considered certain that such a plebiscite would find the Greek majority moving quickly to make the island a political part of Greece.

Lennox-Boyd told Commons Britain's offer hinges on the restoration of peace, law and order in Cyprus. The campaign for union with Greece has made the island the scene of bloody violence since 1954. Most attacks have been blamed on EOKA.

The proposed constitution would leave a British governor in full control of defense, foreign policy and internal security in Cyprus. The governor also could rule by decree during emergencies.

The plan would assure the Greek majority 54 of the 30 elected seats in a new legislature. The Governor would appoint six other members.

The proposals also raised the long-range possibility of partitioning the strategic island as one

means of reaching a solution between the Greek and Turkish communities. Turkey is opposed to the movement for union with Greece, contending the island should go back to Turkish control if British rule is ended.

Themistocles Dervis, mayor of Nicosia and a leading Greek Cypriot spokesman, termed the British plan a "mockery of a self-governing constitution."

Dr. Fasil Kutubuk, chairman of the Cyprus-Turkish party, declared the proposed constitution unacceptable because "none of the points we have put forward have been met."

The cabinet of Greek Premier Constantine Karamanlis said in a statement in Athens the British offer did not comply with principles of the U.N. charter because it did not provide for self-determination. It also asserted the proposals were "neither democratic nor liberal" because the new constitution would leave the British governor of the colony "with practically unlimited power."

At U.N. headquarters in New York, Gregory Cassinatis, chairman of the Greek delegation, said the partition idea is a "fresh attempt at political blackmail."

"The Greek government," he said in a statement, "is unanimous in its verdict that the British proposals satisfy none of the expectations of the Cypriot people."

Gov. Ribicoff Asks Yule Road Safety

Hartford, Dec. 20 (AP)—Gov. Ribicoff included a safe-driving warning yesterday in his Christmas greeting to the people of Connecticut.

Deaths and injury on the highways are a national problem, he said. And it is ironic, he added, that the danger is greatest during the holidays.

Pleading with motorists to observe all traffic regulations, the Governor said:

"It will be the best present you can give your family and your fellow man."

Text of the Governor's message: "It is with a feeling of gratitude for the many kindnesses shown to me that Mrs. Ribicoff and I extend season's greetings to all the people of Connecticut. We wish for you and your families the joy of this holiday. We pray that the new year will bring you good health and happiness."

"Christmas is not only a period of the year which is sacred to the vast majority of my fellow citizens. It is a time in which all mankind should feel the spirit of brotherly love and give thought to eternal values. We in Connecticut have good reason to give thanks to God this Christmas season. We have the blessings of peace and freedom and a good life. We have a beautiful State in which to live and work and raise our children."

"There is one unnecessary shadow again clouding the pleasures of the Christmas season, however. That shadow is cast by the senseless and injurious maiming, the killing and the destruction of the highways of Connecticut and the nation. Despite an encouraging reduction in the number of motor vehicle deaths in Connecticut so far this year, the total is still of grim proportions."

Toll Irrevocably High

"It is ironic that the number of deaths is high during this season of the year when we are all wishing one another good health and happiness and a long life. Yet during the Christmas and New Year's period last year, more than 20 people were killed on Connecticut highways. Hundreds of others were seriously hurt or permanently crippled."

"Think of the heartbreak this brought to our homes and our families at a time of year when there should be only peace and joy! Think of the distress and hardship this meant to women and children so casually widowed and orphaned!"

"I plead with everyone who drives in Connecticut to do his part to prevent these tragedies from being repeated this year. When you get behind the wheel of a car, let the Christmas spirit guide your driving regulations. Live and let live. It will be the best present you can give your family and your fellow man—not only for Christmas but throughout the year."

Woman Cashier Held for Taking \$50,000 in Cash

Denver, Colo., Dec. 20 (AP)—Embarrassment of nearly \$50,000 over six years from a loan company here was charged today to a woman cashier, Mrs. Zidan, a mid-mannered matron of 40.

Mrs. Zidan, who authorities said, signed a statement that she took the money, remained at the bank today, but hardly started and couldn't quit.

"I don't know why I did it. I didn't want to do it, but got started and couldn't quit."

She was employed by the Denver Discount Co. and Allied Credit Corp., a joint firm. Mrs. Zidan was released under \$2,500 bond following arraignment. She had worked for the company 10 years. Her salary was \$260 a month.

Mrs. Zidan admitted taking \$14,000 to \$50,000 at the rate of \$10,000 a year until last month when a fellow employee questioned her records.

No inquiries concerning what she did with the money the cashier refused. She said she had given it to her husband where, she said, she said she used a \$12,000 mortgage on her home and others on two cars.

"Quite a bit of the money went toward caring for my husband, but not all of it," she said. "He's been in the hospital or sanitarium 11 times in the past three years."

Her husband, John, 40, operates a west Denver gas station.

Mrs. Zidan told investigators she took money from the cash drawer and replaced it with checks received in the mail home mortgage payments. She said familiarity with the operations of auditors enabled her to adjust her accounts before the books were checked.

Dulles Liberation Plan 'Do-It-Yourself Policy'

Washington, Dec. 20 (AP)—Secretary of State Dulles' idea of liberation for the Russian satellites after talking for four years about their liberation—comes down to a do-it-yourself policy.

This is cold comfort, but hardly news, for the Iron Curtain countries which want to shake loose from Russia and may have hoped for military help from the United States once they started a revolt.

If this is what they thought, they got their disillusionment when the Hungarians did revolt and got nothing but moral support from the United States. In his news conference this week Dulles seemed even to dilute the moral support.

He said he would rather see the satellites get their independence through peaceful "evolutionary" means.

Avoids Direct Answer

Asked if this country felt that what happened between Russia and satellites was strictly a Russian affair, Dulles didn't answer directly.

He said the Russians have told the United States the satellites are not free, but as he said, he didn't want a resumption of the cold war and didn't want the satellites, even if they were free, as American military allies.

Japan 'Detects' Russian A-Blast

Niigata, Japan, Dec. 20 (AP)—A professor at Niigata University in northern Japan, said today Russia may have exploded a nuclear bomb over the Sea of Okhotsk, a body of water between the Soviet Union and Alaska.

Dr. Hirobumi Wainage said he examined noise in the northern district Tuesday morning and found the radioactive count to have increased greatly, from 180 counts per liter per minute to 1,237.

Scientists at Shinghu University in Niigata, in the same region of north central Honshu, reported the highly radioactive snow Monday morning.
