London, Jan. 12 (AP)—Prime Minister Harold Macmillan continued his intense efforts today to line up his new government and predicted confidently that his task would be completed this week end.

Queen Elizabeth II is expected to be at Buckingham Palace tomorrow, presumably to receive and give approval to the list of new ministers.

The new Prime Minister was wished good luck last night by Sir Winston Churchill, whose advice he has received at the cabinet level.

Ike to Stay Out of GOP Chief Fight

Washington, Jan. 12 (AP)—President Eisenhower was reported today to be inclined to stay on the sidelines if a fight develops within the Republican National Committee over the choice of a new chairman.

Leonard W. Hall resigned the chairmanship yesterday after consulting with Eisenhower. The resignation was effective Jan. 11.

Hall notified the 146 members of the GOP National committee he expected to select his successor at a Jan. 22 meeting here.

Hall also announced he will name a 7-member subcommittee to consult with Eisenhower before recommending a new party chief.

While Eisenhower could designate the new chairman, influential Republicans said they believe the President would like to confine himself to approval of a list of men acceptable to him, leaving the choice to the subcommittee itself.

Graham Executed For Deaths of 44

Canon City, Colo., Jan. 12 (AP)—Coolly accepting his fate, 67-year-old Gilbert Graham was executed today in Colorado gas chamber for destroying an airplane that carried his mother and 45 other persons to their deaths.

Graham was convicted of murdering his mother, Mrs. Dulcie E. King, 68, who perished with 44 other men, women and children Nov. 1, 1955, when a United Air Lines DC-8B was shattered by a dynamite bomb that crashed in a sugar beet field near Longmont, Colo.

Although he never disclosed a motive for planting a dynamite bomb in the plane, Graham named himself beneficiary in a \$75,000 flight insurance policy he took out on his mother's life.

The husky, dark-haired killer went to death "the calmest I've ever seen," said Deputy Warden William Kinney, who has witnessed all 26 executions in Colorado's gas chamber.

Nervous and slightly on his last legs, Graham still was reported to give good spirits and humor by his jail visitors. They included one of his three court-appointed lawyers, John J. Gibbons, and the Rev. Charles H. Johnson, a local minister.

After a 30-minute last-minute appeal, the death row inmate was taken to the gas chamber at 10:30 a.m. His exchange of banter with Warden Kinney, 16, both of whom were in the room at the time of the execution, was reported by Kinney.

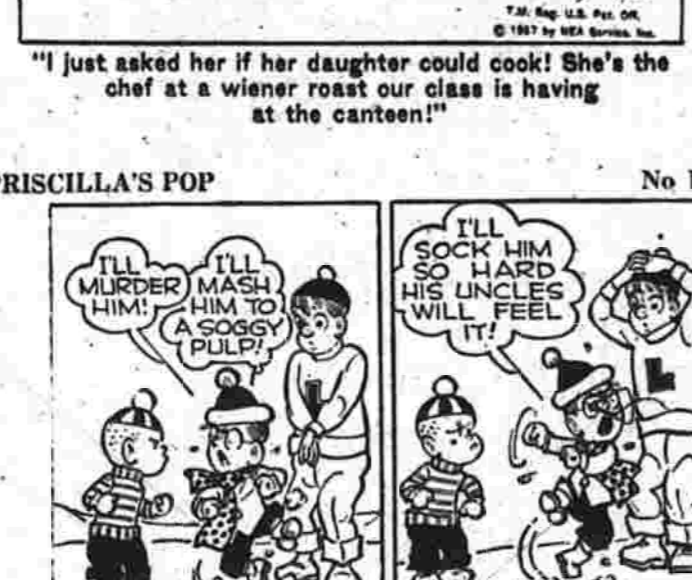
