# Ike Expected to Shun Role of Tough Leader

Washington, Jan. 23.—Any one who has expected Eisenhower's leadership to be mostly staid, successful and tough in dealing with Congress these next four years is likely to be disappointed. In his first two years in office Eisenhower sometimes acted like a man who thought the President's job was merely to consult with Congress. In the following two he showed more signs of pushing for the ideas he wanted approved.

He said he would try to get things done through persuasion, since he is not of the desk-pounding type who likes to attack out his jaw and try to look as if he is beating the covers.

That probably accounts for the lack of aggressiveness and attack in his message to date this year. He has fought very vigorously for much that he proposed at least on domestic problems. He did fight harder on foreign affairs.

So far in 1937 he has operated from the lawmakers and judging from last November's

He has talked to Congress in person on the Middle East; delivered in person his State of the Union message; and sent his budget message to Congress.

It could be interpreted as meaning Truman thinks Eisenhower is timid when it comes to action. But, strangely for Truman, his own statement criticized Eisenhower's "timid" attitude.

Several young women from the area may choose any one of the 27 schools and will be guaranteed attendance at the chosen course by the Department of the Army, Sgt. Robbins said.

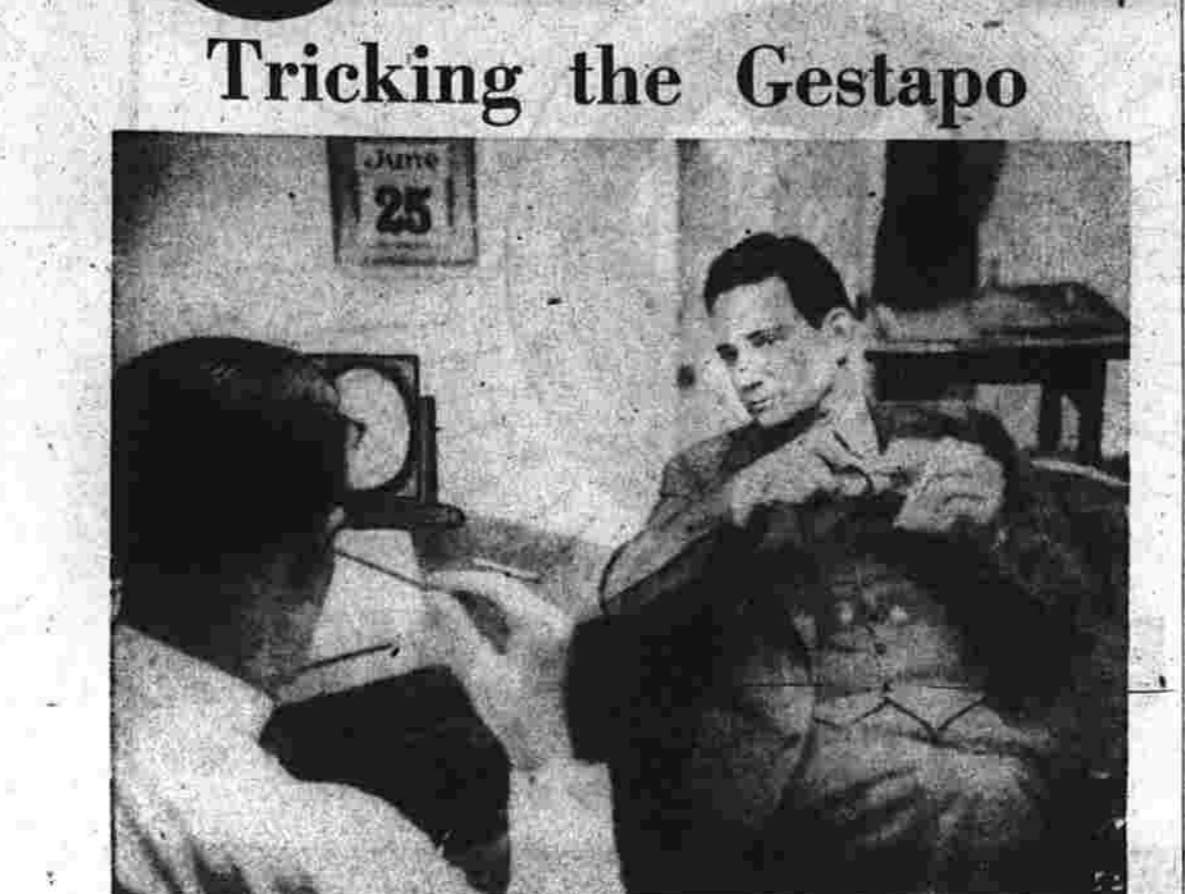

He recalled the blunders that resulted in a vigilante system being organized for combating subversion in the lack of preparedness for dealing with spies and saboteurs, in violation of civil rights during the "red" scare, and the roundup of aliens. He also recalled studies made with recommendations which would correct the errors of the past as far as possible.

At the request of the Army and Navy, the FBI surveyed more than 2,200 key industrial plants in the United States, in addition to Army and Navy arsenals and aircraft factories. Ways and means of tightening security were recommended to the military and to the management of plants.

Methods of sabotage were studied and preventive measures outlined. Suggestions were made on fire prevention and tightening of anti-sabotage guards at vital points of production, and of fingerprinting employees as a countermeasure to those with a criminal record.

At the request of the State Department, the FBI was also kept a watch on the activities of German, Italian and Japanese consular officials as well as the activities of the Soviet Union. The FBI found evidence that German and Italian carriers from carbon monoxide throughout the country were being used as clandestine means of espionage. In June, 1941, the State Department ordered these consular offices closed.

Dramatic Spy Case

Early in 1940, the FBI staged a dramatic case of the strangest espionage and a counter-espionage drags ever enacted in this country. It began when William Sebald, a naturalized American citizen, returned from a trip to his native Germany and immediately came to the FBI. Sebald disclosed that the Gestapo had threatened injury to his relatives—his grandfathers, two Jews—unless he returned to the United States as a German agent. He agreed to return to Germany and they taught him how to use a short-wave radio, supplied him with a secret code and gave him instructions to be passed on to other German agents in the United States.

William Sebald played his role as a German agent well. FBI Laboratory engineers built a short-wave radio station at Coney Island, Long Island. Contact was made with the Gestapo station in Hamburg, Germany. A flow of messages began between the United States and Germany which gradually led the FBI to the largest spy ring to be uncovered before Pearl Harbor.

Sebald Plays Ball

Each message transmitted from the secret Long Island station, which was manned by FBI agents, contained enough authentic information to be convincing. No one was sent without being cleared for security with Army and Navy intelligence officers. The Germans never suspected the hoax.

The FBI established Sebald in a mid-Manhattan office after the "hoax" had been installed. A mirror on the wall reflected the image of anyone looking into the glass—but in the adjoining room this mirror became a mirror through which agents took movies of everything that went on in Sebald's office. Hidden microphones carried each word spoken to a recording device.

Visitors drifted in and out of Sebald's office to receive instructions and to turn over to Sebald messages to be relayed to Germany. Among the callers was Fritz Duquesne, a long-time adventurer and German agent. The agent whose spy career went back to the early 1920s, Duquesne was the ring leader.

This game of cat-and-mouse continued until the FBI was certain the entire espionage ring was known. Then special agents closed in. Thirty-three persons were convicted on espionage charges, including the suave Duquesne. It was like shooting fish in a barrel, one agent said. (Continued on Page 3)

# Union Strike Right Backed by Court

Washington, Jan. 23.—The Supreme Court has upheld the right of a union to call a strike after 60 days' notice, during the life of a labor contract which permits reopening for changes of its terms.

The decision, announced yesterday, interpreted a provision of the Taft-Hartley labor law designed to prevent "quickie" strikes by requiring a 60-day "cooling off" period.

The court held that a union can satisfy the notice requirement by informing the employer it wants to negotiate changes as provided for in the contract, and while the contract is still in effect.

Reverses Circuit Court

This struck down a decision by the U.S. Circuit Court in St. Louis that the Taft-Hartley law flatly bans a strike during the life of a labor-management contract—regardless of any reopening provision of the contract.

The high court decision upheld contentions of the National Labor Relations Board and of employes of Lion Oil Co. at El Dorado, Ark.

Chief Justice Warren, author of the court's opinion, said it would have been anomalous for Congress to require the Taft-Hartley Act the duty to bargain over contract modifications "and at the same time deprive the union of the strike threat."

**Union Assails U.S. Work for Law Violators**

Miami Beach, Fla., Jan. 23 (AP)—The president of the Amalgamated Clothing Workers union reported to the union's general executive board that the government has awarded large contracts to a Tennessee garment company despite what he said were labor law violations.

Jacob S. Potofsky told the board yesterday that the Southern Athletic Co. of Knoxville has received contracts amounting to \$4,670,000 during the past two years.

Potofsky said the firm was blacklisted by the U.S. Department of Labor from December 1946, to February 1948, for sanitation and overtime violations.

The union executive said he had the Southern Athletic Co. added employees back wages under the Minimum Wage Law in 1948 and again in 1954.

"We question the wisdom of the government favoring the kind of people not maintaining the proper labor standards," said Potofsky. "They should not get special consideration and it looks like these people have been getting it."

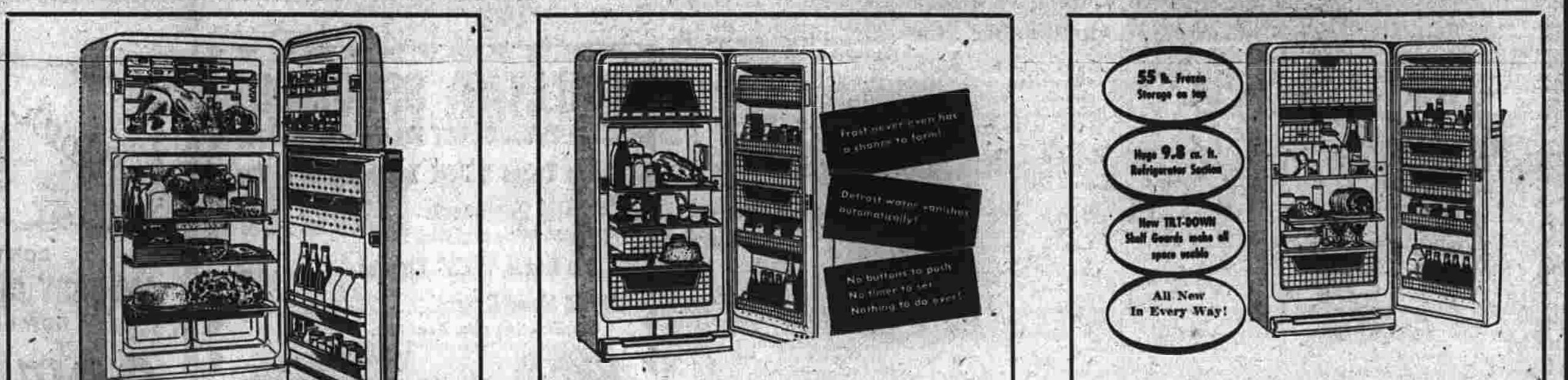
