

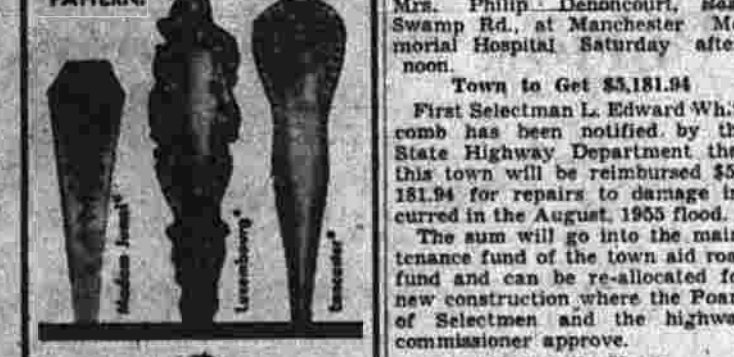




### Andover Snow Removal Cost Reaches \$2,750 Mark Says Whitcomb
