### Miller Calls on Board To Give Martin Aide

Jacob Miller formally resigned last night from his post on the Board of Directors. The Republican Director, secretary of the Board, read his own letter of resignation.

The occasion prompted Director Pasaol, a Democrat, and former Director Walter Mahoney, who identified himself as a "City" Democrat, to endorse Miller for his service to the town.

Pasaol said Miller has been recognized by all for his "forethought, insight, high principle, and courage to face up to his responsibilities."

Mahoney closed his remarks in saying "He's a wonderful man, a great man." He described Miller's resignation as "the most regrettable thing I've heard in 25 or 30 years."

In his letter of resignation, Miller made a plea for an assistant to General Manager Richard Martin. After naming a number of unopposed problems which face the Board, Miller labeled the provision of an assistant to Martin "the one most important single problem for the Board and the Manager to face. Its early recognition and solution will make other problems easier," Miller said.

Miller's resignation was accepted with regret. No mention was made last night of the appointment of a successor.

Remaining Republican Directors have their party's candidate for the post.

**Democrats Undecided**

Democrats appeared still undecided as to whether they would support the GOP nominee without question, or nominate a candidate of their own, presumably Philip Harrison.

Miller's resignation was effective last night, so there are now four Republicans and four Democrats on the Board. If a stalemate develops, however, it will be only temporary, because after 30 days the selection, two of whom are Republicans and one a Democrat, would decide the issue.

Democratic Directors are said to be in the majority.

**THE EXTRA CHANGE FOR A CLUB TRICK**

### TPC Petitioned to Zone Land In Meekville for Industry

The Town Planning Commission has been asked to zone a 13-acre tract of land between the Wilbur Cross Highway and Tolland Park for industrial purposes.

The application for the zone change is one of four on which the TPC will hold a public hearing Feb. 15 in the hearing room of the Municipal Building at 8 p.m.

Also up for a hearing that night will be two proposed subdivisions, totalling some 7000 square feet.

The Wilbur Cross Highway land is owned by the estate of William J. Thornton, which filed the application. Atty. Hugh M. Joseph of Hartford, recently negotiated a bond for deed for the property with the intention of developing it as an industrial site. The land is now in a Rural Zone.

In another application, Stanley Bray is seeking to have land on the south side of Green Rd. changed from Residence Zone A to Business Zone B. The property, which is an existing Business Zone I, is a 21-1/2 acre tract owned by William Kofcia.

William Kofcia is also asking for a Business Zone change. His tract is on the north side of Atlantic City Pk. 14. The tract, Main St. for 165 feet, changed from Residence Zone I to Business Zone II. The land is adjacent to Business Zone II property on Main St.

In the fourth application, Marjorie Miller is asking for a Residence Zone C for property at 482 E. Middle Types, that is now in Residence Zone A.

The two small subdivisions which will be discussed at the hearing are Hillbottom Heights, which involves 50 lots, and Woodside Acres, which involves 20 lots. The latter is located on the East Hartford-Manchester town line.

### Board Restates Stiff Policy On School Bus Misbehavior

### Your Dental Health

**TOOTHBRUSHING**

(This is the third in a series of six articles on dental health being presented by The Herald, in cooperation with the Manchester Dental Society, in observance of National Children's Dental Health Week, Feb. 5-9.)

The toothbrush used at the right time in the right way is probably the most important single home weapon against tooth decay and tooth loss.

The right time means immediately after eating, whether it's a meal or a between-meal snack. It should be recalled that bacteria in the mouth begin acting on sugars within minutes of their consumption to form acids capable of dissolving tooth enamel. Removal of these food particles before the acids can begin their destruction is essential.

If it is impossible at times to brush the teeth after eating, the mouth should be rinsed with water. The old American habit of brushing the teeth the first thing in the morning and the last thing at night is not as effective for dental health as is after-meal brushing.

As for the proper way to brush the teeth, dentists are agreed that a modification of an up and down movement should be used. The strenuous side-to-side method is highly objectionable.

Generally, the bristles of the brush should be pointed toward the roots of the teeth. The brush should be moved so that the bristles sweep over the gums and the lower half of the tooth. The inside surfaces of the teeth should also be included, and the wiping surfaces of the teeth should be scrubbed.

A dentist or dental hygienist can show a parent and child the best toothbrushing method for the child.

Toothbrushes for young children should be smaller than those used by adults. A good toothbrush has (1) a flat, brushing surface, (2) firm bristles and (3) a head small enough to reach all accessible surfaces of the teeth. What about tooth paste and tooth powder? The dental profession recognizes no "miracle" dentifrice. Despite claims to the contrary, there is still no conclusive scientific proof that any tooth paste or tooth powder in itself will prevent dental decay or gum disease.

A dentifrice also helps to help the toothbrush clean the teeth, and tooth powder is still a major waterproof ingredient to protect buildings and highways against weather.

They may include such things as calling down or cutting off trade, withdrawing financial assistance or using methods of blockade. Ordinarily the term sanctions, as applied against a friendly nation, means some kind of economic pressure.

ward, and it was obviously not recognized by Communist China, which also soon began moving away from the active threat of force in the area.

In the two years that have followed, there has been no resolution of the problem of Formosa, and there has been no visible edging toward war in the area. But when this was reported to Washington recently, there were some changes made, and the last high U.S. naval officer to visit the island made a pointed reference to Chiang Kai-shek's army as one which was being trained for "defeat, not offense." It has also happened in those two years, that the once flourishing cloak and dagger mission we maintained on the Chinese mainland, has been abandoned and removed. It has also happened that we have carried out year-after-year a policy of shifting our Pacific area command away from Japan and back to Honolulu, which doesn't mean that we are ready to place Formosa outside our own defense system, but which does indicate that we are beginning to consider it more a defense outpost than a forward base.



Lord Chief Justice Goddard, after hearing the evidence, said to Fuchs: "You have betrayed the hospitality and protection given to you with the greatest treachery... 14 years. That is the sentence I pass upon you."

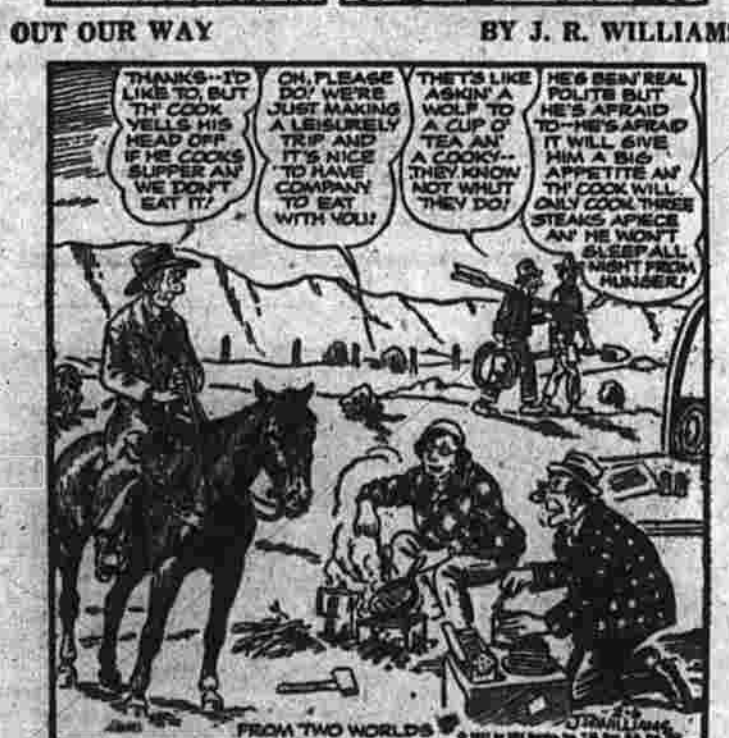

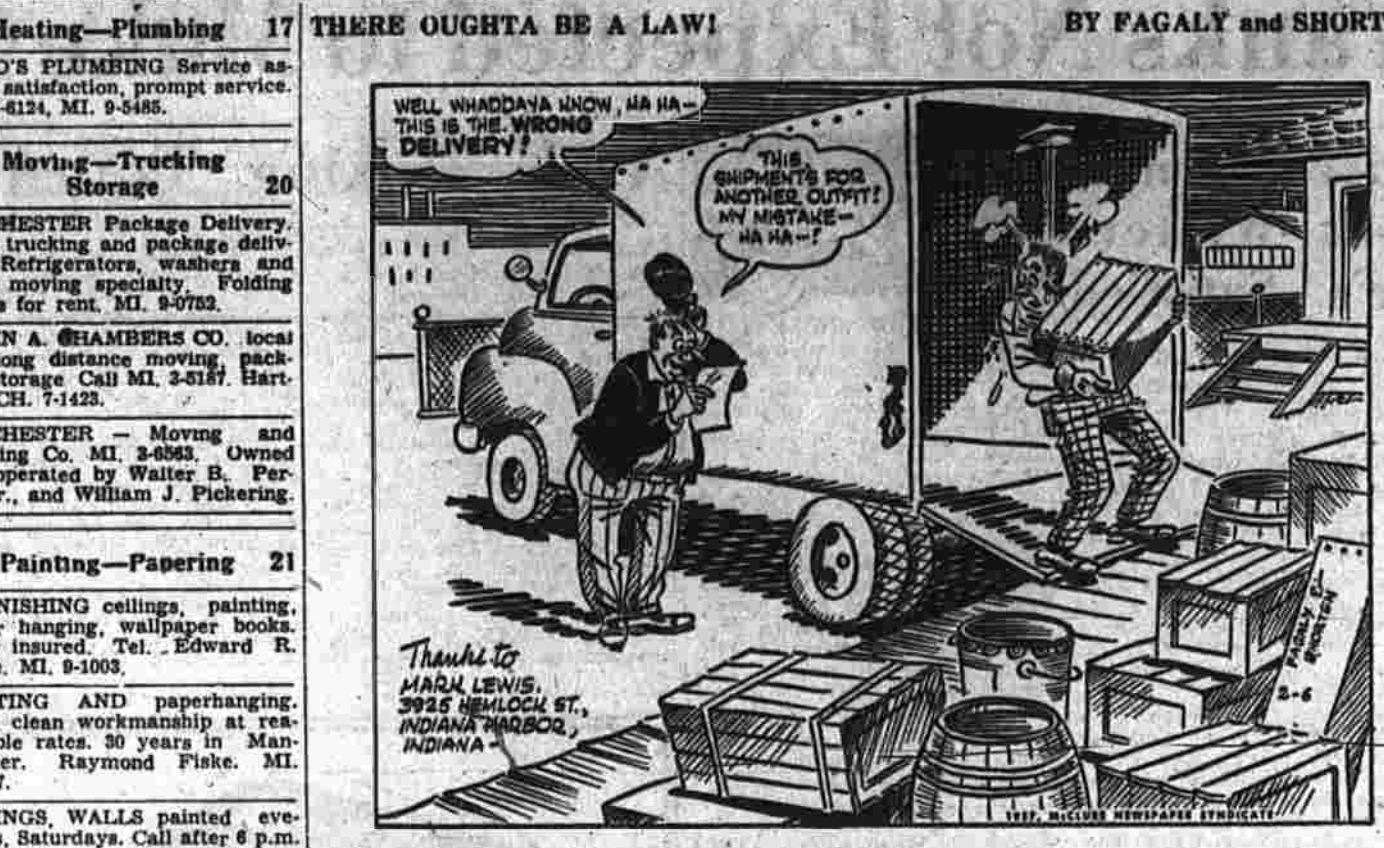
