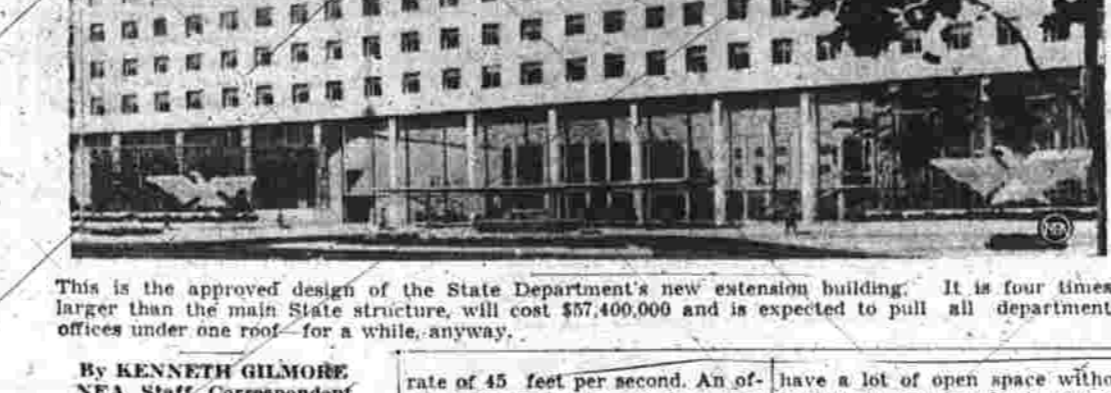

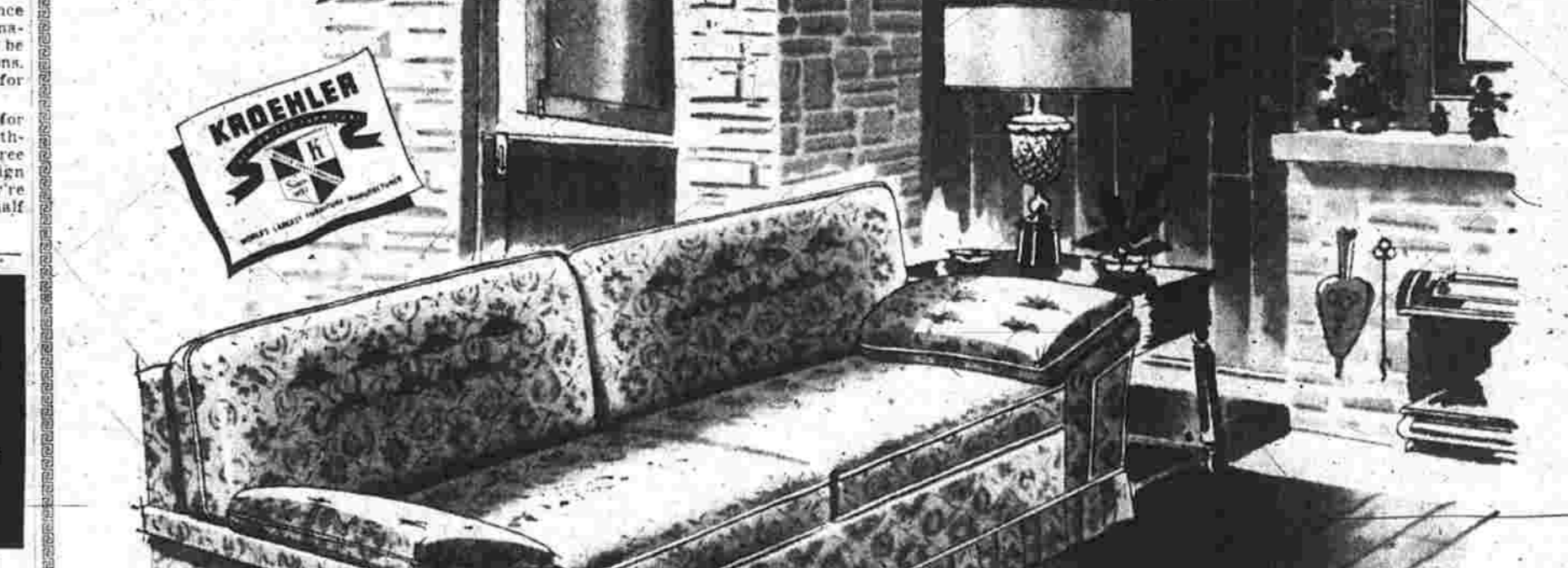

Reports reaching Tel Aviv said a contingent of U.N. liaison officers had already crossed into Gaza at Bataf and that the bulk of the U.N. troops would enter soon afterward. ### College Heads Study U.S. Scholarship Aid

Chicago, March 6.—The Association of Higher Education (AHE), representing some 16,000 colleges and university presidents, today voted to support a resolution proposing that the federal government take part in a program of scholarships for able and needy college students. Little opposition to the resolution was expressed at the association's national conference, but another proposal affecting American parents' pocketbooks was considered today to produce some hot floor debate.

The controversial resolution called on the association to re-examine its present position on a federal income tax credit for payment of tuition and educational fees to tax-exempt credit colleges, to be offset by an increase in the tax on interest and dividends. Opponents of the "credit plan" contend that it would not benefit approximately 40 percent of families whose income is so low that they pay little or no tax.

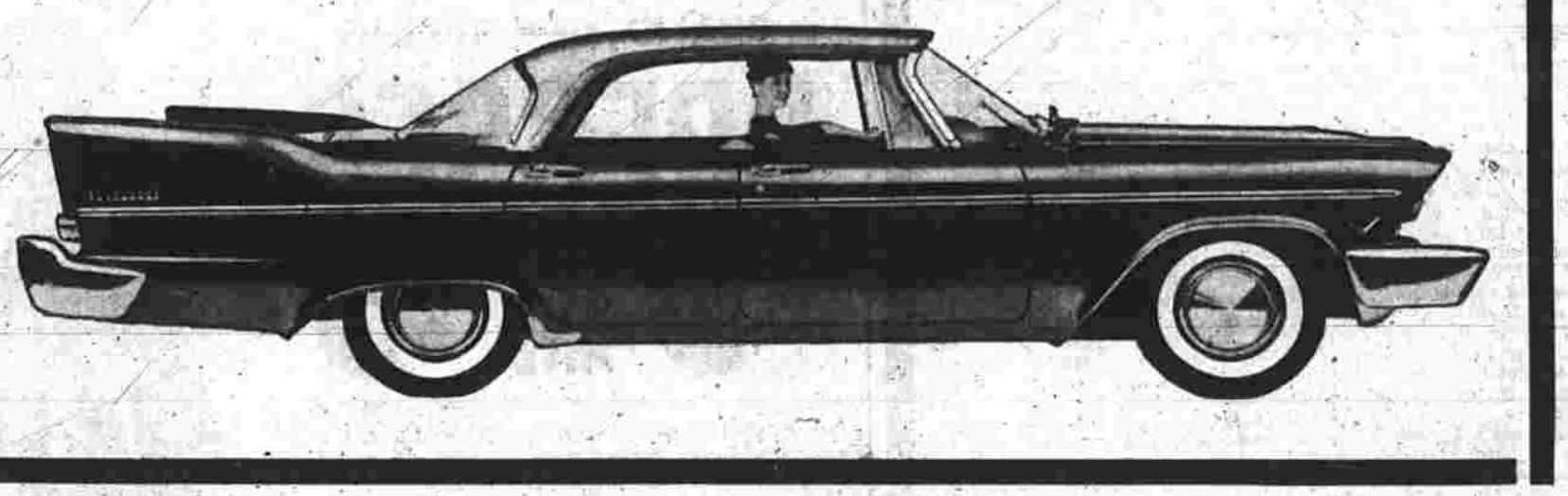

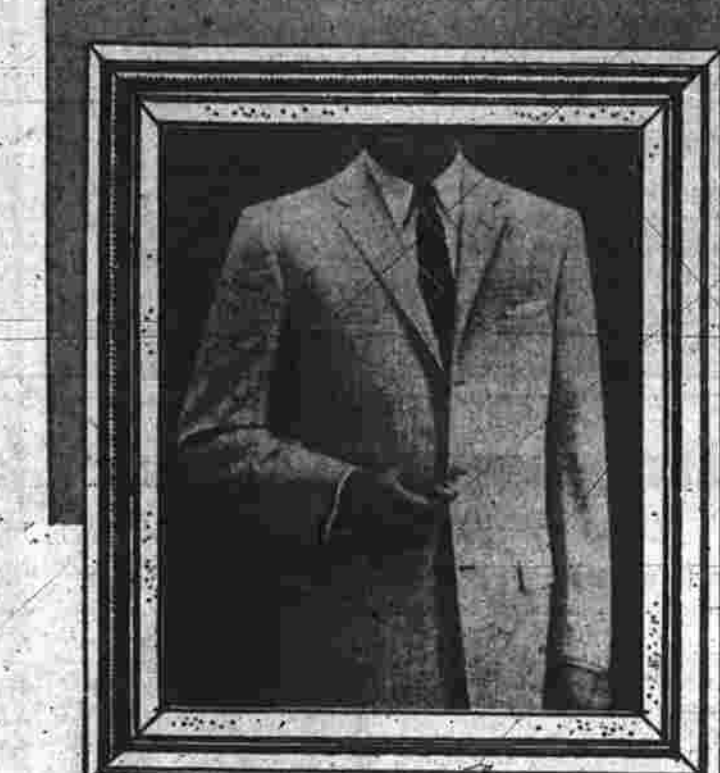
