## Your Income Tax Primer

(Second of 13 Chapters)  
By RICHARD A. MULLER, Written for NEA Service  
The first step in filing out a tax return is to decide which form to use. This year, as in the past, there is the regular form called Form 1040, printed on a check-sized card, and the 4-page letter-sized form called Form 1040-1.  
Form 1040 can be used in one of two ways:  
1. By using the tax table on the back of the official instructions which automatically gives your tax without having to figure your deductions or exemptions.  
2. By computing your own tax using the tax computation schedule on page 2 of the return.  
Every taxpayer can, if he chooses, use the more complicated Form 1040. Most taxpayers are 1040-1.  
Before you can wisely decide which form to use, you should know:  
1. What income you must report.  
2. What deductions you are entitled to.  
3. What credits you can claim.  
Succeeding articles in NEA's Income Tax Primer will show you how to determine your income, deductions, and credits. Article 11 will give you detailed help in choosing the best form for your use.  
Every year many taxpayers fail to take advantage of all the tax breaks which they may be entitled to.  
Any taxpayer who was married on Dec. 31, 1956, can file a joint return with his or her spouse. In almost all cases it is advantageous for married persons to file joint returns.  
If, however, both spouses have substantial income and one has large capital losses or medical expenses, separate returns might give a lower tax than a joint return. The best way to tell in such a case is to compute your tax both ways and then use the cheaper method.  
If your husband or wife died during 1956, you are considered married for the entire year, and may file a joint return provided your income and the income of your deceased spouse.  
Any widow or widower whose spouse died in 1954 or 1955 can also compute the tax for 1956 as if he or she were filing a joint return provided:  
1. He or she has not remarried before Jan. 1, 1957.  
2. He or she supports a child or step-child in his or her home, and the child is dependent on him or her.  
3. He or she was the head of a household in the year of the spouse's death.  
This tax break is designed to help the surviving spouse in the difficult, early years following the death of the husband or wife. It cannot be claimed on Form 1040A.

## Budget Items Before Board

Four routine budgetary matters will be taken up by the Board of Directors Tuesday in connection with financing the remaining months of the fiscal year.  
The Board will be asked to pay the way for approving the sale of \$1,400,000 in fiscal year bonds Thursday by adjourning its meeting until Thursday evening.  
Bids on the bonds will have been taken earlier Thursday.  
And General Manager Richard Martin will ask the Directors to approve the sale of some \$500,000 in notes in anticipation of receiving the money from the bond sale.  
That \$100 million will be needed to finance the town's operations until April 10 when the bonds will be delivered and the \$100,000 collected.  
The Board will be asked to approve an additional appropriation of \$2,500 for insurance by transfer from the appropriation for the Housing Authority. The agency is available in the Housing Authority and the insurance bill is higher than anticipated.  
Explains Method  
General Manager Richard Martin said that the increase in the insurance bill is due to the method of determining the premium on the town's comprehensive liability policy.  
That premium is estimated at the beginning of the year. As the town's assets and liabilities increase, and this increases exposure, added coverage is automatic.  
At the end of the year, the inventory is audited and the premium is determined.  
The fourth budgetary matter is appropriation of \$1,000 to the New School for the Administration.  
That account is used to pay such expenses as the salary of clerical help in conducting the new school construction.  
Since the account is financed by the various bond issues, for new schools, the additional appropriation is a bookkeeping matter.  
In other matters, the Board will hold a public hearing on changing the name of Hookman Circle to Cherry St., and consider a bond swap with Dr. Walter Schwartz of the University of Connecticut.  
The Dr. Schwartz wants to purchase the land on which the University of Connecticut is located. Dr. Schwartz has a lot of about the same size nearby he is offering to trade.

Another officer was held in the street for perjury and racketeering charges after an investigation of a gambling, and illegal liquor sale.
