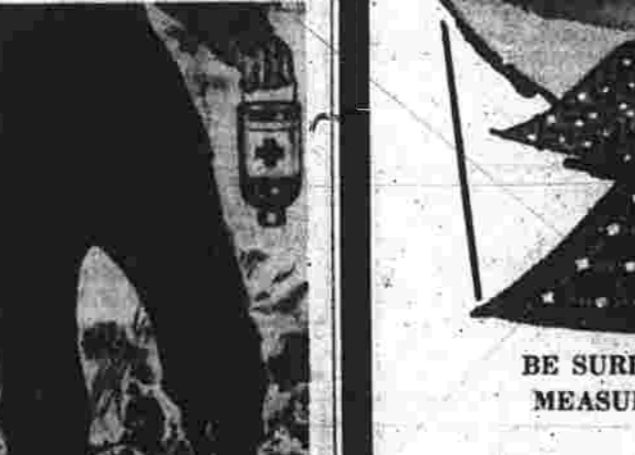

And thus the word "boycott" originally came into use, and became a household word.

"Bohr, of course not, but I've been told it's supposed to be lucky whether you believe in it or not."

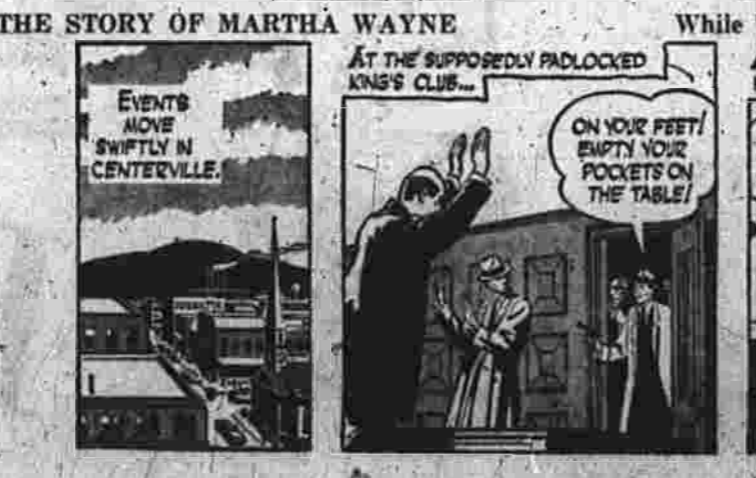
