UConn Study First of Kind In 20 Years

Hebron, March 19 (Special)—The suburbanization study of Hebron which is anticipated to be launched next week will be the first such study conducted by the Rural Sociology Department of the University of Connecticut since it pioneered in the field of suburbanization studies about 20 years ago.

Dr. Robert G. Burnight, who will direct the Hebron study, said that work done by Dr. N. L. Whetten in the mid-30's has been used as a model for additional studies conducted by other groups throughout the country.

Dr. Whetten headed the Rural Sociology Department until last July and is now dean of the graduate school.

Whetten's original work concerned three localities: Windsor, in relation to its development as a suburban area for Hartford; Williston, in Fairfield County, and its development as a suburban area for New York City; and the outlying areas of Norwich.

In conducting such a study, Whetten said, "various developments are usually considered in two categories: 1. The physical development which takes place close to a major town, which researchers term limited rural urban fringe and, second, the relatively new type of development which grows from a work center, termed the extended fringe, or known as bedroom towns.

Whetten's size and population were the determining factor in his plan for the Department study.

"We are primarily concerned with the development of a commuting town," he said, "and what organizations serve this type of community."

Regional School Considered

When asked what bearing the regional school would have on the study, Dr. Burnight said it was entirely likely that the research conducted now might be used as a "benchmark" for future studies.

At this time, there is no guarantee such a study can be made, but the present work at the school opens would afford an excellent opportunity for future studies.

Three field workers will be trained at the University this week for the Hebron assignment where they will work under the direction of Mrs. G. Lowell Field, research assistant.

The interview schedule was presented in Andover last week. Dr. Burnight said to gain information which will be used in final preparation of the questionnaire. Information obtained by the field workers will be completely confidential with final results presented in statistical form.

The cross reveals the heart of God. It is an emblem of sacrifice. It reflects His evaluation of man's sin. For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. Christ upon the cross is the reality of all that was symbolized in the ancient sacrifice which foretold the shedding of the Blood of the Son of God. The Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

"On the other hand, the Cross of Christ reveals the power of sin. It interprets sin. It exposes sin in its true perspective. Its teaching, its mastery, that men would go to the extreme measure of putting to death that tremendous price of crucifixion the world's greatest Benefactor, the world's greatest

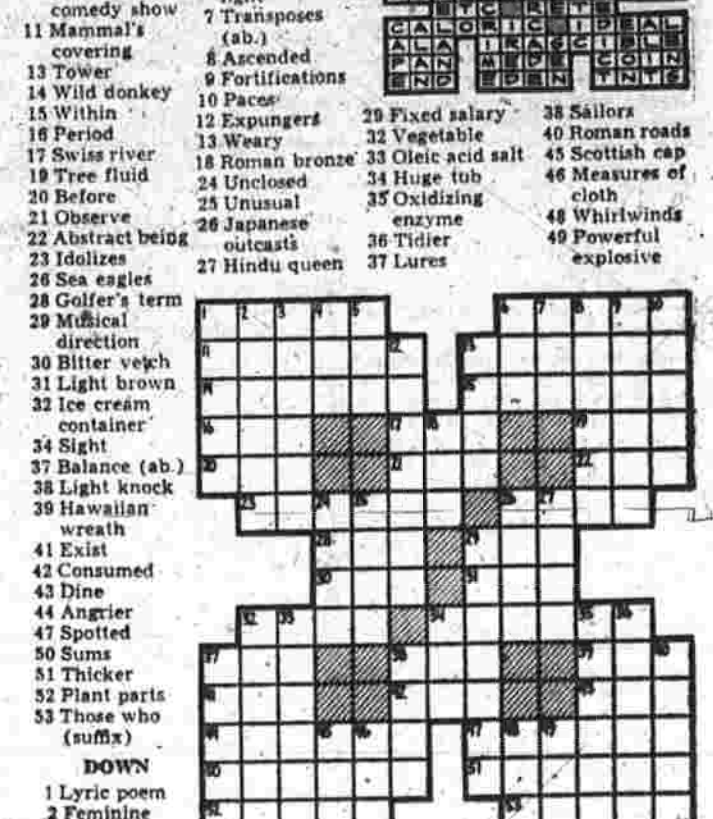

Rockville Residents' Approval Needed

On Outlay of \$10,000 for CD

Rockville, March 19 (Special)—The Common Council last night agreed to call a special city meeting for an approval of a \$10,000 appropriation for Civil Defense (CD). At the same time, Mayor Herbert G. Olson presented a plan for demolishing Peeterson Mill, selling the mill property and the recreation field for a shopping center, and incorporating CD headquarters in the new high school. The mayor also announced a bequest of about \$20,000 from the John E. Peeterson estate, which could be used for a recreation building in Henry Park. The money would constitute the Little Peeterson Memorial Fund and must be used within the city limits for a fountain, tower, or some structure of a permanent nature for public use. The \$10,000 appropriation was asked by Edmund F. Dwyer, CD director, for renovation of Peeterson Mill as CD headquarters. The town approved a similar amount Feb. 18. Both governments were asked to share the renovation expense because the building is owned by the city and town. Half the amount is returnable from the federal government. The Council, in approving the appropriation, purposely omitted mention of the Peeterson Mill so that the fund could be used on any building for CD.
