general was in Damascus with five other high-ranking Jordanian officers.
In Baghdad, Iraq's Parliament discussed foreign policy in secret session. Premier Nuri said was reported to have spoken about relations of Iraq, a member of the pro-western Baghdad Pact, and linked to Jordan by royal blood, with other nations of the Arab sphere.
The new cabinet is expected to press a swift and thorough cleanup of Jordan's government, and to deal with the situation that have induced public agencies.
Observers also looked for King Hussein - flanked by his military victory over Leftists leaders - to invite James P. Richards, President Eisenhower's special envoy, to Amman to explain the President's Middle East Doctrine. There was no clear indication, however, that Jordan would subscribe to the American plan aimed at halting Communist penetration of the Middle East.
With the formation of a regime purged of Communists and extremists, Hussein emerged from the 6-day crisis with new strength and stature. For awhile it had appeared the Leftists would come out on top, but a dramatic display of loyalty by tough Bedouin troops of the Arab Legion turned the tide.
The Bedouins, who formed the hard core of the British Legion, swarmed into the capital yesterday from strategic points to stop the seven hills surrounding Amman. Security police loyal to the young monarch also were out in force with riot equipment.
Bolstered by this support, Hussein summoned all former prime ministers, senators and some deputies to the palace. They emerged after three hours with a 7-man government headed by Hussein's brother, King Talal, and Fakhri Khaldi, 61-year-old former minister who has shown sympathy toward the West.
Sworn in with him were five other moderates. The seven cabinet members included Suleiman Nabulsi, head of the big National Socialist party and premier of the anti-western government Hussein threw out last week.
Nabulsi's inclusion, as foreign minister and communications minister, indicated the King still had to depend to some extent on support from the former premier's party, which controls 13 of the 40 seats in the chamber of deputies.
But officials said privately the "shoigu" cabinet should last long enough to clean out Leftists permeating the government administration and schools. The purge already has begun, but it was not clear yet how far it has progressed.
Nor was it certain whether the purge would bring out street mobs that could cause another crisis. It was believed the next 24 hours might be decisive. Most observers felt, however, that any Leftist demonstrations would be put down quickly.
Reports circulating in neighboring Syria that anti-Hussein politicians had fled to the countryside to provoke public resistance could not be substantiated in Amman. Instead, a return to normalcy was gaining momentum under Nabulsi's regime.

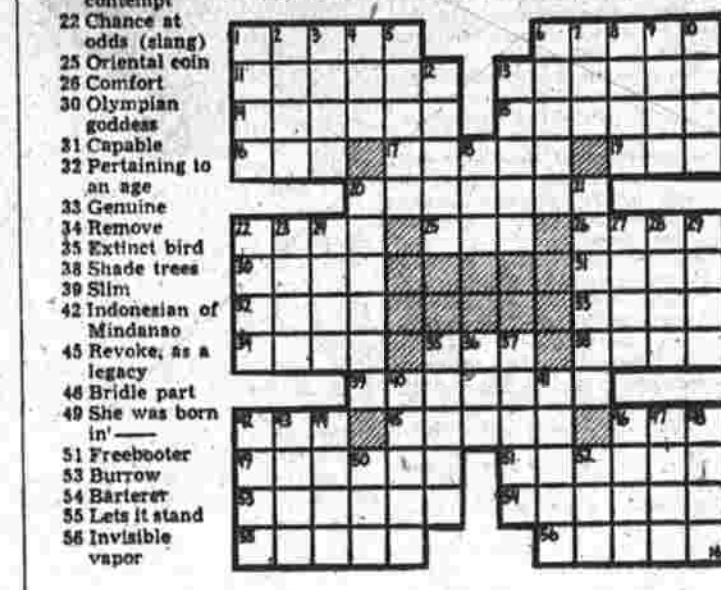

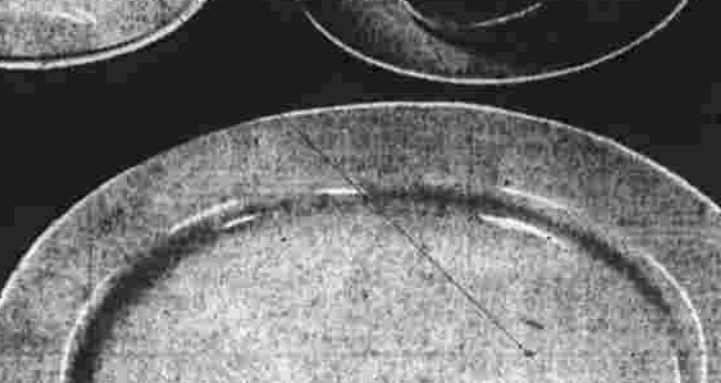
