Rockville Council Votes to Cut Taxes, Rate of 14 Mills Approved

Rockville, May 14 (Special) — While other towns worry about rising tax rates, this city can look forward to a drop of one and a half mills in big rate. The prospect here is "bitter-sweet."

The proposed tax rate will be presented to the adjourned city meeting in June. It represents a drop of one and a half mills from the current 15.5 mill rate.

The tax decrease is apparently made possible by an increase in the grand list of \$1,136,000 over the 1956 total. Also, the amount to be raised by taxation this year is \$277,741, which is \$14,881 less than the amount raised last year.

Re-Appoint Rate Maker
Mrs. Catherine Moran was re-appointed rate maker for the current fiscal year at an increased rate of \$1,136,000.

Other matters discussed at last night's meeting of the Common Council included the appointment of plumbers and heating contractors to the job of installing a water filtration system.

During the Common Council meeting last night, the mayor reported to have Councilman Hamner's legislative action allowing the city to purchase the water company, if it decides to do so.

The action was taken on the suggestion of Rep. Franklin G. Welles after Mayor Olson reported the committee's recommendation at the Public Utilities Commission hearing last week on the proposed sale of the Rockville Water and Aqueduct Co.

The city, Mayor Olson said, is seeking a deferral of the PUC's decision in order that the ownership of the company might be considered. "If we have enough people show up at the hearing we can get a deferral," he said.

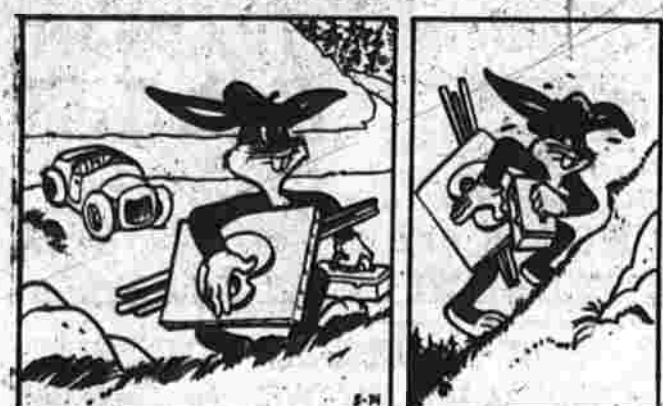

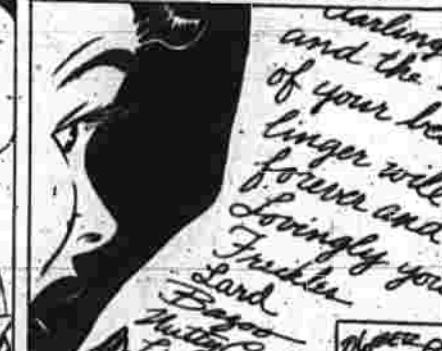
