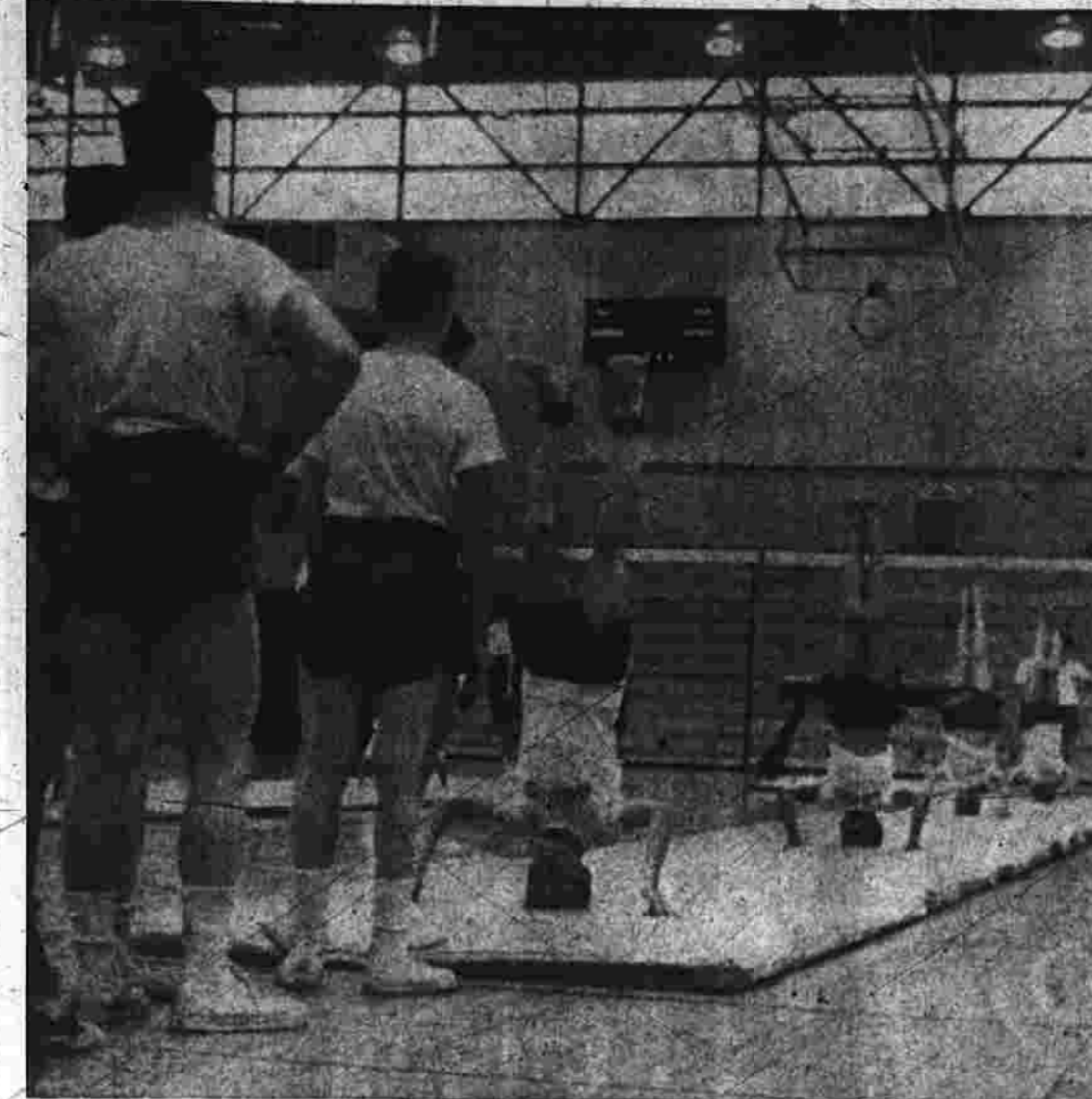

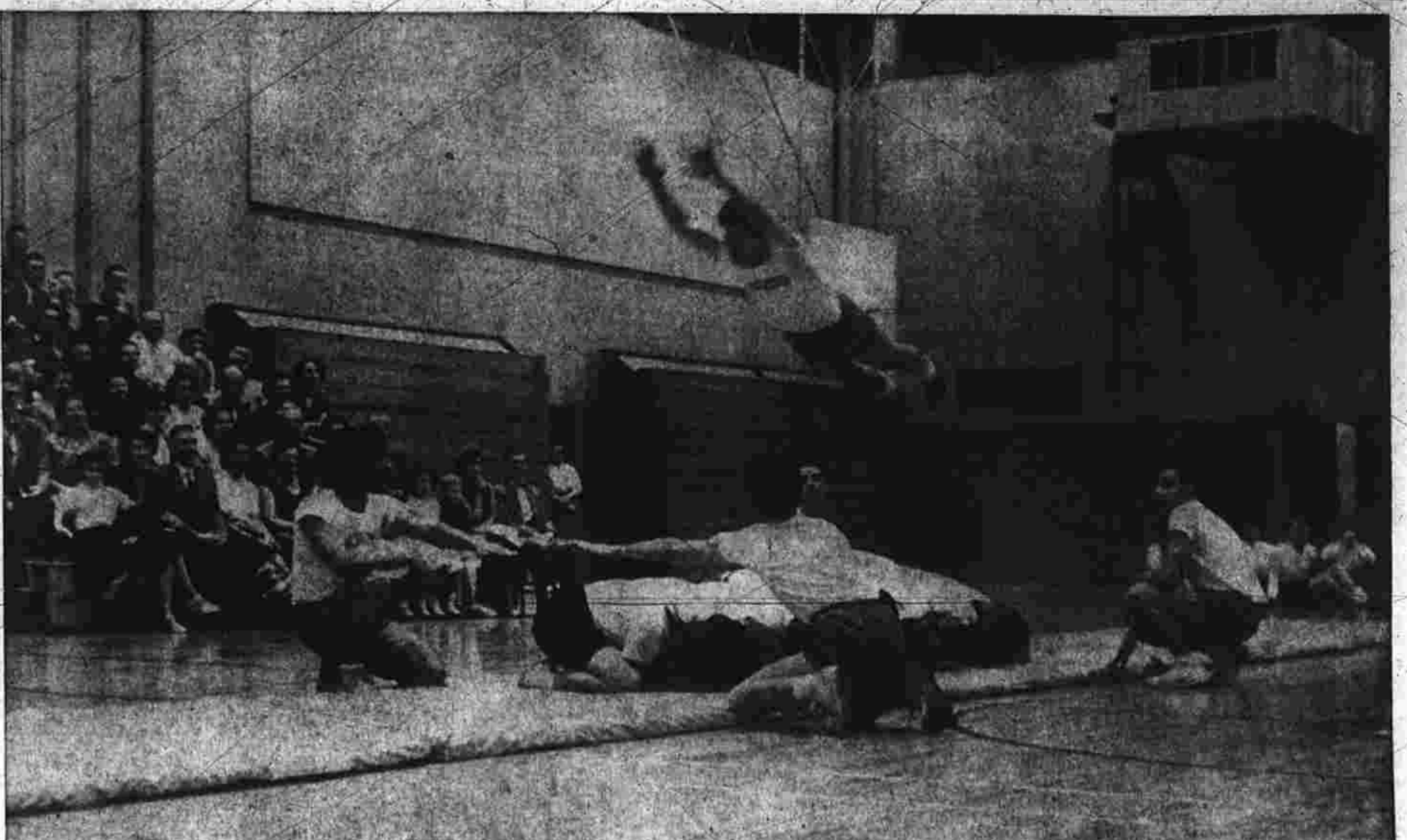

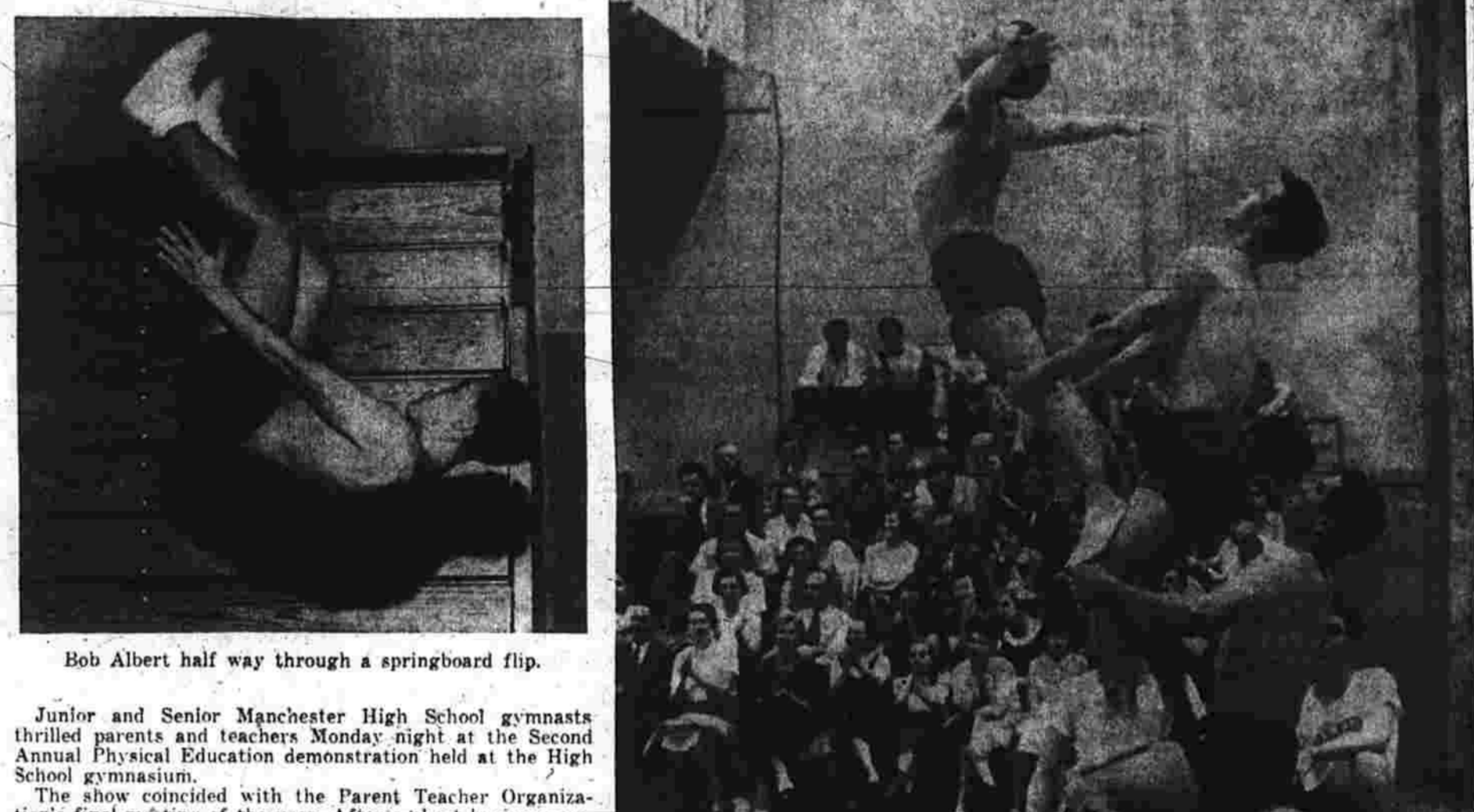

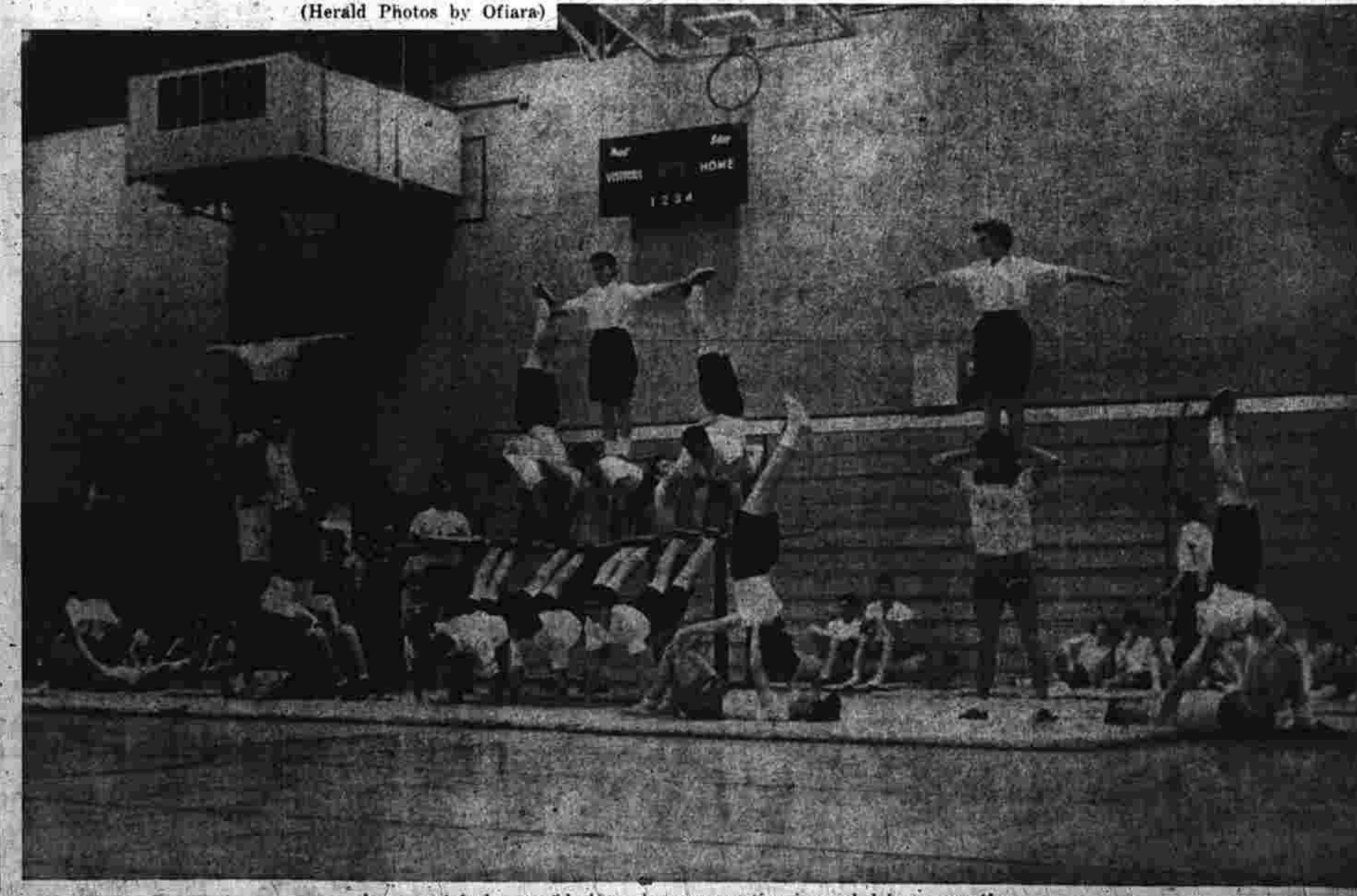

14 Hungarians To Die For Plot To Ditch Kadar

Budapest, May 16 (AP)—A Communist court today sentenced 14 Hungarians to death and a life imprisonment for allegedly killing Red police and trying to overthrow the government of Premier János Kadar.

Three other defendants were given prison terms ranging from 5 to 15 years.

All appealed to the supreme court.

The 21 defendants took part in a protest demonstration against the Russian and the Soviet-imposed Kadar regime that fell in the north Hungarian town of Miskolc.

More than 110 witnesses were heard in the month-long trial which began April 11.

Provincial Hungarian papers received in Vienna reported that Pastor Ivan Basko of the Hungarian Reformed Church at Nagyrev has been sentenced to five years in jail for making political speeches.

In the Senate, party lines held firm and the veto was wiped out 24 to 14 on several occasions.

As for a petition signed by 410 Oxford residents protesting the veto yesterday by a top-heavy 150 to 53 with 23 Republicans joining 28 Democrats in backing the Governor's veto.
