(Continued from Page One) Significant of the Navy's intention to avoid provoking an argument with the Chinese Reds in the area was the Navy's statement that immediately after the Red battery opened fire, the American pilot changed his course to the eastward, which would have taken him in the direction of Formosa.

The United States generally subscribes to the 3-mile limit concept of what constitutes a nation's territorial waters. But Russia, for instance, maintains that her rights extend to at least 12 miles. Because of the inability to get unanimous international agreement about the extent of territorial waters and airspace, Navy planes and ships have standing instructions "to keep well clear" of any area which another country might consider to be private domain, unless diplomatic permission has been obtained to cross closer.

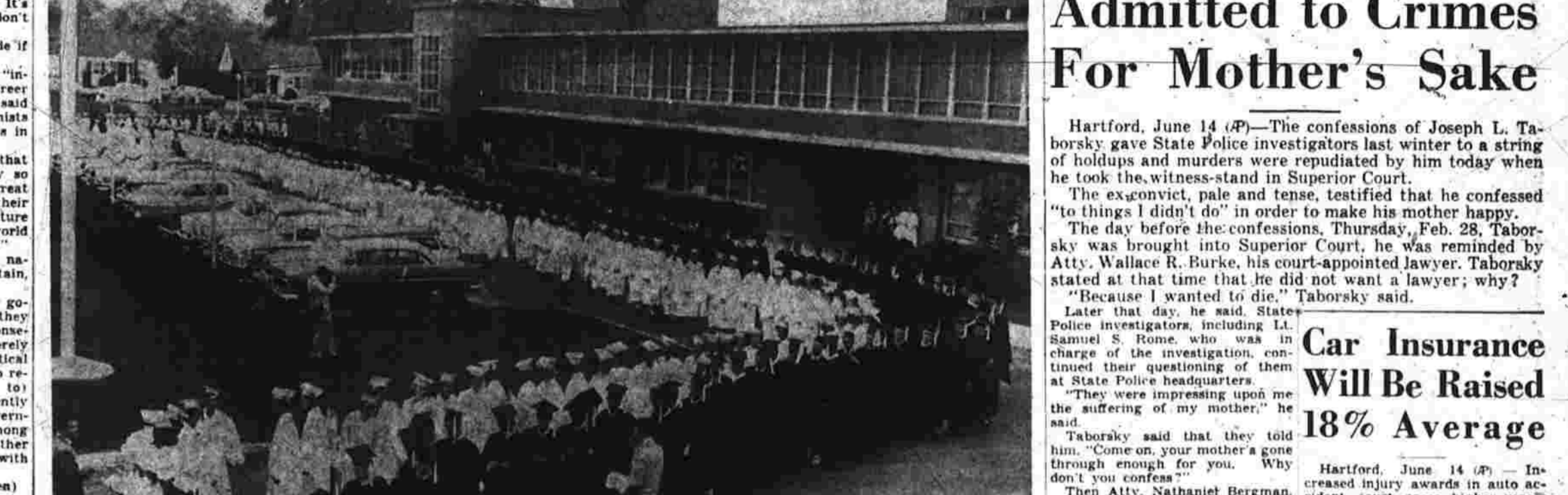

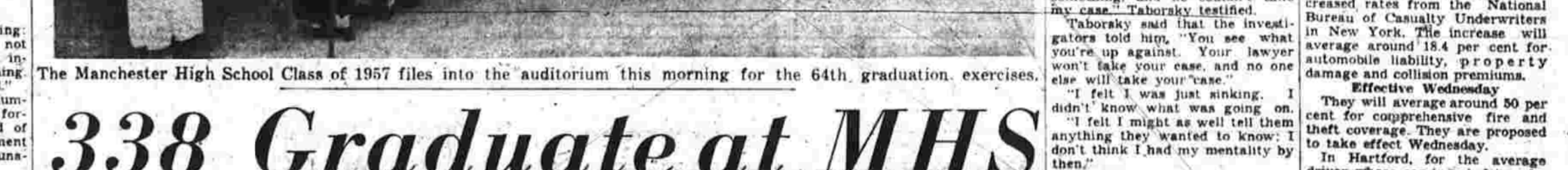

Joseph L. Taborsky, accused murderer and holdup man, sits at a table during his testimony in Superior Court today.



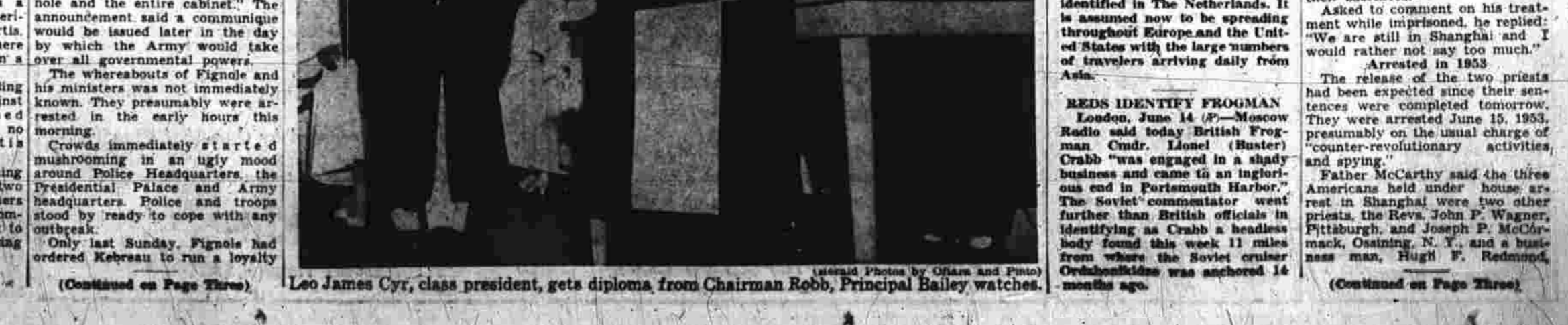
