Coventry Man Appeals \$10 Fine for Family Feud

Coventry, July 20 (Special)—A man who was fined \$10 for disturbing the peace after a quarrel with his wife in Coventry, Conn., has appealed the fine to the Superior Court.

The man, who was identified as John J. Smith, 44, of 124 S. Main St., was charged with disturbing the peace after a quarrel with his wife in Coventry, Conn., on July 15.

It resulted in a conviction and a \$10 fine on a breach of peace charge for one local man, who immediately appealed the case to Toland County Superior Court.

The charges grew out of a June 23 incident in which Strick pulled up from what was reportedly his own land a mailbox and newspaper-tube belonging to Herman D. Smith, also of R.I. 4A, and laid the two containers down on the street.

There followed an altercation during which Strick allegedly took a swing and allegedly struck D. Smith. D. Smith, in turn, allegedly raised his fist in a "fighting" posture.

"I've been waiting for this a long time," as he approached Strick at the scene of the row.

Fight Prevented

Between the two men, law enforcement officers intervened and prevented a fight.

Strick was held in Coventry Jail pending a hearing on his appeal.

Atly, John Specter of Willimantic, Conn., is expected to appear in court on behalf of Strick.

The hearing is expected to take place on Monday.
