Junior High School Decision Goes to Voters Tomorrow

Coventry July 31 (Special)—The question of building a junior high school will be settled by a referendum vote tomorrow when the polls will be open from 8 a. m. to 6 p. m. This action was made mandatory by a petition presented at the special town meeting last week. The petition, was signed by all legal voters and filed with the town clerk's office July 24.

Advantages Listed The Board of Education has favored the construction of a 16-room junior high school claiming that such a building program would develop a solid school system and would provide for a separate administration of a junior high school program. The building would release grades 7 and 8 from the present facilities and allow for the expansion of grades 1 through 6 up to the year 1960-61. By retaining grades 7, the board feels there would be a saving of money on transportation for students to out-of-town schools.

The move would also lighten the load carried by Windham and Manchester High Schools. In hopes these towns would continue to accept local high school students for a longer period of time. There is great possibility that this expansion program will carry the town through 1961-62, according to a board study report.

The board has presented figures of state grants for construction with a figure of \$500 per pupil for elementary school construction.

The estimated enrollment for 1957-58 is 1,116 and is expected to increase to 1,500 by 1961-62.

### Reds Warned On Spies for United States

Throughout the Communist era, people are being told to beware American spies.

Such concerted campaigns often have foreshadowed internal complications. This one may mean the loose ends of the latest Kremlin purge have not been tucked into place, and more jolts are due.

The Soviet press and radio lead the chorus. Soviet propaganda organs have been telling the public regularly that American agents are trying to get political, economic and military information from "talkative people."

In Indonesia, the Communists in North Viet Nam gave big publicity to the arrest of a group of alleged saboteurs in the American service.

Activities elsewhere in Czechoslovakia several groups accused of being spies for the Americans have been arrested with attendant publicity. The Czechoslovak Communists have a mobile exhibit, supposedly illustrating the activities and equipment of foreign spies.

East Germany has announced the arrest and trials of persons plotting sabotage and of students accused of spying for U.S. Intelligence.

Hungary, with a wave of arrests linked to last fall's revolution, claims to have uncovered 40 groups working as agents for western powers.

Poland has arrested a German on charges of being an agent of the U.S. Intelligence service, seeking information on Poland's defenses.

Bulgaria has lodged spy charges coincident with a purge in its armed forces, and Albania frequently announces the discovery of spy nests.

In Red China, a Shanghai court imprisoned a group accused of working economic, political and military information for the United States. The Red Chinese made a display of pistols, signal apparatus and forged documents. The Soviet campaign warns of agents in the guise of diplomats. Moscow Radio's home service said recently:

"The more long journeys to the United States, the more we know of many acquaintances as possible to obtain the information they need from talkative people. The most useful discovered of the American Intelligence are hatters and braggarts."

The broadcast, like many organs of the Soviet press, said American Intelligence needs the services of "unstable and decadent elements," particularly among young people and intellectuals. These agents, it added, put out provocative rumors against Soviet political leaders.





### Dynamite Safer When Radioactive

Ottawa, Ont., July 31 (AP)—To make dynamite safer, add a little radioactivity.

That idea is being promoted by the Canadian Mines Department. It has perfected a method of putting radioactive antimony into dynamite sticks.

Mines and others handling the explosive can use a Geiger counter to locate sticks which have failed to explode or have been misplaced.

The report says researchers have found that breathing the dust which is more effective than the standard method of breathing into a paper bag and less expensive and simpler than trays which keep the dust from falling into the eyes.

Officials say the antimony iodide is inexpensive and has no health hazard. It contains only sufficient radioactivity to last over a reasonable period of storage. One part of radioactive antimony is used to 50,000 parts of dynamite.

### New Tube Made For Lung Cancer

An article in the American Medical Association's Journal reports that a "dead-space" re-breathing tube has been developed that may offer a simple, inexpensive and effective method for preventing or delaying the collapse of the lung.

Such collapse is a common and often dangerous complication after surgery on the lungs, in which secretions collect in the lungs and block the air passages.

The report says researchers have found that breathing the dust which is more effective than the standard method of breathing into a paper bag and less expensive and simpler than trays which keep the dust from falling into the eyes.

### Cars Light Field For Landing Plane

Middleboro, Ky. (AP)—Hearing an airplane circle about the town at night, residents here knew what to do.

One hundred motorists headed for the airport, lined up their cars on either side of the landing strip, and kept their lights burning.

The pilot made a perfect landing and out stopped at Middleboro Agricultural university, and was taken to a clinic in Knoxville, Tenn., where he is recovering from his injuries.

The airplane has no facilities for night landings.

### New Tallow Uses Sought

Twenty-five Western tallow-rendering firms have banded together, each contributing a part of its profits to a research organization to develop new uses and outlets for tallow.

The United States Department of Agriculture, university and tallow packers have produced new ways to use tallow that are taking 18 per cent of the nation's tallow production, or about 500,000,000 pounds a year.

27 Firms Given Big Tax Rebates

Washington, July 31 (AP)—Twenty-seven American corporations won federal tax rebates in excess of a million dollars each during 1956, the Congressional Committee on Internal Revenue taxation reported today.

They topped the list of taxpayers who received individual refunds or credits exceeding \$1,000,000, totaling \$13,364,346 for the year.

The company getting the biggest single rebate for 1956 was the American Vacuum Corp. of Philadelphia, with refunds and credits totaling \$20,267,220.

The law requires the treasury to notify Congress before allowing any tax refund or credit in excess of \$100,000.

Although the 1956 over-\$100,000 rebates were in the nine-figure bracket, they were the smallest since 1947 and nearly 300 per cent less than 1953's total of \$12,232,696.

The peak year so far is 1951, when refunds and credits reported for 1950 represented claims on years going back as far as 1945.

The rebate of the late Lamont Du Pont was granted a refund of \$803,053 as the largest non-corporate return. Mary Ethel Pew of Philadelphia was granted \$227,200; Warren J. Shreve of East Chicago, Ind., \$226,891; and John and Fannie K. Hertz, Cary, N.C., \$108,262.




