Duvalier Leads Haitian Voting

Port Au Prince, Haiti, Sept. 24 (AP)—Dr. Francois Duvalier rolled up a top-heavy lead in presidential election returns today and a losing candidate hinted at violence.

Unofficial counts in heavily populated rural areas indicated that the 48-year-old Negro doctor was winning there by about 10 to 1.

Duvalier claimed victory last night. His headquarters indicated he was sure of more than 60 per cent of the 1,300,000 votes cast Sunday.

Former Sen. Louis Delor, Duvalier's principal opponent, hinted that there might be widespread disorders. Some of his supporters threatened to burn the capital if he lost.

Delor charged widespread fraud. He charged that his followers had been harassed by mass arrests and intimidation.

Scores of sullen Haitians clustered about the porch and lawn of Delor's home here awaiting word from their leader, a 63-year-old mulatto plantation owner. He gave no indication he was about to concede Duvalier's election.
