Thirty minutes later, a second Marine battalion task group was to land at Kesan in 45 helicopters, the largest 'copter force ever used in NATO exercises,

The 50-ship U.S. Sixth Fleet was reinforced by 7,000 Marines and 40 warships from the United States for Exercise Deepwater, at the eastern anchor of NATO defenses. The practice beachhead is across Saros Bay from Gallipoli, where British invaders suffered terrible losses in World War I.

In theory, the Americans had embarked hurriedly at East Coast ports and crossed the Atlantic and Mediterranean to help drive away an unnamed enemy who seized parts of Turkey and Greece in an all-out atomic attack a month ago.

Two Boards Discuss School Specifications

Specifications for the proposed are on the verge of instructing North End junior high school were discussed by the Roard of Education last night.

The special metting was called to review the desires of the school board and hear more accurate enfolment estimates.

Arthur H. Illing, superintendent of schools, first presented a list of the number of students in the system at this time, together with an estimate of how many there will be at the junior high level in 1985-66.

"These figures are more reliable," he said, than those the Board had at the time the specifications were first made. They show at least the numerical needs of the school.

According to these figures, the normal capacity of the present high school and Barnard Junior Fligh is 3,800. By 1985-66 the number of junior and senior high students will total 4,485.

Weant Expandable School Illing said that the Board of Education wants to build the junior high so that its immediate capacity is 750 students with allowance for expansion to meet the needs of 1,285.

Members of both boards then reviewed the specifications. The school will be located on a 25-case site between E. Middle Tpkc. and Hollister St.

It will have, besides the usual business office, principal's and vice principal's offices, classrooms, gymnasium, cafeferis, and science rooms several features which drew suggestions from the Board of Directors.
