The 44-year-old Hoffa had been due to take over the union presidency tomorrow from retiring president Dave Beck, who said he would resign to clear the way. Beck's term extends to Dec. 1. Hoffa's election was held in a hotel in New York City. Hoffa was elected by a vote of 10,000 to 7,000. Hoffa's election was challenged by a group of Teamsters who said they were not allowed to vote.
