Rockville, Oct. 15 (Special)—City officials are continuing their efforts to gain control of the local water supply by establishing a metropolitan water district. Their action is being taken despite the unfavorable decision of the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) and the resultant transfer of a majority of Rockville Water and Sewerage Co. stock to Suburban Water Services, Inc.

Mayor Herman G. Olson told the Council last night that that decision of Vernon, Ellington and Tolland have agreed in many two representatives from each town to establish a metropolitan water district.

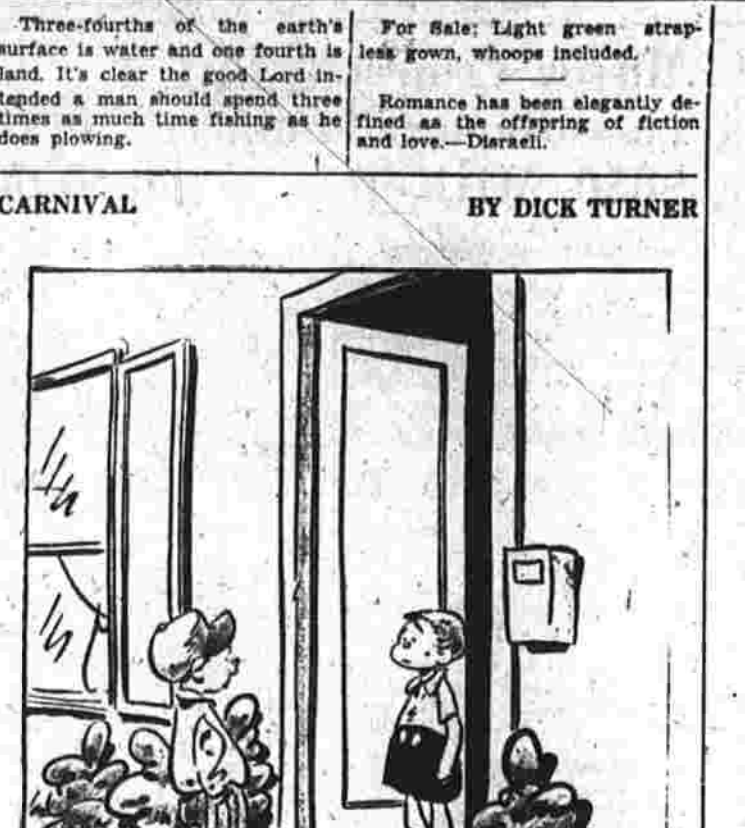
