Key Spokesmen Disagree On State Outlook for '58

By GEORGE MACKIE Hartford, Dec. 30 (AP)—With unemployment in Connecticut now pushing toward the peak reached at the height of the 1954 recession, what will 1958 bring?

To some extent it depends on whom you ask. A check of a half dozen key spokesmen in business, labor and government brought replies ranging from downright pessimism to guarded optimism.

There seemed to be general agreement on three points: (1) No body can make a downright prediction about the economic future with any degree of certainty; (2) Conditions aren't likely to get better in the immediate future; (3) It is within the next few weeks, and there is little danger of a longer range, massive 1930-type depression.

Market is concerned, said Raymond C. Smith, president of the Connecticut Chamber of Commerce. Joseph M. Bourke, secretary of the State Labor Council, also predicted a recession in 1958.

Chairmen have not been announced for a corn and hot dog contest for September and a chicken barbecue for October, both to be held at the clubhouse.

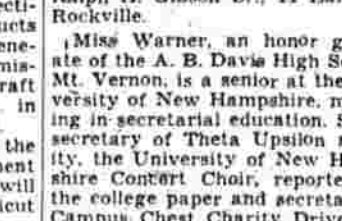

Some Rates in Crowell House

Three of the eight private rooms in Crowell House, the self-service unit of Manchester Memorial Hospital, will be converted to 2-bed rooms and the rates on all rooms by the start will be increased slightly.

Announcement of the changes was made this morning by Miss Elizabeth J. Crowell, administrator of the hospital.

The new rates will be \$11 per day for a private room and \$10 per day for a semi-private.

The cost of all rooms is now \$6 per day in Crowell House. The rates in the main hospital building are \$19 to \$23 for private rooms, and \$18 for semi-private.

The addition of the three beds brings the total number of beds at the hospital to 277.

The changes were approved at a meeting of the Board of Trustees Dec. 17.

Patients in Crowell House are ambulatory. They are either in the final stages of recovery from serious operations, or they are undergoing diagnostic and therapeutic examinations. Patients with heart and dietary troubles as well as a host of other ailments also stay in Crowell House.

The self-service unit was established by Edward Thoms, the hospital administrator, in April of this year. It is part of a 3-stage program in which special attention is centered on the problems of the ambulatory, the routine, and the convalescent.

Crowell House is located directly across the street from the hospital proper on Hayes St. Patients in Crowell House are ambulatory. They are either in the final stages of recovery from serious operations, or they are undergoing diagnostic and therapeutic examinations. Patients with heart and dietary troubles as well as a host of other ailments also stay in Crowell House.

New York Bus, Tube Strike Off

New York, Dec. 31 (AP)—The threat of a new year's Eve transit strike that could have paralyzed the city evaporated today with a City Hall contract settlement.

Delivery from the threat of a walkout on the city's transit system was lifted at 4:40 a.m. by Michael J. Quinn, Transport Workers Union (TWU) president.

Transit Authority reached tentative agreement on a 2-year contract providing a 22 1/2-cent-an-hour wage increase.

Then, with the pattern set by City Labor Commissioner Harold A. Felix, the transit workers agreed to a 22 1/2-cent-an-hour wage increase.

The agreement called for wage increases ranging from 18 1/2 cents an hour over two years.

Subject to Union Vote

Both men and women are subject to union membership ratification.

Combined, the two groups are expected to handle almost 10 million tons a day.

After settlement was reached, Quinn spoke the words that nullified the strike and the men returned to work at midnight tonight.

Everything will continue rolling smoothly until the end of the year.

Workers on the subway and the city's bus lines are expected to receive a 15-cent wage increase
