Your Income Tax--No. 5
You Can Forget Some Income,
But Make Sure It's Non-Taxable

EDITOR'S NOTE: This is the fifth in a series of articles on your income tax. It lists the income you do not have to report to the IRS. It is for reference when you fill out your return.



1. Gifts. This includes money or anything of value for which you performed no service whatsoever.

2. Dividends on G.I. life insurance programs. Any 1007 income you had which falls into one of these categories is beyond the reach of the tax collector.

3. Prizes and awards (as distinct from gifts) are exempt from taxes only if they are given in recognition of civic, literary, artistic, educational or scientific achievement.
