Schoolboy Hobby Turns Cellar Into Well Organized Snake Pit

COLUMBUS, Ohio (AP) - Man's best friend may be his dog, but 12-year-old Kraig Adler is partial to pythons. In fact, he's probably the only high school senior in the country who could be late for school and get away with the excuse: "I was sitting up with a sick snake." Young Adler's interest isn't limited to pythons. His cellar spans the whole range of reptiles. Included are 20 specimens of snakes, lizards and turtles. They're kept in glass-front cases lining the walls of the basement in his home. New "races" appear from time to time as the young herpetologist (student of snakes) buys or sells specimens. His collection presently is valued at about \$1,000.

Started With Chameleons. When Kraig, at the age of 10, bought his first chameleon, he thought it's doubtful his family realized it would lead to such additions as a 4-foot python (non-poisonous) and a black mamba (a viper from the "Tartar stapes of Russia, a skink (water lizard) and possibly the only monitor lizard (2 1/2 feet long) in the United States. "The main reason I keep my poisonous reptiles at the Columbus Zoo is to protect the people who come to see my collection," Kraig explains. He has a snake bite kit around the house, but neither he nor his parents, Mr. and Mrs. William C. Adler, and his brothers, Gary 14 and Bruce 11, have had to use it.

Reptile collecting has led Kraig into a number of sidelines. He studies foreign languages to keep up his extensive correspondence with a growing number of collectors all over the world, including Russia. CART BRIDGE ON THE WATERWAY TO WIN DIFFICULT HAND. By Alfred Sheinwold. The best way to make a certain kind of bridge hand is to throw the lead right back to the enemy. Dore then to best you, and perhaps they will find a way to go wrong. When this hand was played in last year's world championship match, both hands got to a point in no-trump. The champion declarer went down against a spade opening lead, as well he might. The Italian declarer, Giorgio Belladonna, succeeded in winning 12 tricks against the same spade opening lead! West opened the five of spades. East put up the king, and Belladonna won with the ace. He could count eight spade tricks, but he therefore led the test of spades right back to East. He didn't expect to fool anybody by this. If the opponent took his spade tricks, perhaps a spade opening lead would develop at the hand. Actually, there was no spade, but the result was even better. East led the second trick with the jack of spades and thought things were quite clear, and so South's reason for leading the ace of spades was not to take advantage in taking the spades and then giving declarer the rest. It would seem, too, that in the normal course of municipal business a project like that for the swimming pool could also be financed over current taxes, even if that should mean delaying the project for a year.

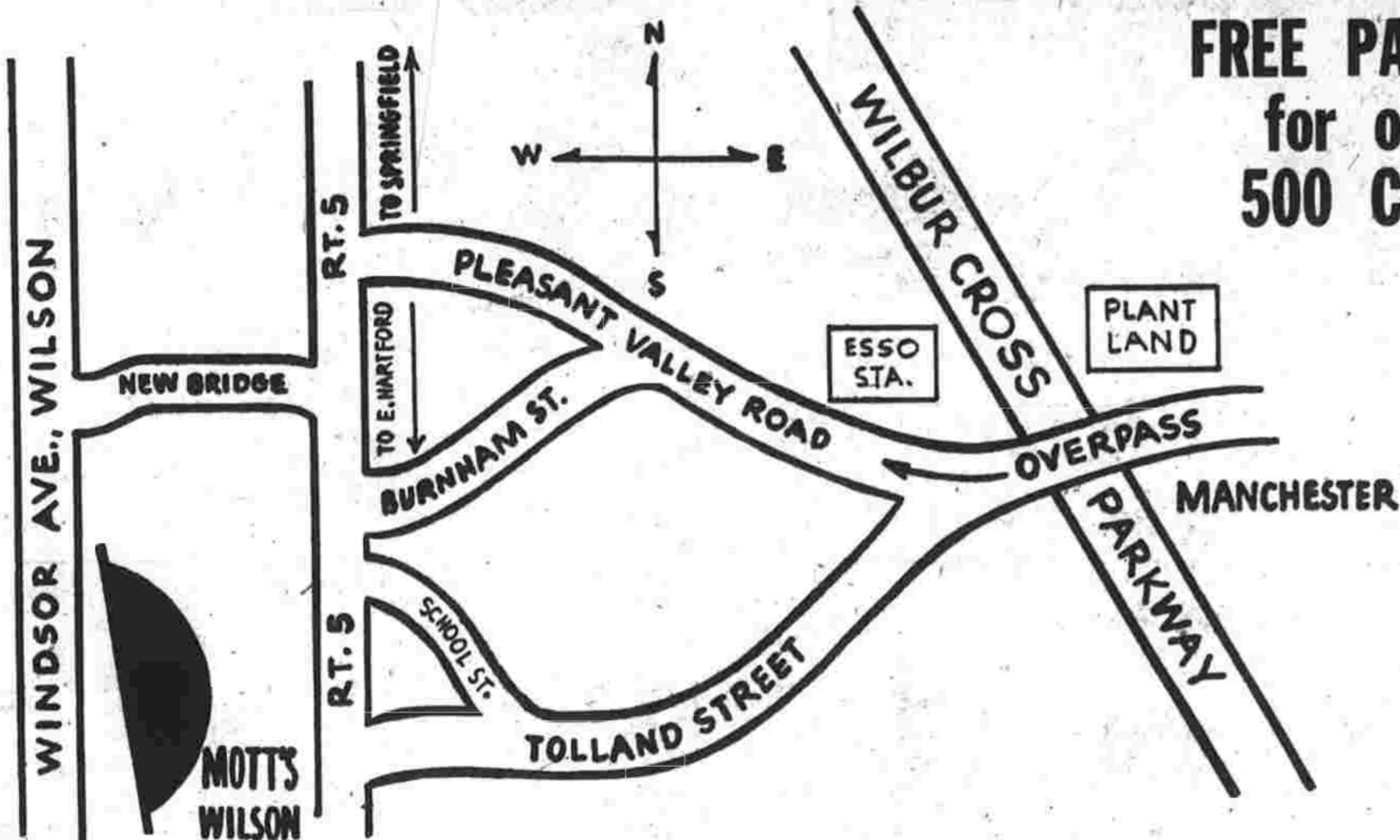

Mighty trees were falling under the ax in Manchester this week. They were coming down under a new tree removal contract between the town and the Carter Tree Remo- val Co. of Vernon.

The company's contract calls for removing 24 branching elms, maples and other old-timers obstructing sidewalks and roads, for \$1,991.60.

One dead elm is 47 inches around and the average diameter is 34.2 inches, according to Tree Warden Horace Murphy. More than a day's work will be required to remove some of the stubborn ones, Murphy said.

Notices will be posted on the tree trunks five days before the removal date. Within that time, a written protest may be made to the tree warden who has authority to call a hearing.

Owners of adjoining property have asked for removal of the trees to be taken under the Carter contract.

Carter's was the second lowest of seven bids received on an original bid of \$2,000. For the original number, the Carter bid was \$2,050. Other bidders and prices were: Dibble Tree Co. of East Hartford, \$2,805; Oscar F. Warner of Waterbury, \$2,114; Walgren Tree Expert Co. of West Hartford, \$2,370; Charter Oak Tree Co. of West Hartford, \$1,425; Allen Tree Service of Thomaston, \$3,480; and Henry M. Davis Bros., Inc. of North Haven, \$2,313.45.

The low bidder's offer was not accepted because the firm did not hold a certificate from the Connecticut Tree Protection Examining Board which licenses tree workers in the state, Murphy said. This was one of the specifications for the contract.

Carter's original bid was cut by \$58.60 when one tree was removed from the list.
