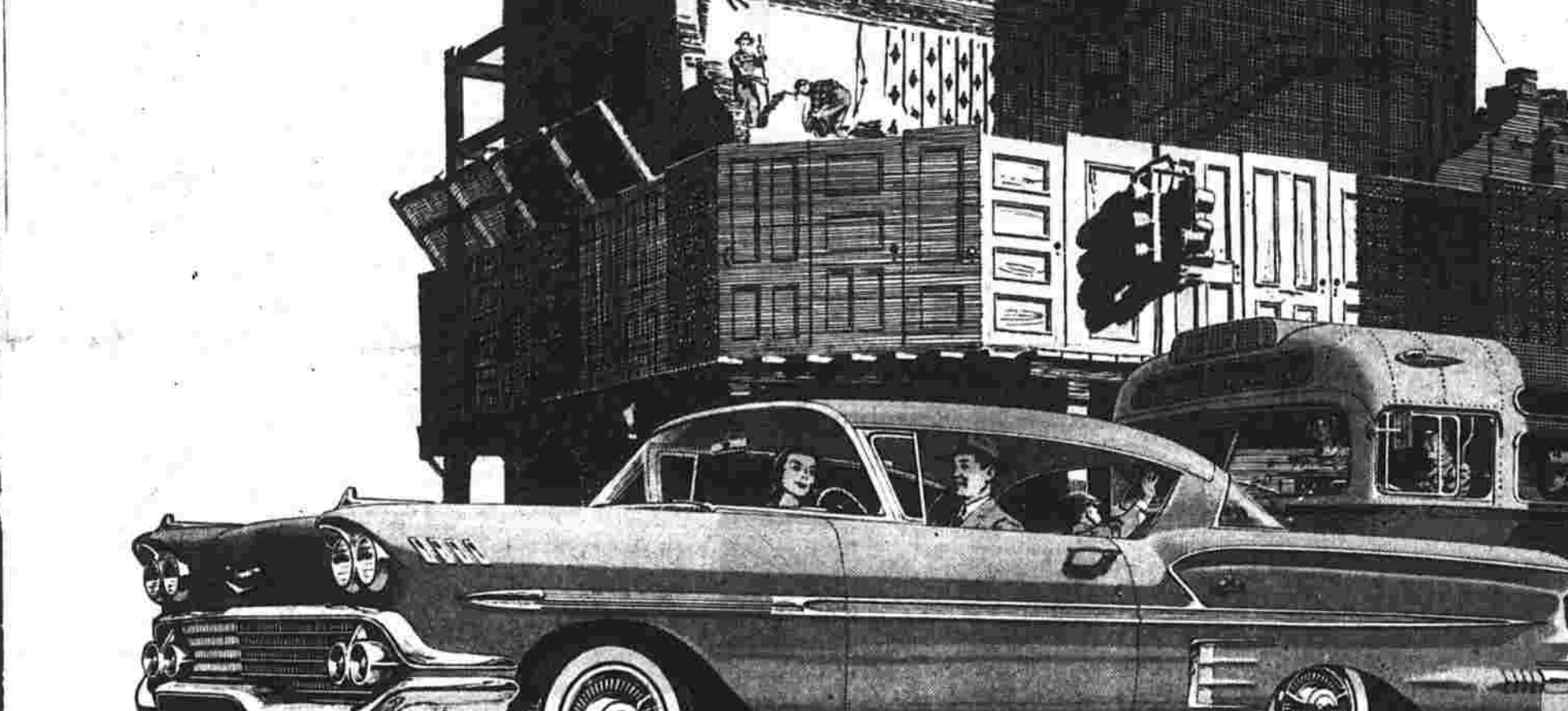

the two countries. But by the same token, the fact that the two countries went to such pains to negotiate it is an indication that there is a willingness as well as a desire, to reduce those tensions, despite the continuing arms race, the name-calling and the threats that both have been guilty of.

The subject of exchanges was first discussed at the Geneva summit conference in the summer of 1955—two and a half years ago—and the Big Four foreign ministers tried to negotiate an agreement that fell but failed. The subject was revived last fall, however, with the job of negotiating a settlement left to special U.S. Ambassador William S. R. Lacey and Soviet Ambassador Georgi Zarubin. And these two trained diplomats went at it for three months before the compromise agreement—the first successful U.S.-Soviet negotiation since the Russian record of 1955—was reached.

Political scientists and policy makers in the two countries can draw from the history of this negotiation what conclusions they wish as to whether it would be better to hold a summit conference on major East-West differences before or after lower-level talks have resolved those basic differences. But the exchange agreement serves as a useful reminder that agreement between the United States and Russia on difficult matters is still possible, that the cooperation needed to reach agreements can be fueled by each country's desire for them.

In the meantime, an increased number of Americans and Russians are going to be learning a good deal more about each other's homeland. And this fact, as much as any other, may help hasten the day when the governments of the two countries find the desire, sincerity and perseverance needed to reach basic settlement.

Good Work at Ankara
 It rather looks as if Secretary of State Dulles has made a good handling of our relationship with the Baghdad Pact. This regional alliance, which he authored, but which we do not dare join for fear that our doing so would create more trouble than it would cure, is perhaps the most worthless of all the paper Maginot Lines we have erected against Russia. But to abandon it outright would, perhaps, be considered a retreat and weakening of our stand in the world.

It is to be doubted that Mr. Dulles realizes the worthlessness of something he himself created. But it would seem, from his conduct at Ankara, that he at least recognized our task as being one of avoiding either retreat from or new starting commitment to the Pact.

The members of the Pact, reportedly opened this meeting eager for two things—our own formal joining of the organization, and much greater economic aid from us to the Pact members. Mr. Dulles, somehow, seems to have left them satisfied without our membership, and without much more than a token assurance of new economic aid. It is true that he gave various verbal assurances of American military support in case of Communist aggression against the members of the Pact. But these assurances are actually inherent in our position everywhere in the world.

We have thus neither abandoned the Pact nor sharpened its importance, either of which courses might have been dangerous, but seemingly left it in a state which will not make it too difficult for the Pact to meet what should be the eventual fate of all these regional pacts on both sides of the world struggle. That eventual fate should be a withering on the vine while the world tries some saner and more efficient method of guarding the peace.

There were even, in the final communique from Ankara, encouraging references to the United Nations, the potential world system of law and justice and peace for which these regional alliances have so far represented rivalry and sabotage. The members of the Pact said, in their communique, that they looked to the United Nations Charter and principles for the ultimate security of their area. That it is a healthy adjustment of attitude. It is also realistic. For if trouble should come to this area, it would be the United Nations, and not the Baghdad Pact, which would have the only real chance of dealing with it successfully.

A U.S.-U.S.S.R. Agreement
 Perhaps the most helpful observation to be made of the United States-Soviet agreement to increase cultural and technical exchanges is that negotiation by the two countries can still be fruitful.

The agreement itself does not by any means disintegrate either country's iron curtain. Russia is not yet willing, for instance, to permit uncensored explanations of United States policy over Soviet television or radio. And neither side is willing to open up its country to completely free travel by the nationals of the other.

But the agreement, if implemented, can drill some holes in the curtains through which some much needed fresh air can penetrate. It provides for limited exchanges of broadcasts and films, to be approved in advance, and of teachers, students, technicians, artists, athletes, journalists and tourists. In addition, it indicates that direct air travel between the two countries is a distinct possibility.

That such an agreement should even be necessary—and that it should be as circumscribed with restrictions as it is—is a measure of the tensions existing between
