By JOHN M. HIGHTOWER, Washington, Feb. 7 (AP)—Secretary of State Dulles joined in today in publicly expressing hope for an improvement in Soviet-American relations.

Dulles did this while on a photographic tour with the Soviet Ambassador, Menshikov, in the city of Washington.

The unusual display of friendship took place at the State Department where Menshikov, who arrived in a Soviet jet airplane only yesterday, conferred with Dulles this morning.

Menshikov said he was sure Dulles would be received by President Eisenhower in a friendly and cordial manner.
