They gave the money to Mr. and Mrs. George Peters, parent of Joe and Tommy, who turned it over to Mrs. Alfred Sorochi, March of Dimes drive chairman in Columbia for the past 12 years.

Mr. Peters said the four youths had saved the money all this time to donate specifically to the March of Dimes drive.

The youngsters are pupils at Horace W. Porter School.

The donation brought the total amount contributed to \$700. Mrs. Sorochi and the coin card committee Wednesday night opened all coin cards received in the mails which had accumulated since the drive started.

It has been a policy of hers to let the coin cards accumulate and competition.

FBI Probes Charge Of FCC Member Fix

subpoenaed from Whitehouse, who said he had a reputation in Florida as a "fixer." Schwartz said Whitehouse represented Public Service Television, Inc., which had been granted for Miami's TV Channel 10 in a hotly contested case. Public Service is a wholly owned subsidiary of National Airlines.

Whitehouse denies charges. Denial came quickly from Whitehouse in Miami.

"Schwartz is a fixer," Whitehouse said. "He has had me 'fixed' anything in my life and that he was never employed as an attorney in the Channel 10 case."

Whitehouse also issued a statement saying Mack was an old friend and that he had loaned Mack money of \$25,000 for 20 years. Whitehouse also said he had records of Mack's \$25,000 loan.

As for the Channel 10 case, Whitehouse said that in September 1956 he recommended to Mack that Public Service get the award. He said he did so at the request of Robert H. Anderson, then a lawyer and now a circuit judge. He said Anderson is a "friend of long standing."

Schwartz said yesterday that Anderson, at the time the TV case was pending, was a member of the law firm that Schwartz said handled the Channel 10 proceeding for Public Service.

Schwartz quoted Anderson as telling subcommittee investigators that he had hired Whitehouse in the case.

Whitehouse said he was recommended by Public Service because he had the "fix" on the case. He said he was a "friend of long standing" and general reputation in the community of persons involved in the application.

He said subcommittee investigators never had interviewed him but that he had made a sworn statement to the House group.

Mack was one of four commissioners who voted for Public Service, overturning an FCC examiner's recommendation that the Channel 10 grant go to another applicant. Two commissioners voted against public service, and one abstained.

Mack is a Democrat, was appointed by Eisenhower to the bipartisan commission.

The contest for the Miami TV channel started in 1953 and was decided by the FCC in February 1957.

Electron Wire Recording. Yesterday, Harris received a large manila envelope from Ben Morse (D-Ors). Harris said the envelope contained some papers and a wire recording which Schwartz said had been delivered to Morse by Mrs. Schwartz Tuesday morning. These were separate from the files delivered the previous night to Morse by Schwartz and later returned to the subcommittee.

Schwartz said the recording was of a long conversation between Mack and a subcommittee investigator, who had concealed a small recorder in a briefcase.

Dewey Withholds Files. In another case, Schwartz testified that former New York Gov. Thomas E. Dewey refused to turn over to subcommittee investigators records of his law firm on a case before the Civil Aviation Board.

The files were sought in connection with an accusation—denied by Dewey—that his firm got a \$150,000 fee for "illegal services" in helping Eastern Airlines get a New York-Mexico City route.

Schwartz said he had prepared a very detailed memorandum stating what has happened in the matter and also that there were supporting documents.

In New York, a spokesman for Dewey's law firm—Dever, Ballantine, Bunbury, Palmer and Wood—said that the firm was "entirely proper" for it to represent Eastern or any other airline. It is a matter of public record that this firm was not retained by Eastern Airlines to appear before the CAB and did not do so.

The spokesman said the firm's 2nd-floor offices were headquarters for Eastern since Jan. 31, 1956—seven months before the CAB approved Eastern's application for the route in question. He said that Schwartz said the firm was in connection with that route, and that it never performed any "illegal services" for Eastern.

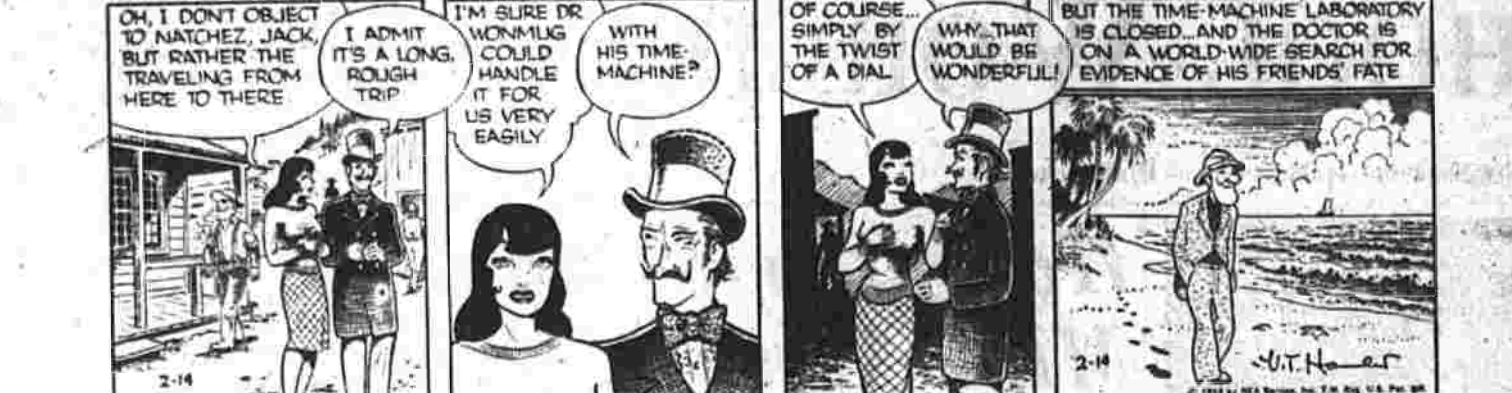

State to Sleep In Ice Box for Another Night

There's a popular saying that you can prove anything with statistics. The truth is the saying now applies better than in a comparison of the United States and Russia. Both are giant countries and both badly collect statistics. By judicious choice of coverage and use of limited facts, a poor relation can be made to look like a poor relation. In the principal consideration of the East-West battle, the statistics are interesting facts, significant and otherwise.
