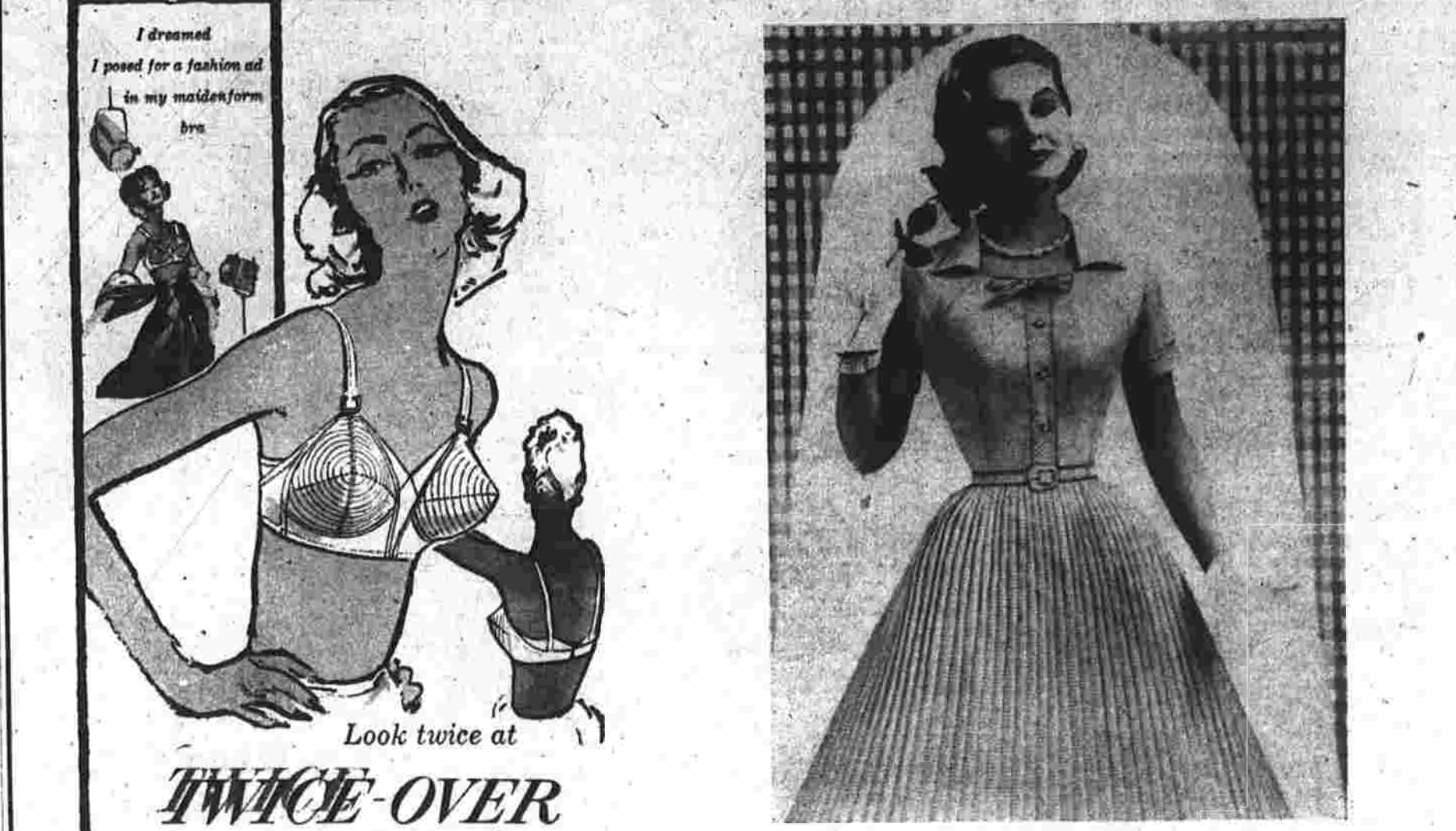

ruined to a hospital where I remained only two weeks and returned to work. The most amazing aspect of this recovery is that other members of the staff now constantly caution me to "take it easy," as though I were an old man.

I do not feel old, at any time. "Experiences" would be the more accurate word; because one must live to learn, or to be able to modify one's "beliefs" appropriately to new evidence and knowledge. If we aged folk cannot do so, it is not surprising when youth takes over in our stead.

Besides accurate knowledge and skills are always at a premium whatever our age. It is my conviction that "age" has no other legitimate authority than its knowledge and good judgment, and that age in itself is not worthy of veneration. It should, however, have little devotion.

The aged owe something to youth. About St. Ignace, Ignace, sharing wisdom, faith in them, encouragement, ambition for their absence of any feeling of competition but rather the spirit of cooperation.

**Only Comparative Term**

When the aged meet their obligations to youth they never grow old, even to young people. They remain "young" since "old" is a comparative term, after all.

The preceding does not take into account invalidism in the aged. Although experiencing serious illnesses, such as typhoid fever, pneumonia three times, broken bones even to a fractured skull, there were complete recoveries and no prolonged invalidism. The question arises, is not a large percentage of "invalidism" in the aged people mostly a state of mind?

Personally, I have never feared growing old. It seems more of a triumphant achievement. Obeying hygienic principles is likely to result in shorter physical discomforts and an adequate philosophy of life can minimize anxiety in most situations and instances.

From Her's Needed

In my own case, the greatest compensation for and comfort about growing old is being made to feel that I am needed, as much now as at any other period of life. This is a greater satisfaction than awards, recognition, reputation or power. It keeps one "current" instead of being regarded as a "has been." However, my own retirement was voluntarily and not forced.

I have always rejoiced at other persons' achievements, even in my own field, with no sense of competition. On the contrary, their success has assured me of the possibility of my own. This has gained me loyal friends and well wishers in turn. I take no credit for that. It is simply the "way I'm made." This is especially true of my attitude towards younger men, many of whom I have taught and encouraged, looking towards success when my own work is finished.

I have known riches, dire poverty, both in this country and in Europe. As a child I lived for some years on New York's East Side. It was not pleasant but highly instructive, and north, south, east and southwest of America are as familiar as my birthplace, Liverpool, England. But — people

A university student sat on a stool throughout the day and night while other potential buyers quizzed up behind him. He was provided with food and a sleeping bag by fraternity brothers from George Washington University. When the store opened at 7 a. m. the following day, he darted in, gave the clerk \$57 and got a 16-inch diamond-encrusted television set (nominal price, \$199) for Phil Sigma Kappa fraternity house.

One woman traveled from Youngstown, Ohio, to buy two fur pieces, one a silver-brown mink scarf, for \$10. In nearby Alexandria a 1950 automobile went for \$9 cents.

At a Washington furriers crowd was so thick a policeman was called. He ended up by buying his wife a bargain fur coat for \$39.

At one of the biggest downtown department stores, an estimated 8,000 bargain hunters crammed in during the first 15 minutes after opening and drove the clerk in the kitchen furniture department right up on top of a dining table.

# Herdic Making Two Budgets, One Including Union School

The Advisory Recreation and Park Commission last night approved Recreation Supt. James Herdic's budget request of \$112,021.50 to operate the town's Recreation Department during the 1958-59 fiscal year. The proposed budget did not, however, include appropriations for operating a Union School center.

Herdic's request for funds was \$22,121.50 more than the Board of Directors allotted the department during the year 1957-58 when he asked for \$109,725.58 and received \$90,500. It was also \$2,888.14 more than he requested a year ago. However, a \$5,000 low-approved increase in salaries and workmen's hourly pay rates makes Herdic's 1958-59 request some \$2,000 less than he asked for during 1957-58.

At the Feb. 4 Board of Directors meeting, General Manager Richard Martin suggested that an estimate of operating costs and possible facilities for a Union School center be made by Herdic for the department's budget hearing on March 11.

Department heads have until tomorrow to submit their budgets to the general manager.

Martin also suggested that specifications be presented for renovating the abandoned building, Herdic said today that, although the Union School was not included in the budget request, which he presented for Board approval last night, he was working on it and would definitely submit a second budget to Martin with the Union School center included.

Herdic told the Rec Board that the major increase items which go into the \$22,121.50 difference between what he is asking for this year and what he received last year, include equipment replacement and the cost of chlorine for the pool. He also said that the cost of the pool, as well as the salary and pay rate increase.

The Salter's Pond item is a transfer expenditure, Herdic said. Last summer about \$2,000 was spent on chlorine, an amount which was not included in the budget. Operating the pond, he said, is a continuing chore. Replacement of equipment totaled more than \$1,500 last year, he said.

# War Affects Cards

Schendel, a CD Advisory Council member, and Leon A. Thorp, council chairman, said last week that their appeal for a director had been answered by only one person. However, they both said that the person was what the council was looking for and they indicated that he would possibly accept the position.

However, the man, after viewing the CD setup yesterday and realizing the amount of time he would have to devote to it, withdrew himself from possible consideration," Schendel said today.

What General Manager Richard Martin, titular head of the local CD organization, and the CD council will do now is not known. "There's nothing we can do to further the organization until we get a director," Thorp said.
