Bolton Town's Tax Rate Unchanged; 36 Mills Set by Finance Unit

The town's tax rate was set at 36 mills for the current fiscal term by the Board of Finance at a special meeting held last night. The rate is the same as that in effect last year.

The rate is based on a taxable grand list of \$4,151,550 and is expected to produce \$220,776 in property taxes which fall due on May 15.

Although budget requests for the current year, which began Oct. 1, increased by \$20,000, the total amount to be raised by property taxes increased only \$10,000.

A \$500,000 loan in the 1957 Grand List at 26 mills provided the necessary \$130,000. The \$100,000 is already shown as anticipated revenue in the budget and is represented by the increase in state school grants voted by the 1957 General Assembly.

Ailing Men Need Women As Doctors

Chicago (AP)—What most sick men need in this country is a good woman doctor.

That's the conviction of 51 doctors on the staff of the Mary Thompson Hospital here, one of the two all-women medical institutions in the country.

Although the hospital stays close to its founder's concept of medical care "for women by women," men are welcomed into its doors. Male doctors are admitted to its consulting army of country staffs and 20 per cent of its patients are men.

"A woman physician can develop a closer relationship between the doctor and patient," says William C. Pfister, president of the hospital's board of trustees. "Women give a more personal, sympathetic service. We actually feel that our men patients recover better and faster with personalized care."

Antarctica Post Office Does Roaring Business

By RENNIE TAYLOR

At the South Pole (P)—A corner of the mess hall at the 107 station contains the post office with a magic name for millions of people around the world. It has the coveted postmark "Pole Station, Antarctica."

It is the target of stamp collectors everywhere. People strived by curiosity write to the station to find out how its 18 men live in the world's most hostile climate. The pigeonholes are for out-landish women write in the hope of striking up "pen pal" friends. And the station always gets letters than it receives. Stamp

collectors send their covers to the station in packages. The covers stamped and addressed by the messies according to the station or countries of their destination.

This means more work than the postmaster, Louis B. DeWitt, Navy commissary steward from Ogden, Utah, can do. So other men of the station, take turns helping him.

The stamp-collecting part of the operation has become so heavy that the Navy has imposed a limit. Individuals are told to no more than five covers in each consignment. However, some of them have circumvented this by sending packages of five to several of the men here.

It goes back unopened. Sometimes the scattered consignments from one person are collected, repackaged and returned to the sender, without benefit of the magic postmark.

From the financial standpoint, DeWitt says, the government is doing well on its polar post office. This is mainly because it has no scales that will weigh ounces or fractions of an ounce. A man who mails a letter here it costs guess its weight. To make sure it won't be stopped en route for insufficient postage the sender always errs on the side of generosity in using stamps.

Since Nov. 16, when DeWitt took charge, the polar post office has received 1,058 pounds of mail. In that time it has sent out 645 pounds of mail and has another 200 pounds ready to go. About 75

per cent of the output is addressed to stamp collectors.
