Salvagers Hope To Raise Ship Sunk in 1628

Stockholm — Salvagers hope to bring to the surface of Stockholm harbor the wreck of the Swedish man-of-war Vasa which capsized and sank Aug. 10, 1628, at the beginning of her maiden voyage. About 400 people were aboard.

The 120-ton galleon, a 6-decker, mounted 60 to 70 guns, most of them weighing about three tons each, which probably made her top-heavy. At least 17 of the brass cannons have already been brought ashore.

Missile Head Tells Zealots To Act Safely

Butterville, Ala. — Words of safety wisdom addressed to amateur rocketeers came from Major General H. N. Toffey, commander of the Army's Redstone Arsenal here.

"Don't experiment with liquid fuels like liquid oxygen, nitric acid, and gasoline at all," he said.

At the Arsenal's development work is carried out behind concrete and steel barricades, with plenty of distance between men and experimental materials, and propellants are mixed by remote control in proper containers.

The mixing process performed by a would-be scientist can be dangerous. "A couple of harmless drops of nitric acid mixed with a little alcohol makes a deadly weapon when combined," Toffey warned.

"Usually the simplest things make the worst propellants and equipment black powder is the worst of all."

Science teachers whose students are undertaking a rocket-building program are encouraged to write: Safety Officer, Army Ballistic Missile Agency and Redstone Arsenal, Huntsville, Ala.

Meanwhile a booklet stressing the safety aspects of rocket construction and firing is being prepared for distribution to rocket hobbyists requesting it.

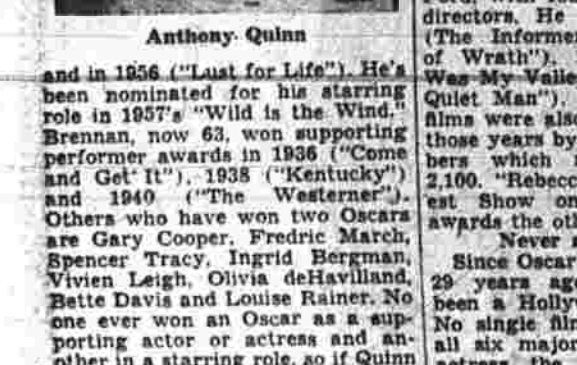

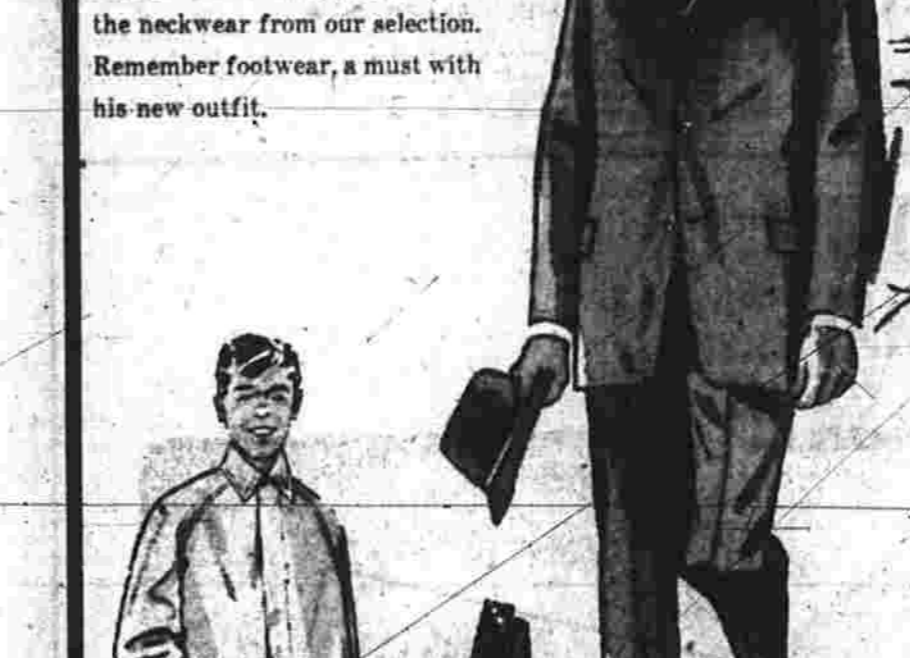
