Jet Tanker Fails Goal, Sets Mark

Omaha, April 8 (AP)—A sleek Air Force KC135 jet tanker landed at Lajes Field in the Azores at 10:25 a.m. (EST) today after a flight of 10,228 miles, a new world distance record for jet aircraft.

The jet stream velocity was added north of Hawaii and never picked up sufficiently again. Striking eastward from Tokyo after taking off at 3:38 p.m. (EST) today, the plane took a record flight of 15 hours and 35 minutes for the 10,228-mile flight to Washington, first leg of the trip.
