Reds Call Top Aides On Talks

London, June 16 (AP)—The Soviet ambassadors to the United States, Britain and France have been summoned to Moscow, presumably for consultations on East-West summit meeting and nuclear arms negotiations.

Ambassador Sergei Vinogradov flew to Moscow yesterday, the Soviet embassy in Paris announced. He left a day after conferring with French Premier Charles de Gaulle, who was given a letter from Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev.

Jacob Malik left his London post by plane shortly after it was revealed that Mikhail Menonikov had slipped out of Washington and headed for the Soviet capital.

Malik told reporters at London airport:

"I am going on business. When one goes to do business in one's own country, it is always a pleasure."

He did not disclose the nature of his business or how long he would be away. Ten officials of the Soviet embassy say his departure is a routine matter.

Recently the pace of diplomatic exchanges between Moscow and the West has quickened.

Khrushchev sent lengthy communications last week to President Eisenhower and Prime Minister Macmillan dealing with economic matters. Contents of these notes have not yet been made public.

The three western ambassadors in Moscow have been talking with Soviet Foreign Minister Andrei Gromyko.

1958 Vote Dim On Increase in Social Security

Washington, June 16 (AP)—The House Ways and Means Committee opened hearings today on social security revisions with a strong bias from Chairman Wilbur Mills (D-Ark.) that the committee would take no action this year.

The first witness, Secretary of Welfare Polson, backed this up, saying that any proposal for significant changes should be subjected to the most thorough and searching study.

However, Polson indicated the administration would go along with changes which have been proposed to increase benefits to some five million persons on minimum rolls and to enlarge the tax wage base from \$4,200 to \$4,800.

The committee has scheduled two weeks of public hearings on numerous proposals to broaden social security coverage.

Mills noted at the start of the hearings that "we admittedly have a relatively short time available for these hearings and this second session of the 85th Congress is well under way."

It may not be possible for the committee to act on all of the proposals, but the testimony will be available for one study and a possible basis for action during the first session of the Congress, Mills said.

Polson noted that revised estimates of public last week showed that the Old Age and Survivors Insurance Trust Fund will show a decline this year for the first time and will dip further during the next five years.

Urging careful and thorough study before changes are made in a program which is so far-reaching and complex, Polson said:

"It is therefore imperative, if we are to maintain the soundness and integrity of the social security system, that any benefit increases be financed fully and immediately by increases in tax revenues."

Polson made it clear he would support any such increase.

Man in Sharon Shot to Death

Sharon, June 16 (AP)—Robert Walters stood in his kitchen with his wife yesterday while their breakfast coffee brewed. Then, police said, his father-in-law shot him in the back with a shotgun.

Walters, 35, a factory worker, died moments later.

When police arrived, they found his 13-year-old father-in-law, Robert Porter, seriously injured with a gunshot wound to the head.

State Police said it was murder and attempted suicide.

Mrs. Walters, who watched her husband die, was unharmed. She uttered shock, however, and could not tell police all the details of the tragedy.

Porter was taken to Sharon Hospital, where he remained unconscious and in critical condition. Police did not charge him pending the outcome of his injuries.

Lt. William Meneer, commander of the Sharon State Police, said he had placed Porter in the hospital. He said he was going to attend church.

Mrs. Walters' 15-year-old son by a previous marriage, Edward

U.S. Embassy Families Move From Lebanon

Beirut, June 16 (AP)—American families had the go-ahead to move out of Lebanon today as the anti-government rebellion kept up a determined, bloody stand before U.N. Secretary Dag Hammarskjöld arrives to direct his international team of observers.

Bitter fighting broke out in the capital Saturday and continued yesterday until government security forces pinned down the insurgents in their strongholds at the center of Beirut. Heavy shelling stopped by noon, but sporadic firing and bombing were heard the rest of the day.

A bomb exploded across the street from the American University of Beirut this morning. Eye-witnesses reported there were no casualties.

In the report waiting to be sent to the Middle East since the 1956 Suez crisis, the U.S. embassy staff of 200 other Americans in Beirut were urged to stay off the streets.

So far no foreigners have been hurt in the month-old rebellion against President Camille Chamoun.

Two Walkouts Could Tie 700 U.S. Fleets

New York, June 16 (AP)—Two maritime unions struck today, refusing to sail without contracts.

The walkout of 1,700 engineers and 10,000 unlicensed tanker seamen could tie up nearly 700 American flag ships operating out of East and Gulf Coast ports.

The striking unions, the Marine Engineers Beneficial Association and the National Maritime Union, said negotiations would pick up again later in the day. Meanwhile, the engineers are employed on 44 dry cargo and passenger ships, the 10,000 seamen on 21 oil tankers.

There is no large passenger ship berthed here now and none is expected to sail before Wednesday. The walkouts do not affect ship at sea.

The Marine Engineers struck after the union rejected a contract offer by the dry cargo and passenger ship operators.

The strike hit the tanker arm when it was expected to be completed by the end of the week. The N.M.U. had tentatively approved a three-year contract covering about 30,000 unlicensed seamen employed on the dry cargo and passenger ships.

Another maritime union, the American Radio-Ship Association, representing 500 operators, reached agreement on a new contract with the American Maritime Marine Inspectors, representing the employers.

The settlement reached after an all-night bargaining session does not provide for any specific pay raises or increased overtime benefits. It does contain substantial improvements in vacation benefits, negotiators said.

The agreement also improves conditions for radio men aboard ships and provides for two wage reviews, at the election of either party, it was said.

Under the old contract the radio men received a 10 percent raise.

State GOP Weighs Governor Hopefuls

Connecticut Republicans meet in convention today to nominate eight top candidates for the November election.

But whether a gubernatorial candidate can be agreed upon by the 820 delegates in a question even veteran political observers are avoiding. A 6-man race for the nomination may lead to the first statewide primary election in Connecticut history.

The 2-day convention opens at 10 a. m. at the Bushnell Memorial auditorium, Hartford.

Voting for the eight top places on the GOP ticket will take place tomorrow.

It is the first of the two major political conventions in the state this month.

The Democrats, also faced with a possible primary election, convene in the same auditorium June 27-28.

Keynote Speech Tonight
Former Gov. Howard Pyle of Arizona, special assistant to President Eisenhower, will give the GOP keynote address tonight at 9 o'clock. Republican National Chairman Nease Alcorn of Suffolk will introduce him.

U.S. Senator William A. Purtell will introduce him.

He is expected for a second full term.

But none of the six candidates for the gubernatorial nomination enters the convention assured of becoming the convention's choice to run against Democrat Gov. Abraham A. Ribicoff.

Ribicoff is expected for his party's nomination. He is the only veteran now holding a top state office.
