Washington, June 17 (AP)—Sherman Adams pleaded "ignorance" when told today his friend Bernard Goldfine got information from the Federal Trade Commission in violation of law.

In the witness chair of a House investigating committee, the President's top assistant admitted he never did any improper favors for Goldfine's Boston industrialist who made gifts to him and President Eisenhower.

Subcommittee Counsel Robert Lashman said a law violation stemmed from a telephone inquiry Adams made in 1954 about an FTC investigation of a Goldfine mill for alleged misbranding of the content of a fabric.

As a result of the call, Lashman said, Goldfine learned the name of a complainant and that the matter might be settled if the mill would agree to change its labels. He said that giving this information to Goldfine was in violation of law and regulation, Adams replied.

### Nikita Facing Criticism over Domestic Aims

Paris, June 17 (AP)—Diplomatic advisers reaching here said the all-powerful Central Committee of the Soviet Communist party opened an urgent session in Moscow today which could be critical for some of the policies of Premier Nikita Khrushchev.

Hartford, June 17 (AP)—Republicans today nominated Fred R. Zeller as their gubernatorial candidate.

Vienna, June 17 (AP)—Communist Hungary has executed two leaders of the Soviet-crushed Hungarian revolt in October and November 1956, former Premier Imre Nagy and defense minister Pal Malter.

Moscow broke the word first in what looked to Vienna observers like the start of a new Kremlin purge of Tito in the Balkans seeking independence from Moscow's domination. Foreign diplomats in Belgrade viewed the execution of Nagy as a direct Kremlin slap at the Yugoslav president.

Budapest Radio said Nagy and Malter refused to make full confessions to the Hungarian Supreme Court which tried them secretly in Budapest. The dates of the trial and of the executions were not made public. All nine were charged with "organization of a plot aimed at overthrowing the Hungarian government."

Nagy also was convicted of "betraying the motherland" and Malter of "organizing a military uprising."
