Wide Probe of Goldfine Ties Urged

Washington, June 20 (AP)—A Republican member of a House investigating subcommittee called today for an inquiry into all of Bernard Goldfine's contacts with federal officials during the last 10 years.

Rep. John B. Bennett (Mich.) said "I'm of the opinion that (Bernard) Adams is not the only official of the federal government who has enjoyed Goldfine's hospitality."

Adams, President Eisenhower's top aide, has been accused of gifts and favors from Goldfine, a wealthy Boston industrialist, on the basis of a long friendship. He said he also got in touch with two other agencies on matters relating to Goldfine, but denied he sought special treatment for the Bostoner.

Bennett spoke in an interview as the Pentagon denied that more than 20 million worth of textile contracts have been awarded to Goldfine's companies since the outbreak of the Korean war. The Pentagon supplied the figure on request, with no implication of influence or wrongdoing in connection with the awards.

In a separate development, the Securities and Exchange Commission unanimously denied that it dropped a case against one of Goldfine's companies in connection with the awards.

On the contrary, the 5-man commission said, the case was never dropped. It was referred to East Boston Co. and was filed \$3,000 and is now being scheduled for trial.

The SEC reported Chairman E. A. Tamm's decision to refer the case to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a full investigation.

Reds Protest Danish Embassy Demonstration

By the Associated Press. A crowd staged a stone-throwing, banner-waving demonstration at the Danish embassy in Moscow today, breaking seven windows.

It was retaliation against a similar incident at the Soviet embassy in Copenhagen by Danes three days ago. The Danes were protesting the execution of former Hungarian Premier Imre Nagy and his associates.

Danish embassy personnel said about 200 or 300 persons marched on the embassy here today and stayed for two hours. The crowd chanted and carried banners bearing such slogans as "Danes are imperialists friendly toward Hungarian rebels." They threw stones and even threw axes of their banners inside.

Danish Ambassador Alex Morth told the press that the demonstration against the Soviet government, against the execution of former Hungarian Premier Imre Nagy and his associates.

First word of the Moscow demonstration came from Moscow radio.

Today's Moscow broadcast said: "Workers and employees from various Moscow enterprises and establishments assembled at the Danes embassy to protest against the activities of the Danish reactionary government."

The demonstrators carried placards with inscriptions expressing their demands upon the Danish government to secure freedom of the press, the activity of official Soviet representatives.

The demonstration followed a format protest at the Danish embassy in Moscow yesterday. Danish authorities "could not have been intimidated," it said.
