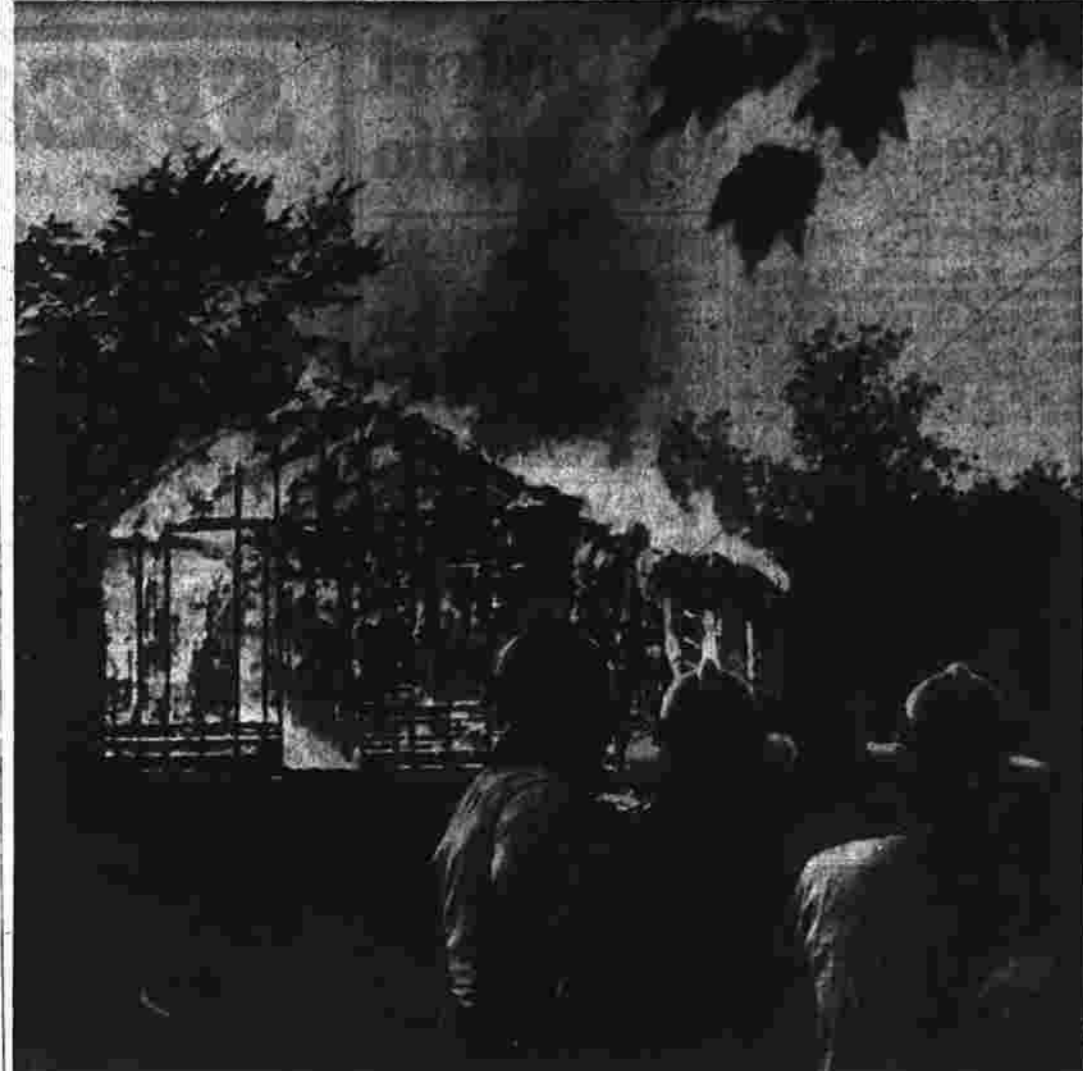

While the men were being rescued by Russian soldiers, the two other youths and recovered 12 soft drink bottles and 116 tins from the plane. The three boys told police they were sleeping out in an old shack at the rear of the house of one of them before the incident occurred.

Flaherty noted that he helped prepare the state's primary law. "When I am not satisfied with the present law," he added, "I believe it is an important step in the direction of democratic control of political parties. I will never hesitate to use this when I feel that circumstances warrant its use."

Bowles, former Connecticut governor, was urged to seek the Congressional nomination after he lost his bid for the senatorial nomination at the state convention in Thomas J. Dodd. He had the support of Gov. Abraham Ribicoff and many party and district leaders.

Bowles will oppose Rep. Horace Sneyd-Krown, Jr., who has been nominated by the Republicans for a sixth term.

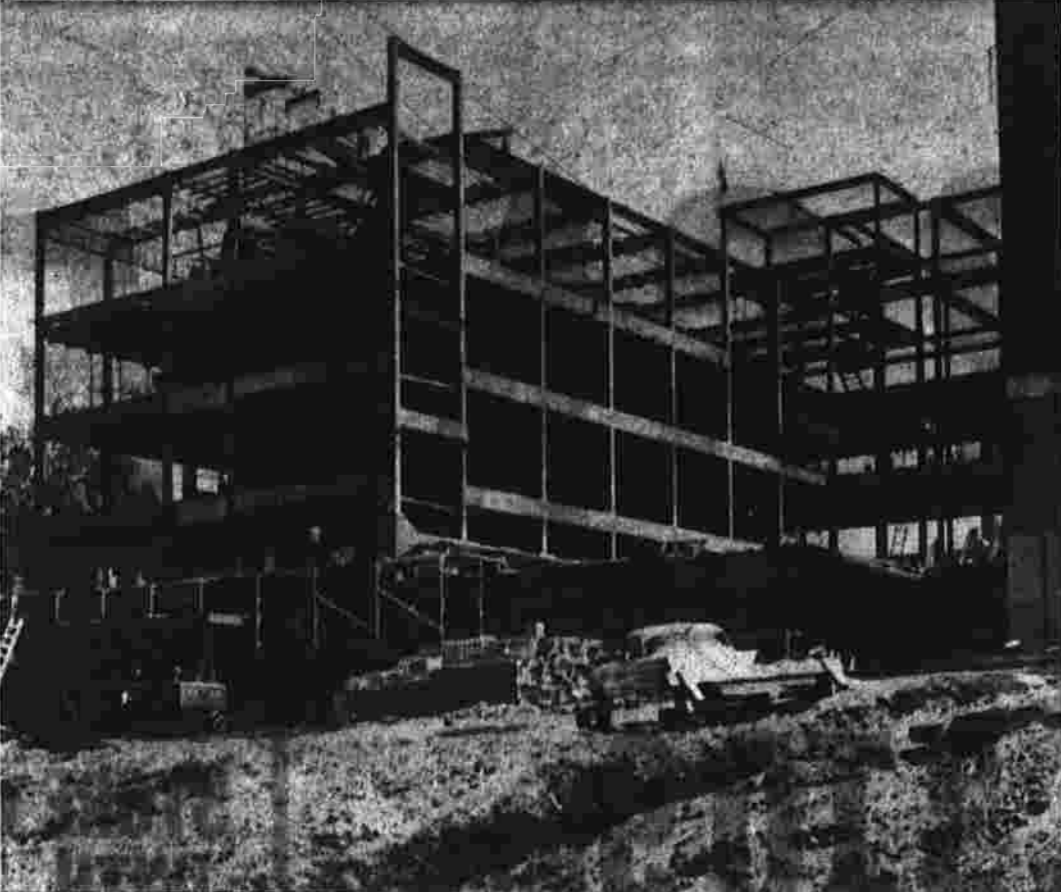

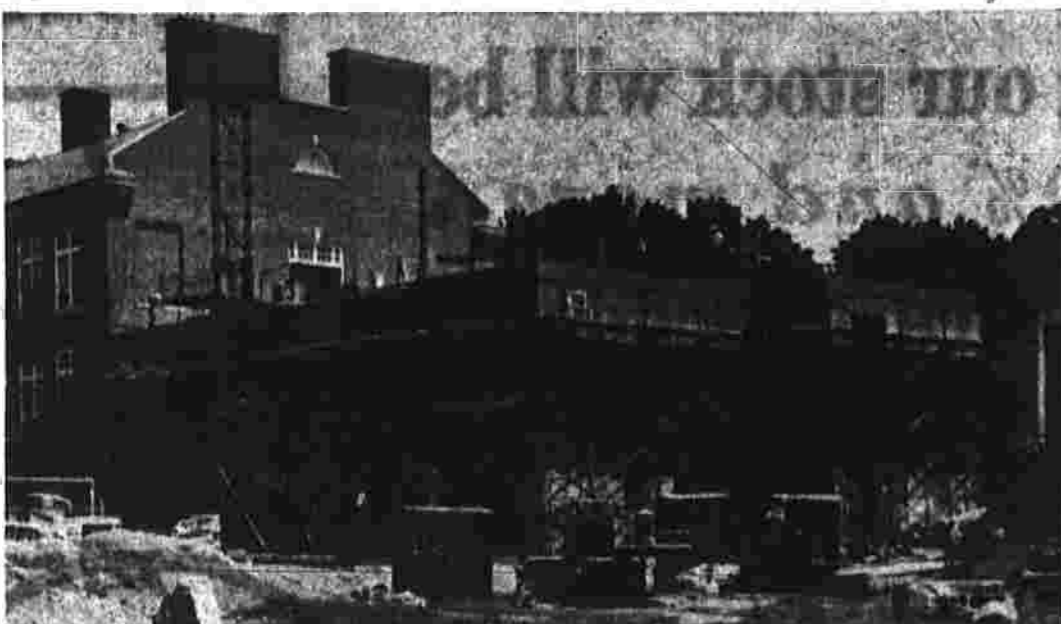
