Nevertheless officials here felt that in view of the position taken by Khrushchev and Macmillan, De Gaulle would almost certainly go along with a meeting at the U.N. next week.

Khrushchev had called for a meeting in Geneva, but Macmillan had refused to attend. But India is not now a member of the Security Council. Presumably Khrushchev would want him included by special arrangement.

Diplomats said that Khrushchev might also object to the British proposal that the meeting should be held solely in the United States. It is necessary to arrive at decisions on the Middle East.

De Gaulle had charged the United States and Britain with aggression in sending troops into Lebanon and Syria. He argued for an emergency summit conference between the great powers on the brink of a catastrophe.

Khrushchev rejected the aggression charge, saying that the United States and Britain were acting in self-defense. He said that the special meeting would be to discuss the situation in the Middle East, and that it would be held in the United States.

GOP's Margin In State Slim

Hartford, July 23 (AP)—What is the independent voter in Connecticut thinking about these days?

This old question had new significance today after the release of figures showing that Republicans have only a slim lead over Democrats in party registration.

How the independents vote will be a decisive factor in the fall elections since there are almost as many of them as registered Republicans and Democrats combined.

State officials reported yesterday that there were only 20,011 more registered Republicans on the state than Democrats.

The official total was compiled from records in the office of the Secretary of State. There were 301,286 Republicans and 136,247 Democrats. The State population is about two million.

Comparison with the last vote figures for 1956, the latest count available shows that there are about 100,000 more registered voters in the State in 1958 than the total number of voters was in 1956.

A new State law required the submission of the party registration figures from each of the 160 towns in the State by the end of this year, the law requires that the figures be filed during the last week of June each year.

A big appeal will be made during the coming campaign to get independent voters by both parties.

The GOP demands that the Legislature, holds all congressional seats and occupies every top State office except governor and lieutenant governor.

The Democrats, led by Gov. Arlan B. Sorensen, are making a voter registration drive to swing the balance of the way.

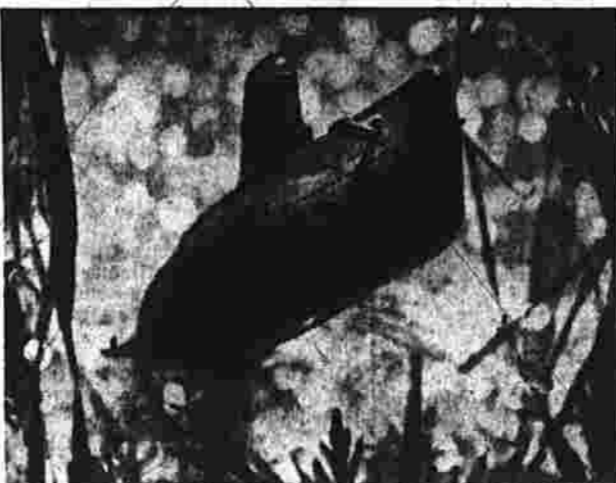

The House That Jacks Build Has Room for Do-it Projects

(NEA) — Dream of a "second home" comes closer to realization for many families with development of a new home building technique by two South Carolina builders.

Brothers J. C. and L. D. Long are lowering costs by jacking up the roof of an all-concrete "vacation" house before the walls are built. Summer homes are under construction at Isle of Palms, island resort area, Charleston.

The result is a reduction in cost of about one-fifth in construction of the building, and move-in time is but two weeks after ground is broken for foundation slab of the dwelling.

The method is an adaptation of a construction technique hitherto used in apartment and multiple parking garage construction.

The Long brothers' method is currently the subject of a patent application.

Mesh in Slab
Welded wire fabric—similar to the wire mesh that's imbedded in driveway construction—makes possible use of the lift-slab method of roof raising.

It gives necessary strength to the slab.

After a similarly reinforced ground slab has set, a plastic overlay is made and the roof is poured over a wire reinforcing.

Motor-driven jacks, five to each side of the slab, work in unison to raise the roof some nine feet above ground.

Center posts are added for temporary support, and walls, windows, doors and partitions are erected UNDER the roof slab.

Plastic sheet is removed from underside of the roof slab; to be used as a vapor barrier in construction of another slab.

The roof is then lowered in place and felled and tarred. A fuel stack and fuel line are provided, and the house can be inhabited just as soon as plumbing and wiring are installed.

Handy Man Takes Over
From here on, the handy man has a chance to get in his links to further reduce cost of the finished dwelling.

He can do all the painting, laying of any of various floor coverings and construction of cabinets, closets and other niceties to finish the shell, which is inhabitable without these improvements.

What will build on this idea of first raising the roof remains to be seen, but possibilities include a second, vacation-time home for many families, and homes at relatively moderate cost for budget income groups.

Whether the technique will become widely used or whether it can be adapted to other, more elaborate types of private dwelling construction, are questions yet to be answered.

Hormone Slowup Hastens Old Age

Salk Lake City (AP)—The sharp drop in the secretion of sex hormones in elderly persons may hasten the aging process, according to Dr. Edward Haslinger of the University of Kansas Medical School.

He says there now is considerable evidence to support this theory and added that these hormones are necessary for many body functions, including the maintenance of strong muscles and bones.

Dr. Haslinger told a medical symposium that thyroid deficiency also may contribute to rapid aging. In both cases, he says hormones can be given in pill form to help compensate for the lack of natural substances.

"None of these things is an elixir. The most we can ask is that people are not allowed to vegetate in their later years."

Child Marriages World Concern

(AP)—It's legal for a 15-year-old girl to get married, with her parents' consent, in New Hampshire.

In some parts of Canada—Newfoundland, Quebec and the Yukon Territory—a 14-year-old boy may marry a 13-year-old girl, with parental consent.

Brides of less than 12 years in age are considered proper in Tanganyika, Africa, provided the marriage is not consummated before the age of 12.

A recent report of the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women shows there are large areas of the world where no legal restrictions exist against a man taking a child bride.

The commission has called for an international agreement forbidding the marriage of girls before the age of 16.
