Racket Group Tied to Hoffa

Washington, Aug. 8 (AP)—A Pennsylvania labor leader testified today Teamster boss James R. Hoffa helped a group of racketeers get a charter to run a hotel and restaurant workers union local in Philadelphia.

The testimony came from William J. Brennan, a vice president of the State Federation of Labor who said he had been threatened for leading an unsuccessful fight against the racketeers. He said he had heard about the threats, but had received none directly.

Brennan told the story before the Senate Rackets Investigating Committee.

Hoffa was in the hearing room awaiting more quizzing.

Chicago Senator Paul (Doc) Walter also was on call for questioning but was not in the hearing room.

The committee said Brennan is not related to Doc J. Walter Brennan, international vice president of the Teamsters and a pal of Hoffa.

William Brennan said the racketeer group revolved about Philadelphia Teamster official Sam (Shoote) Estlin. He said it got a charter in 1934 to run Local 616 of the Hotel and Restaurant Workers Union.

He said the local promptly became involved in scandals including charge of intimidation of employers and that it bosses ran the local \$25,000 in debt in the night.

Underwood To Shut in Bridgeport

The Underwood Corp. announced today that it will close its manufacturing operations in Bridgeport effective Aug. 23, to bring costs into line.

The company said about 500 employees would be affected. Some 75 for about a month to do inventory and maintenance work.

The Underwood plant has been in Bridgeport since the early 1920's. The company said it had not yet decided on future plans for products manufactured here. Some will be produced in other Underwood plants. Adding and accounting machinery and building and accounting equipment has been produced here.

Other plants are located at Hartford and New Hartford, Burlington, N. J., and overseas.

Mayor Samuel J. Tolson called the announcement "another big blow to the city of Bridgeport."

During the year, peak production was 2,500 persons. In the past year, the figure dropped sharply and a year ago the two plants here had about 1,000 workers. Employment last month was estimated at 500.

In the past year the company shut down twice because of a surplus of inventory and lagging sales. The most recent shutdown came three weeks ago at the conclusion of the annual vacation period.

Employees were notified that the plant would be closed until Aug. 4, but on that date they were notified that the shutdown had been extended indefinitely.

Today employees were notified by mail of the company's final shut-down schedule.

Manufacturing operations had been considered in the larger of Underwood's two plants here in April. This is a modern look factory in the south end of Bridgeport near the Commercial Turnpike. The smaller plant in the east side has been idle since a consolidation.

Aide to Ike Hits Terms Of Aged Aid

Washington, Aug. 8 (AP)—Secretary of Welfare Arthur S. Flemming said today he will recommend a veto of the Social Security bill if the Senate passes it in the same form as the House.

He told the Senate Finance Committee he had checked his testimony with President Eisenhower's Budget Bureau before coming to the Capitol.

Flemming gave his approval to the 7 per cent increase in old-age and survivor benefits which the bill provides.

But he strongly opposed the section under which federal grants to the states for public assistance, such as the newly aged program, would be boosted by \$24 million in the first year.

The secretary, who took office only a week ago today, said Eisenhower feels that the states should pay a bigger rather than a smaller share of the cost of these anti-age programs.

Sen. Paul H. Douglas (Ill.) raised the question about the proposed increase in old-age and survivor insurance program "are reasonable and desirable and I recommend their adoption."

Atomic Sub Goes Miles Under Ice

Washington, Aug. 8 (AP)—The United States announced today the atomic submarine Nautilus has completed history's first trans-polar under-sea voyage across the top of the world.

The dramatic announcement came at a White House news conference where President Eisenhower personally presented citations to the youthful skipper of the submarine and members of its crew.

The citation hailed the voyage under the Arctic ice cap as pioneering, a submerged sea lane between eastern and western hemispheres.

"This points the way," the President said, "for further exploration and possible use of this route by nuclear-powered cargo submarines as a new commercial sea-way between the major oceans of the world."

The Nautilus has added to its list of historic achievements, Eisenhower said, by crossing the Arctic Ocean from the Bering Sea to the Greenland Sea, passing submerged beneath the geographic North Pole.

The Nautilus was skippered on the voyage by Cmdr. W. R. Anderson, 35, Waverly, Tenn.

Anderson was picked up by helicopter from the ice cap and flown to Washington for today's White House ceremony.

My very best congratulations to the Nautilus crew and to the command staff on their historic achievement.

The President asked Anderson to extend his congratulations to the members of the Nautilus crew. Secretary of the Navy Gates said the award was the Navy's first of the kind in peacetime.

Operating under the Arctic ice, the Nautilus left Pearl Harbor in Hawaii at 2 a. m. July 23. The voyage north and across the pole was completed at Iceland the morning of Aug. 3—two days ago.

The submarine covered a total distance of about 8,000 miles. Anderson estimated that about 97 per cent of the trip was undersea.

The Nautilus traveled 1,500 miles under the ice in 56 hours.

Jobless Total Drops 143,000, Now 5,294,000

Washington, Aug. 8 (AP)—The government reported today the number of unemployed Americans, dropped by 143,000 in July to 5,294,000.

Employment rose by 188,000 more sharply at this time of year.

The unemployment rate fell to 65.17 per cent. The increase was as great as usual for July.

Hartford, Aug. 8 (AP)—Nearly 100 Philippine seminarians, hospitals and educational facilities owe their existence to an ailing Hartford priest who just died.
