United Nations, N. Y., Aug. 12 (AP)—The U.N. General Assembly adjourned at 12:44 p.m. It will meet again at 10:30 a.m. tomorrow.

President Eisenhower, appearing here for the first time in nearly five years, told the assembly that the United States is ready to support a Middle East peace force and a bold new agency to help finance economic projects.

Gromyko opened up his blast shortly after the President had addressed the assembly. He said the Soviet Union is ready to support a Middle East peace force and a bold new agency to help finance economic projects.

U.S. A-Sub Probing Under Polar Icecap

Washington, Aug. 12 (AP)—The United States is probing for nuclear submarines under the icecap of the North Pole.

The Soviet Union has a ready made block system of party workers which in time of war could quickly be converted to meeting the needs of Civil Defense. Strict organization extends from the highest echelon of government and party to the lowest.

Hoast and other organizations are seeking to educate the Soviet people on how to care for themselves in event of an atomic-age conflict. But this program does not extend to bomb shelters, block wardens in the home, and sirens shrilling alarms for practice tests.

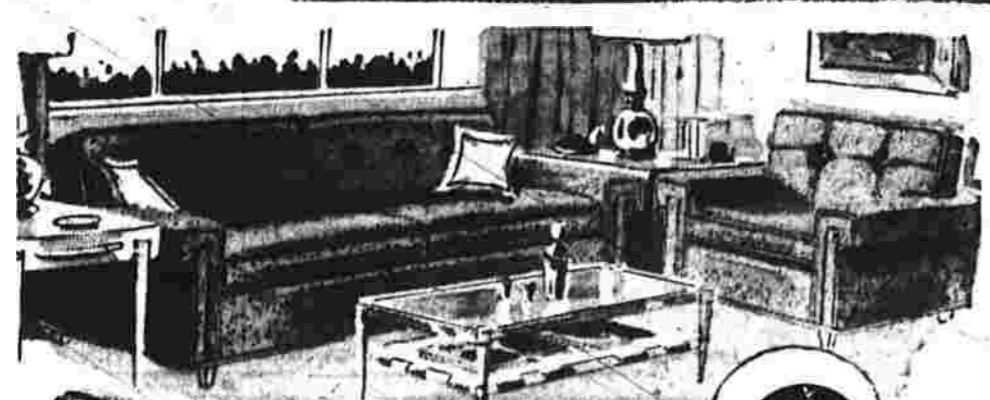

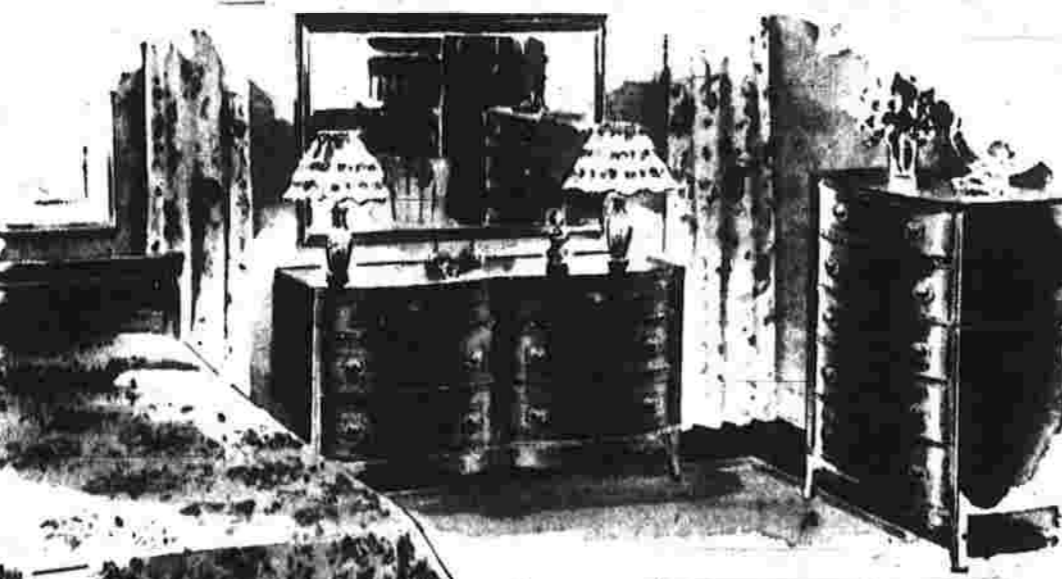

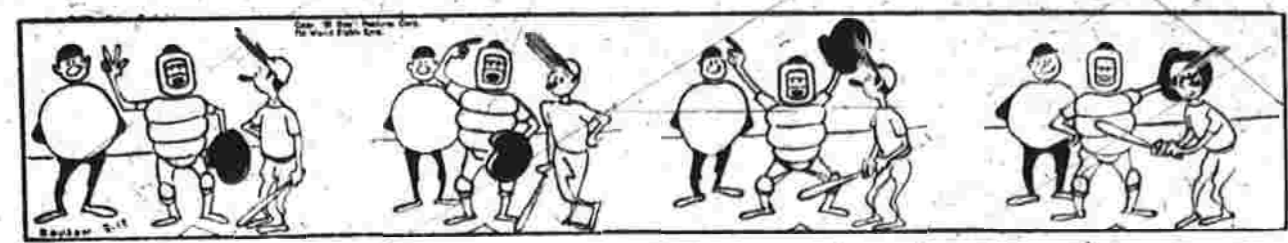

Survivors Sighted; Americans Aboard

Shannon, Ireland, Aug. 14 (AP)—A giant Dutch KLM airliner with 99 people aboard plunged into the stormy Atlantic 130 miles off the west coast of Ireland today. A communique issued by the Royal Dutch Airlines said there was little hope of survivors but a French trawler reported sighting survivors on liferafts. Three British Air Force planes circling the crash scene were among the rescuers. These reports were still not completely clear. A list given out by the line indicated about 50 Americans were among the passengers. The 4-engine Super-Constellation vanished at dawn, 35 minutes after leaving Shannon airport for New York. It had left Amsterdam at 10:30 p.m. The Super-Constellation was in radio contact with the shore at 3:30 a.m. That was the last heard of it. The crash shaped up as possibly the worst single airplane disaster in the history of commercial aviation. There were 91 passengers, 2 of them children, including 2 babies and a crew of 8. Mr. and Mrs. John J. Moore, 431 Boston Mountain Rd., were killed instantly early today in a head-on collision with the plane in the air. Mr. and Mrs. Moore were on their way back to Manchester after visiting the Grand Canyon in Arizona. The accident happened on a flight from Shannon, Ireland, to New York City. Survivors Sighted; Americans Aboard

Shannon, Ireland, Aug. 14 (AP)—A giant Dutch KLM airliner with 99 people aboard plunged into the stormy Atlantic 130 miles off the west coast of Ireland today. A communique issued by the Royal Dutch Airlines said there was little hope of survivors but a French trawler reported sighting survivors on liferafts.
