22 of 34 Aboard Airliner Killed in Crash 30 Years from Nantucket Island Airport

Nantucket, Mass., Aug. 16 (AP)—A Northeast Airlines plane from New York crashed and disintegrated near Nantucket airport late last night taking the lives of 22 of its 34 occupants. Among the victims was Gordon Dean, 52, former chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission. After leaving the AEC he became board chairman of the Nuclear Science and Engineering Corp. and in 1955 was named senior vice president in charge of nuclear energy for General Dynamics Corp. General Dynamics builds atomic submarines. The 3-person crew of the 2-engine Convair—pilot, co-pilot and stewardess—perished. Also killed was Harvey Schwamm, prominent New York City banker. His wife, Lillian, was listed among the seriously injured. A 2-year-old baby, riding in her mother's lap, lived through the crash. The mother, Mrs. Jacqueline Young, 18, Nantucket, was killed. Airport officials said the plane was coming in about 11:30 p.m. last night on an instrument landing through the fog when it crashed 300 yards northeast of the runway.
