### Alaskan Vote Tuesday Seen For Statehood

(Continued From Page One)

Al status has come largely from residents who fear new and higher taxes will be required to support a state government.

Many federal employees in the territory also have expressed fears that statehood would bring an end to a 25 per cent cost of living allowance they receive for working in Alaska.

The Statehood Act becomes void if any one of the three referendum propositions fails to win approval tomorrow.

The first of the three is the key to admission. Voters will answer yes or no to the question: "Should Alaska immediately be admitted into the Union as a state?"

The second accepts the present territorial boundaries as the boundaries of the new state. The third would accept 100,000,000 acres of public land for the state and would authorize military land withdrawals in time of national emergency.

For the first time, Alaska will be voting for officials seeking elective offices of governor and secretary of state. In addition, candidates will be nominated for 10 U.S. Senate seats and one seat in the U.S. House.

If statehood carries in the referendum, a general election to elect the first state officials will be held Nov. 25.

The first bill in Congress calling for statehood was introduced more than 22 years ago.

Statehood supporters say it will be that long before another admission bill would have a chance in Congress if statehood fails at the polls this year.

### Power Squadron Offers Courses In Boat Handling

Free lessons on how to handle small boats will be given again this fall by the Hartford Power Squadron, Commander H. Stanley Warren announced today.

Registration for the classes will be held Sept. 8 and 10 at 7:30 p.m. at Morse College, 183 Ann St., Hartford.

Commander Warren said that anyone interested in learning piloting boats is invited to register and attend the classes which will run weekly for about 14 weeks.

He pointed out that the piloting course covers equipment and emergency regulations, rules of the navigational road, seamanship, safety, the mariner's compass, aids to navigation, charts and plotting, and manners and customs of ship-board.

He advised that those who cannot register personally on the date set may do so in advance by writing to the squadron.

Whether classes will be held in surrounding towns will depend on the size of registration the commander stated.

Registrations for the advanced grades and elective courses, open only to members of the squadron, will be held Sept. 17 at 7:30 p.m. at Morse College.

### Fate of Explorer V Puzzles Scientists

ran smoothly. All four stages of the complex Jupiter-C functional normally, honing the satellite to the 18,000 m.p.h. velocity needed to place it into orbit.

A clear Explorer V signal was monitored for seven minutes at Ft. Monmouth, N.J. It gradually faded away six hours later the Defense Department announced the satellite was not in orbit.

U.S. scientists hoped Explorer V would tell them more about a dense expanse of deadly radiation starting about 400 miles up. It extends far into the unknown. Man must be adequately protected against this radiation before starting adventures in space.

The radiation band is being investigated by Explorer IV (which blazed into an orbit July 26). Preliminary information shows that the intensity and energy of the rays are much more severe than was expected.

The equipment in Explorer V was changed slightly from its predecessor to take a closer look at this radiation phenomena at higher altitudes.

Analysis of Explorer IV reports at the University of Iowa revealed that the rays double in intensity every 60 miles. Above 1,200 miles Explorer IV was nearly exterminated by the bombardment.

Scientists speculate that this radiation-type still unknown—could kill an unprotected man in from 4 1/2 hours to a few weeks' time.

Explorer V carried the same four radiation counters to measure the phenomena as Explorer IV. But the protective lead shielding on one of the two Geiger instruments was made three times thicker by the bombardment.

The thicker shield made Explorer V four-fifths of a pound heavier than Explorer IV. Both satellites are bolted about three inches long.

The Defense Department announced that despite the failure, the Jupiter-C has earned the nickname of "Old Reliable" because of its performance in five satellite launches.
