Talking to Employees Really Difficult Task By SAM DAWSON (AP Business News Analyst) New York, Sept. 17.—Talking to your employees is often harder today than you might think. Sometimes the talking is dramatic — as this week in Detroit. But it goes on the year around, usually in a lower key although an incident one. The difficulties are: There's a natural cynicism on the part of the worker as to the motives and targets. More general is the great featherbed of indifference into which your punchest points may land. Many workers are understandably more interested in their take home pay than in the problems of the boss.

And now and then, Uncle Sam looks over your shoulder. He has some do's and even more don'ts as to what you can say about unions, wages and working conditions. But beyond these legal barriers, there are many fields in which management can communicate with Labor — and does so with an increasing number of words and at an increasing annual rate. Experts in the field of labor relations estimate that the nation's corporations are spending more than \$20 million this year on attempts — successful or just hopeful — to communicate with their employees and the communities in which they operate.

Bulletin Board Popular — The two most popular devices: The company house organ and the company bulletin board. Newspapers and radio stations in the areas where plants are located are offered stories about the company and about its employees. Beyond their news value is the hope that the items will win friends for the firm among its workers' families as well as the community in general.

In lines of stress companies resort to telling their story in letters in payroll envelopes, or letters directly to workers' homes. Personal contact is sought through supervisors or over public address systems. Some firms use closed circuit TV during lunch hours or coffee breaks.

On happier occasions a growing favorite with management is the open house or visiting day. Some are designed to let the family see how Dad and Mom spend their working hours — and how important the firm says they really are. Others try to get the town folk to see that the company is a community asset and really has a heart.

Increasingly popular is a special annual report tailored for employees rather than stockholders. Usually it is printed and often has cartoons, but a few concerns use a phonograph record to tell the story.

Either way the report stresses how the company's sales dollar is spent. Usually it tries to point out the much of the part spent for something other than wages ends up in making the job easier, more secure, and headed up the happy road that in time means higher pay.

Animal's Enemy Disguised Friend Washington — Quite often an animal's enemy is his friend in disguise, while his friend is really his enemy, scientists have discovered. Here are two examples they give: Fishermen in the area trapped fish-killing otters with the aim of increasing the fish supply. The fish didn't increase, however. They disappeared. The otters had been catching diseased fish which couldn't swim fast. With the otters gone, the sick fish infected and killed the others.

To increase the herd of about 4,000 deer living in Arizona's Kaibab Forest in 1905, hunters killed the coyotes, mountain lions, and wolves. Then the deer multiplied, reaching 100,000 by 1923 — far more than the range could support. About 60,000 starved to death during two winters. The forest was seriously damaged, and the deer herd declined until it was well below the original capacity of the range.

He sponsored a merger of nine small parties with his Conservative Hiedempton Party to "battle against Communism." This looks like a government effort to gain voters support against the growing strength of the Leftist Revolutionary Party.

Ydigoras, once helped by the Revolutionary Party, now says it and Communists are the same thing. Party leaders deny this. Guatemala City elects a mayor in December. This job is the country's most important elective position next to the president. A union that he was not showing a firm enough hand in dealing with Guatemala's economy, but by lowering coffee prices, its high cost of living and its crime.

Ydigoras' election was attributed to a personal, more than a party following. Now he seems to be trying to build up a well organized party in his support. His followers say that if he succeeds in doing that, he can devote less time to politics and pay more attention to running the country.
