Rockville-Vernon Educators Set Course For Grades 7 and 8
About 30 teachers, school administrators and school board members gathered last night in the high school cafeteria for the first of a series of conferences on secondary education in the Rockville-Vernon area.
The study council led by Alice Dresser, assistant superintendent, is preparing a junior and senior high school program for 1959-60.
Discussing grades 7 and 8 last night, curriculum planners determined that English, math, science, and history would be the basic subjects. Others to be offered are physics, geography, home-making, music, industrial arts and physical education.
