Tegucigalpa, Honduras, Feb. 10 (AP)—The government claimed today that the army was in control of all Honduras after routing a rebel force which seized the key city of Santa Barbara, near the Guatemalan border. Congress was expected to declare a state of siege, the most form of martial law, to strengthen the hand of President Villanueva in quelling the rebellion. The Mexico City newspaper Diario de la Tarde said that a clandestine Honduran radio station, Radio Libertacion, had called on Hondurans to rise up in a general strike and provided that regular army troops would defect to the rebel forces.

Manchesteer January Idle Totals Highest Since 1950

Washington, Feb. 10 (AP)—Unemployment rose by 616,000 in January to 4,724,000. It was the highest number in any month since before World War II. Government statisticians said that from a statistical standpoint, the unemployment figure was a 699,000. They say there may be a 2.3 million in January. A result of the shorter work week, factory workers average earnings declined by \$2.18, or 17.3% a week in January. Hourly earnings remained steady at \$2.42. A seasonal decline in employment is usual in January. The number of Americans who were dropped by 1,327,000 from 67,972,000 in December to 62,700,000 in January. The monthly job report of the Commerce and Labor Department attributed the job decline to seasonal factors such as release of army and navy personnel, and the Christmas season when stores and post offices, and further curtailment of outside business. Some of these temporary workers were not looking for permanent employment. Hence they were not counted as among the unemployed. Since the State of New York accepted a satisfactory settlement with the Communist-Labor report on government employment in January. The number unemployed for 15 weeks or longer was 1,400,000 in January. The report said this was about the same number as in December.
