Just for The Record... Last week's column dwelt on one of the most important changes in the record world today; one which is of equal importance to the person who owns his own record player and to the listener who buys records.

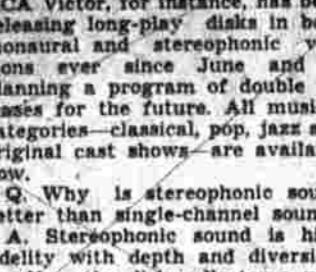
