

Participants Named Lynching Case Solved by FBI

Washington, May 27 (AP)—FBI report implicated at least 18 persons in the lynching of the Negro Charles Parker in Mississippi today, the FBI said today. The report named the participants in evidence turned over to Mississippi Gov. J. P. Coleman.

According to this report, the list was accompanied by proof of the identities of the masked men who went into the Pearl River County Jail at Poplarville, Miss., in the early morning of April 25 and dragged the screaming 23-year-old Negro first to their waiting cars.

Parker, who was on the eve of trial on a charge of assaulting a pregnant white woman, was found dead in the Mississippi side of the Pearl River May 4. He had been shot twice.

Today's Chicago Tribune reported an FBI solution of the case, quoting unnamed sources on Capitol Hill. The newspaper said approximately 18 men were named in the list turned over to Coleman.

Labor Safety Codes Approved in House

Hartford, May 27 (AP)—The industrial safety bill in its final form today was approved by the House of Representatives. The bill, which would allow the Labor Commissioner to enforce industrial safety codes under a compromise bill passed by the Connecticut House of Representatives yesterday.

Safety programs and codes would be set up by the Labor Commissioner after consulting with a 12-member industrial safety commission appointed by the governor. The commission would represent labor, management, insurance companies and the public.

Berlin Still As Deadline Day Passes

Berlin, May 27 (AP)—The day the Russians open up the western Allies to clear out of West Berlin came today and all was quiet.

The announcement came from the Soviet Premier, Nikita S. Khrushchev, who had already been down and negotiate it with the Russians.

Nikita Warns On U.S. Bases In Italy, Greece

Moscow, May 27 (AP)—Nikita Khrushchev says the Soviet Union is ready to set up rocket bases in Albania and Bulgaria to match any the United States may establish in Italy or Greece.

The Soviet premier, visiting Albania, repeated an earlier Soviet proposal for a ban on nuclear weapons in the Balkan peninsula to make a peninsula of peace without any military or nuclear weapons.

He warned Italy and Greece that U.S. rocket bases on their territory "will attract our rockets as a magnet."

These bases are clearly spearheaded against the Soviet Union against Albania and other Socialist (Communist) countries.

Fidel's Brother Rescued After Plane Crash

Havana, May 27 (AP)—Raul Castro, commander in chief of Cuba's Armed Forces and Prime Minister Fidel Castro's half-brother, was rescued today after a plane crash. He was found by the Cuban Navy.

Raul Castro was found lying with the plane's three crewmen at the mouth of the River Matiguano in the Remedios de la Broga area of the Matanzas province.

The men were first reported missing in the swampy area and had not been heard from since last night.

The younger Castro disappeared yesterday after taking off from Havana with three aides in a light plane to search for the crashed helicopter of Air Force Commander Maj. Pedro Luis Diaz Lanz.

Godfrey said it was important to research as similar projects now being pursued by nuclear fusion, missiles and space scientists.

Godfrey, in the request prepared for Congress, made it clear that he is in the interest of millions of our fellow Americans, not for myself.

Godfrey made his plea in a letter to Sen. Lister Hill (D-Ala.), chairman of a Senate Appropriations Subcommittee for Health, Education and Welfare. The letter was dated for reading at today's hearing.

Japan Ballet Seen Oddest

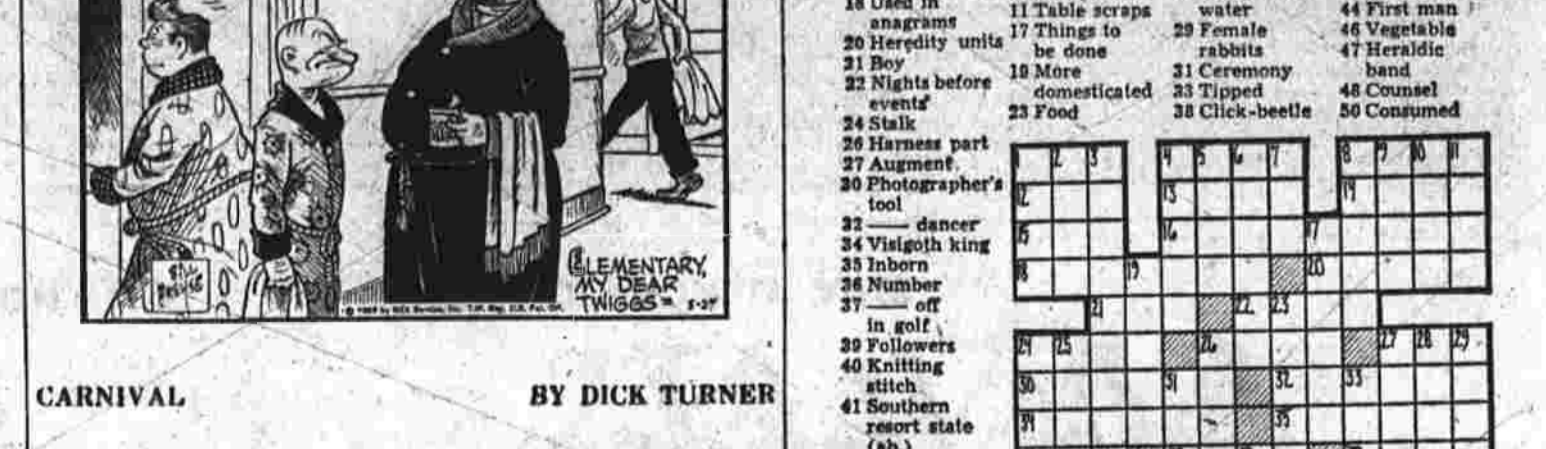
