5 Youths Guilty Of Manslaughter

New York, May 29 (AP)—A General Sessions jury has found five teenagers guilty of first degree manslaughter in the fatal beating of a young Cuban as he sat with a girl friend in an East Harlem Park last Memorial Day.

The victim, Julio Ramos, 24, was challenged against his head, he died the next day.

Convicted last night of the slaying were Frank Monti, 18, Norbert Balbo, 18, Louis (Butter) Camp, 17, George (Chris) Clemente, 17, and Alfred Catino, 18. They face up to 20 years imprisonment. Judge Mitchell D. Schweitzer set sentencing for July 9.

The jury of 11 men and one woman deliberated a total of 2 1/2 hours Wednesday and yesterday before reaching a verdict.

Ramos, a Cuban, was sitting in Jefferson Park when he was set upon by a gang called the Red Wings. The gang had sworn to keep their park clear of Puerto Ricans, and apparently mistook Ramos for a Puerto Rican.

When the jury foreman pronounced the verdict, the five youths said nothing, but hung their heads. Women relatives in the corridor outside the courtroom broke into hysterical sobs when the decision was announced.

One woman shouted, "These kids are innocent." Another screamed, "I'm a justice!"

During the trial Balbo had said his father was of Spanish birth, and Catino said his father was born in Italy. The others are most of American-born parents.
