Crowley on Route To Connecticut

Tokyo, June 24 (AP)—Joseph P. Crowley, appointed Monday in the charge of killing his brother-in-law by plane tonight for his home in New Haven, Conn.

He did not plan for the prosecution to decide whether it will appeal the acquittal.

The former Yale football half-back and his wife, Betty, boarded a Pan American World Airways plane that is due in Honolulu at 1:30 p.m. (EST) EST. Attorneys for the 48-year-old New Haven businessman said Honolulu was as far as he was booked on that plane.

Prosecutor J. Nishimura said the prosecution has not decided whether it will appeal the acquittal to a higher court, a step it can take under Japanese law within a two-week period, or by July 6.

"It will probably be July 3 at the earliest before we decide," Nishimura added.

Nishimura told a reporter Tuesday that Crowley was "morally obligated" to await the prosecution's decision whether to appeal.

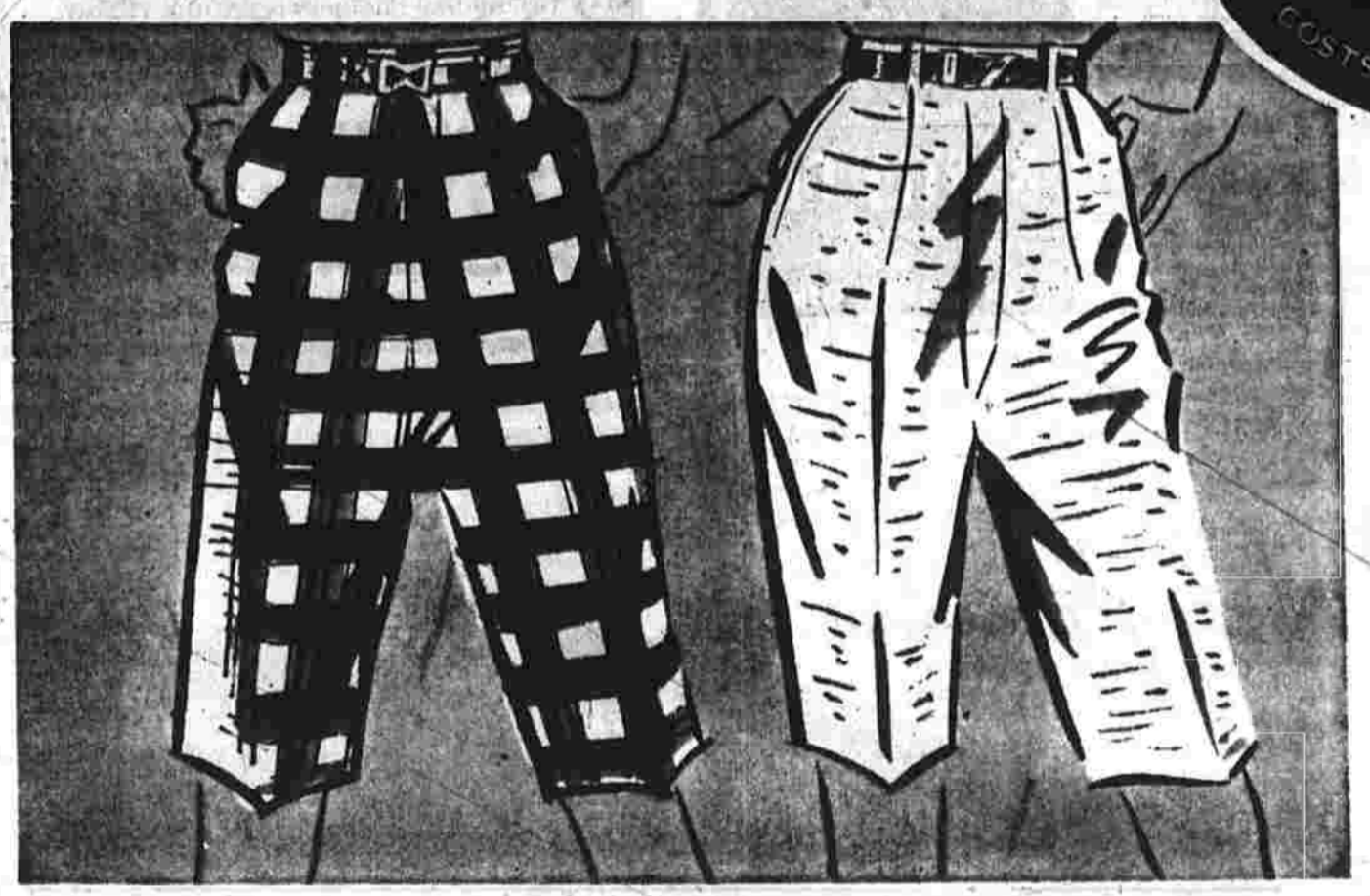

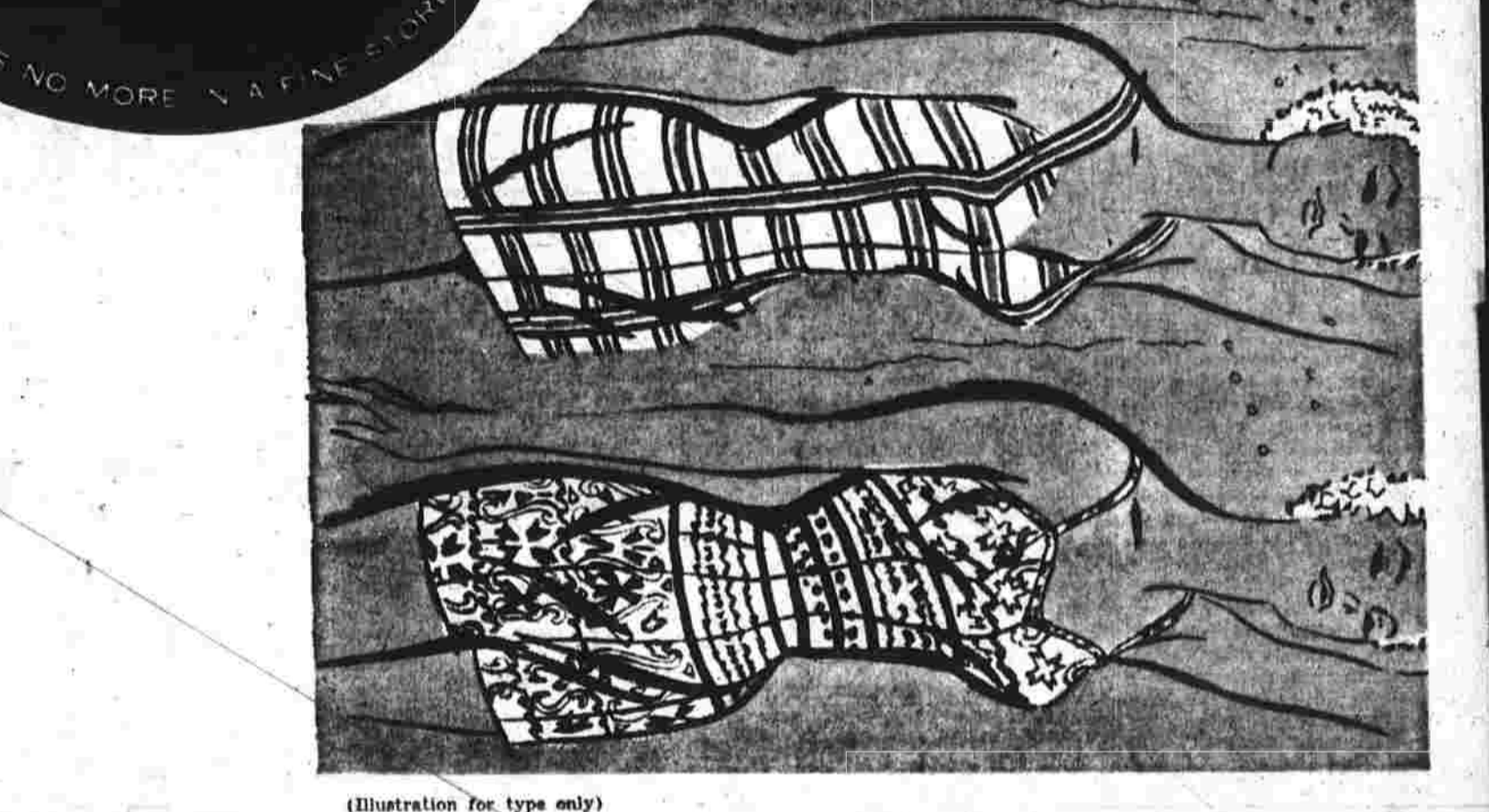

### Herter Added Nothing, AP News Analyst Says

Washington, June 24 (AP)—Secretary of State Christian Herter today made a big point of emphasizing that the nation last night—added nothing to what was already known about his troubles with the Russians at Geneva. He reviewed the obvious.

The mild, 64-year-old Herter, talk while firm was also mild. He made a big point of emphasizing that the Western allies would not abandon West Berlin. This may have been reassuring to the West Berliners, but it was hardly news.

Herter and the foreign ministers of Britain and France talked for six weeks—in sessions almost entirely in secret—in London, Paris and Bonn. They discussed at great length the Russian demand that the Westerners get their troops out of West Berlin and the Westerners refused to do anything of the kind. But they reached last week until July 13 without reaching any agreement.

On the paramount question facing the ministers—in there any realistic chance of a settlement in the next few days?—Herter hit a small note of optimism and then became pessimistic again.

Herter said he and the other Western foreign ministers did not go to Geneva with "any high hopes." He regretted "no sign of real progress was made." Then at the end of his talk Herter threw in this:

"...The conference revealed possible areas of agreement concerning specific arrangements for Berlin. I believe that it may be possible to build on these areas of agreement if the Soviet Union is prepared to accept the Western position of a free West Berlin under Western protection."

If the Geneva talks so far have revealed anything it is that the Russians are not prepared to do anything of the kind.

It was obvious before Herter and the others met in Geneva that the Western allies support for West Berliners and the allies' insistence on keeping the supply

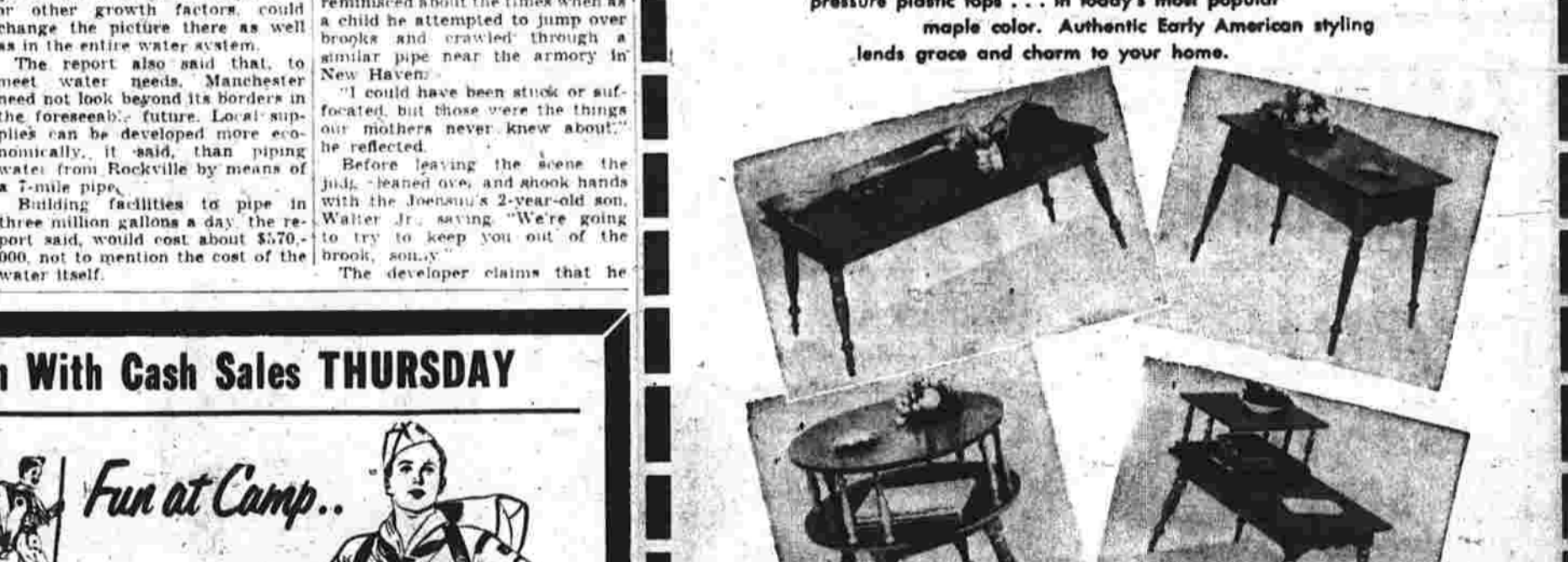

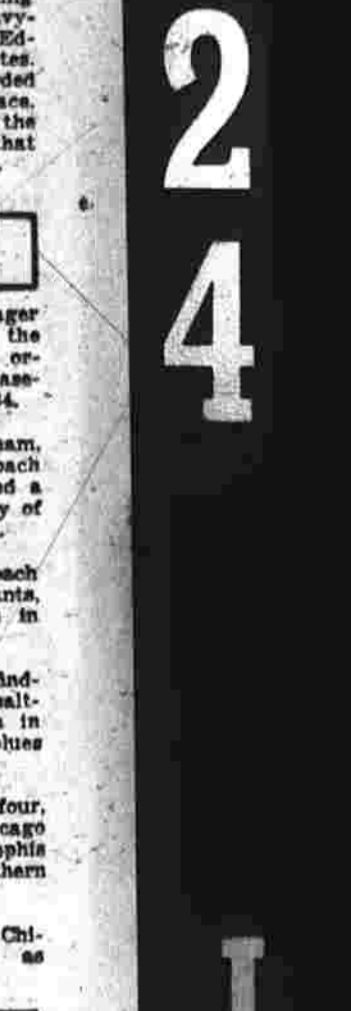
