# New Medium for Noted Thespian VIEWpoints

No doubt the most noteworthy occurrence to brighten an otherwise uneventful summer season has been in the advent of Sir Cedric Hardwicke, distinguished star of stage and screen, as a regular performer on TV.

Currently in New York as the star of the Broadway hit, "A Majority of One," the gifted actor-producer-director has now been called upon to wield his lively wit every Thursday on the panel show entitled "Who Pays?" (NBC-TV,

"I don't think being on a panel show has anything to do with acting," observed the versatile stage and screen star thoughtfully, as he settled down to enjoy a lively dis-cussion. "I imagine you are in-vited to be on a panel because you have become a notorious figure, shall we say, from being an actor nevertheless, I find it a refresh-ing change and I think it's good fun-it's like playing a game and

I personally enjoy it very much." An ardent devotee of the the-ater since the age of 10 when he knew all of Shakespeare by heart, the urbane English actor dipped into 54 years of acting experience for some interesting observations on the current theatrical scene.

Styles of Acting

"I don't think there are any theories about acting or directing," said Sir Cedric meditatively. "I think there are no rules. However, I will say that the best directors I have known have been actors at some time in their lives. . . There are fashions in acting just as there are fashions in anything else. The theater re-flects life, largely. As life changes, so do styles of acting. In former times, an actor was considered good insofar as he was different from other people. Nowadays, it's just the opposite. The more an actor is like the person pext door, the better an actor he is considered."

Commenting on the differences between the theater here and in England, the perceptive British actor continued, "In America, a young man or girl, especially if they are good-looking, can be rocketed to stardom. But it is a position that's difficult to austain over a period of 30 or 40 years. A new star very often hasn't had the training and experience which only comes from a succession of small parts. If you are suddenly going to become a star, you limit the number of parts you are in a position to accept — and this restricts your was in the theater for 20 years be- cal abode.

First Dramatic Success
Having begun his acting career
at the age of 12 when he formed his own Shakespearean company, Sir Cedric achieved his first major success some years later, as Caesar in George Bernard Shaw's produc-tion of "Caesar and Cleopatra," which, at that time, was directed

Did Shaw, as a director, have strong feelings concerning the manner in which the characters in his plays should be interpreted? Sir Cedric replied without heata-tion, "I don't timile he had as atrong an opinion as some of the modern directors. I think he used ry much ch talents and person-ality brought to the part by the actor. . He didn't try to impose anything on the actor that wasn't a part of the performer himself,

a part of the performer himself, which there is a tendency to do today. He would get performances out of people rather than put performances into them."

Insofar as the American theatre is co cerned, Sir Cedric said he regretted the tendency to concen-trate all theatrical activity in New York. "I think the theatre here should be a little more decentralized. For the life of ine, I can't see why they can't produce plays in Chicage or Los Angeles. But it seems it isn't fashionable to do a play anywhere except on Broad-

Knighted by King George V in British theater, Sir Cedric gave an eloquent explanation of one of England's most revered traditions. "It is an konor paid to a profes-sion sather than to an individual. And, as one who is k. ighted, you are supposed to devote your time and energy and prestige to the better, ent of your profession. It is not upposed to be used for your own personal aggrandize-ment."

In the time since Sir Cedric was lenighted, the acting profession has welcomed its newest medium—the world of television.
